However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost

auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

SINGLE TENDER ENQUIRY

Offer is solicited only from M/s Siemens Ltd. being single tender.

1. Payment terms:

Payment shall be made within 45 days for MSE (Micro & Small Enterprises) / within 60 days for Medium Enterprises / within 90 days for non MSME suppliers

[A] Payment against Supply:

[A1] 95% payment on receipt of complete invoice along with documents in 3 sets (original + 2 copies) as follows:

- · GST Compliant Tax Invoice
- · LR / GR duly endorsed by BHEL Site Official
- · Packing List
- Warranty Certificate
- · Copy of Transit Insurance Certificate from underwriters
- · CRAC (consignee receipt-cum-acceptance certificate) / MRC.
- · Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)
- · Material Inspection Clearance Certificate (MICC) issued by BHEL Quality

Management

[A2] Balance 5% payment shall be made on receipt of claim invoice along with documents in 3 sets (original + 2 copies) as follows:

100% payment shall be made on receipt of complete invoice along with documents in 3 sets (original + 2 copies) as follows:

- · Certificate of completion of final documentation as per Purchase Order /

Technical Specification issued by BHEL Engineering Management.

Note: Vendor has to submit the duly signed check-list along with Bill.

- **2. Delivery** Time: 42 days from the date of PO/input by BHEL as per Activity schedule (Annexure-A).
- **3. Liquidated Damage for delayed Delivery:** As per GeM terms and conditions i.e. If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/ Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

4. Warranty Clause (Defect Liability Period):

The equipment / material supplied shall be guaranteed to be free from all defects and faults in design & engineering, material, workmanship & manufacture and in full conformity with the Purchase Order / Contract, Technical Specifications & approved drawings / data sheets, if any, for 3 years (i.e. 1+2 years onsite comprehensive) from the date of Supply.

The defective equipment / material / component shall be replaced free of cost at site. Freight & Insurance during transit shall also be in the scope of the supplier / contractor. Any expenditure for dismantling and re-erection of the replaced equipment / material / component shall be to supplier's / contractor's account. All replacements during the guarantee period shall be delivered at site promptly and satisfactorily within a period not more than 45 days from the date of reporting the defect / rejection etc.

In the event of the supplier / contractor failing to replace the defective equipment / material / component within the time period mentioned above, BHEL may proceed to undertake the replacement of such defective equipment / material / component at the risk and cost of the supplier / contractor without prejudice to any other rights under the contract and recover the same from PBG / other dues of this Purchase Order / Contract or any other Purchase Order / Contract executed by the supplier / contractor.

5. Performance Bank Guarantee:

As per GeM terms and conditions. Performance BG of 10% of the contract value shall submitted be as per BHEL format. Performance BG shall be valid till Warranty period with claim period of 3 months extra over and above Warranty period.

6. Make in India:

For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as Class-I local supplier / class-II local supplier / Non-Local supplier and purchase preference to Class-I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020, issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before opening of part-II bids against this NIT.

"Bidder to specify the percentage of local content as per the format of self-declaration for local content" as per Annexure-V."

"This tender is not a global tender and only Class-I suppliers as defined under the DPIIT order no. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 04.06.2020 and subsequent orders are eligible to bid in this tender. Bids received from Class II & Non-Local supplier shall be rejected."

As per MOP order no A-1/2021-FSC-Part (5) dt 16.11.21 minimum local content to qualify as local class-I supplier is 50%.

7. COMPLIANCE TO GOI ORDER FOR RESTRICTIONS UNDER RULE 144 (XI) OF GENERAL FINANCIAL RULES (GFRS), 2017 [Annexure-VI]

Refer Clause at Annexure-VI and Certification at Annexure-VII / Annexure-VIII (whichever is applicable) regarding restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017. Bidder to comply the clause and submit the certification. Non-compliance/ Non-submission of certification will lead to rejection of Offer.

8. MOP CIRCULAR [Annexure-IX]

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Disclaimer

Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
