9.	<u>PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE</u>

10.	<u>FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTRACT</u>	
10.1.	Notwithstanding anything contained in any other clause, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract due to any failure on the part of the Tenderer in discharging his obligations under the contract or in the event of his becoming insolvent or going into liquidation.
