The scope of work requires deployment of minimum eight no of tractors with trolly arrangemnet daily having adequate payload capacity to carry garbage and other waste materials per day (including sundays/ holidays as required) with required helpers per tractor in addition to operating staff. Instructions to Tenderer:

1	Agency has to quote his price by considering all the cconsolidated wages /Bonus payable to workers/ BHEL wages (which consists of state Govt. minimum wages and additional payments), allowances, deploying of JCB (8 Hrs) once in every month to drive the garbage at dumping yard and other statutory dues payable to workers. BHEL will not reimburse any additional amount payable to contractor other than the agreed amount.
2	Agency supervisor shall control the deployed manpower. All the garbage dustbins, sweeping areas shall be attend on priority basis as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge, shall not cause any traffic restriction in Township during the movement of agency vehicles in Township. Agency authorised vehicles are only allowed in the BHEL Premises, agency other vehicles are not permitted inside the BHEL Campus.
3	Agency supervisor shall look after the working areas where the work has been carried out.
4	The Agency supervisor shall do frequent checking.
5	Controlling of Tractors, Traffic, Drivers and deployed work force shall be monitored.
6	Supervisor shall arrange extra arrangements for lifting the garbage and sweeping during public functions by diverting the other allocated works.
7	Agency supervisor is the overall in-charge of the work. Single Point of Contact (SPOC) during the work.
8	Agency supervisor is to ensure workers are posted in their respective posts as per the directions of BHEL officer in-charge and record to be submitted daily.
9	To ensure all the communication given by BHEL officer is to be passed to the workers promptly.
10	To ensure required guidance, training etc. is provided to the workers at their respective works beside the regular briefing etc.
11	Custodian of the daily attendance
12	Supervisor shall stay at the site until he total work is done and ensures the same for the workers too.
13	Any incidents occurred during the work has to bring it to the notice of the BHEL officer in-charge and if necessary depends on the situation report has to submitted to the police station.
14	Monitor the performance of the workers and their quality of service.
15	Report of the daily work done shall be submitted daily with duly signed with stamp.

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16	Workers to alert and inform his superiors about any suspicious materials found within the Township Premises.
17	Supervisor has to check each dustbin, roads, dumping yard, etc., and alert the workers who are working at their respective place to perform their works as instructed by BHEL Engineer-in-charge.
18	Supervisor along with supporting workers, Drivers, Tractors has to report to BHEL Officer in-charge and they have to follow the instructions given by the BHEL Officer in-charge.
19	During any public functions / festivals / sports events / school events / BHEL Management events / any VIP visits / any elections etc., Supervisor has to follow the guidelines given by the BHEL Officer In-charge for Sweeping and Garbage Lifting works.
20	All group gathering by engaged work force / drunk & drive / accidents / group fighting / rash driving etc., has to be taken monitor by the Supervisor.
21	Wednesday and Saturday Market Sweeping and Garbage Lifting has to done immediately as per the instructions of BHEL Officer In-charge.
22	Employees who are staying in Township area and given information about their area Sweeping and Garbage Lifting shall be attend immediately as per the instructions of BHEL Officer In-charge.
23	Monitoring of Vehicles control in all required places and report to be submitted to officer.
24	Frequent checking of dustbins, dumping yard, dozing of dumping yard as per the requirement need to done. Proper report need to
25	As per the time to time instructions given by the BHEL management, supervisor along with their staff has to work with the given
26	During the execution of contract, if required, agency shall work on Sundays and holidays also as per the direction of Engineer-in-
27	Penalty as per the clause 2.1.36 shall be applicable.
28	All the bills of the contractors will be cleared subject to the production of clearance certificate by the contractors in respect of compliance of all statutory requirement, issued by IR section of HR department BHEL.
29	The agency shall submit the I.R. clearance certificate for the above work and arrange to get the final bill sent to Finance within one month from the actual date of completion of work.
30	The maintenance period of the work is Nil . The security deposit will be released after satisfactory completion of the work and after getting I.R clearance and payment of final bill.
31	Vehicle means Tractor suitable for disposal of garbage/waste materials having payload capacity of at least 2 MT or more.
32	As per the requirement and as per the instructions of Engineer- in-Charge, agency shall work on a holidays also, agency has to ensure the security and safety of the workers during the work on any days.
33	The contractor shall maintain a logbook for record of deployment of vehicle and manpower on daily basis. The record shall be duly verified by the Engineer-in-charge.
34	The contractor or his authorized representative shall report to Engineer - In charge of the civil maintenance at 8 am daily along with vehicles including helpers and with two supervisors for their movement to execute the work as per instruction of Engineer-in-Charge.
35	The contractor shall deploy an optimum no. of labourers to be associated with each vehicle. Agency is solely responsible for the Safety of the deployed labours.
36	If the contractor persists with his default in deployment of stipulated number of vehicles and manpower causing work to suffer, BHEL, in place of effecting deduction/imposing penalty as mentioned above, reserves the right to make any alternative arrangement at risk and cost of contractor with prior notice. The decision of Engineer-incharge shall, in this regard, be final and binding on the agency.
37	Daily record shall be maintained of all works performed under this contract. The work done shall be entered in the register duly signed and dated by both parties viz representative of Engineer Incharge and the contractor or his authorized representative each day on completion of work.
38	The tenderer is advised to quote the rate on per vehicle per day basis by considering all statutory payments for labourers as declared from time to time. One day will have 08 working hours. The work may be required to be done on all days of the year including sundays & holidays (if so required) .
39	The vehicle must be in good running condition fulfilling all RTO Compliances with necessary valid documents / permissions / permits. The contractor shall also submit fitness certificate of the vehicles in this regard. The Driver shall have valid licence and also should carry the original license, it shall be produced as and when required by the BHEL authorities.
40	Agency shall be able to clear minimum 48 number of dust bins a day as per the scope of work. In case, number of dust bins cleared are less than 48, a penalty @ 1000 per dust bin per day will be recovered from the bills. (For example, for a particular day, agency clears only 38 instead of 48, then penalty shall be (48-38) x 1000 = Rs.10000 will be recovered on that day.
41	Agency has to deploy separate tractor to clear all the collected waste during sweeping of the roads and dump all the collected waste in the dumping yard.
