- 1. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. PAYMENT TERM: 80% payment of Supply value shall be made within 45 days for MSE, 60 days for Medium Enterprises and 90 days for Non-MSE from the date of receipt of material at BHEL. Bala nce 20% of Supply value plus 100% of the I&C portion of PO value will be paid against I&C certific ate issued by BHEL along with submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) valid for 15 mont hs (warranty period + 03 months claim period) from the date of I&C certificate issued by BHEL for 5% of total PO Value in the prescribed Format.

3. <u>INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING -</u> Installation & Commissioning (I&C) value will include ser vices to be rendered at BHEL like installation, commissioning, job proving, performance tests, training to operators etc.

The estimated percentage of installation & commissioning value is: 2 % of equipment cost without GST.

I&C value should be quoted separately by bidders. Only in case where quoted value is less than th e value (in %) specified in the NIT or separate I&C values are not mentioned in the offer, value for I &C portion shall be deemed to be considered as the value indicated in NIT & accordingly supply value will be adjusted from that quoted value and balance will be released as I&C payment.

- **4. INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING TIME PERIOD**: Time period required for I&C: 30 days from date of first call by BHEL.
- **5.** CHARGES FOR SERVICES AT BHEL HARIDWAR: Prices offered on GeM portal shall be inclusive for complete scope of work. Vendor to demonstrate all the function & features of the item being p rocured.

6. Penalty for Delay in 'SUPPLY' and 'I&C':

For the purpose of Liquidated Damages for delay I&C of the equipment the duration will be reckon ed from the date of intimation by BHEL to vendor for readiness of site.

Liquidated Damages on delay in 'Supply' and/or 'I&C' will be applicable to the delays attributed to vendor. Liquidated Damages will be considered separately for 'Supply' and 'I&C'.

A. For delay in Supply:

The rate of penalty for delayed Supply shall be @0.5% per week of delay of total PO value (Supply + I&C) in supply subject to a maximum of 10% of total PO value (Supply + I&C).

B. For Delay in Installation & Commissioning:

The rate of penalty for delayed I&C shall be @ 0.5% per week of delay of total PO value (Supply + I&C) in I&C subject to a maximum of 10% of total PO value (Supply + I&C).

Maximum penalty for delay in Supply and I&C together shall be limited to 15% of total PO value (Supply + I&C).

In case PO includes more than one machine, the penalty shall be @ 0.5% per week of d elay on total PO value (Supply + I &C) for the delayed machine.

In case, any shortage is noticed viz-a-viz PO requirement in the main equipment /spares, s uch shortages shall be replenished by supplier on FOR destination basis without any cost i mplication to BHEL i.e. Custom Duty and freight charges etc. up to destination for such sho rt supplies shall be borne by the supplier.

Supply period indicated by bidder should include reasonable time required for approval of drawings and other inputs from BHEL. In the Techno-Commercial Bid, the bidder shall subm it milestones for various activities in co-relation with Supply and E&C period quoted by him

For calculating Late Delivery Liquidated Damages delivery date shall be considered as per following:

Indigenous Suppliers:

- 7. <u>Evaluation shall be done on Total Landed Cost to BHEL Haridwar.</u>

Total Landed Cost to BHEL includes Material cost, I & C, Insurance, Freight charges & GST etc.

- 8. Date of Part-1 Opening shall be considered for Cost Evaluation Process.
- 9. **ERNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):** EMD shall not be applicable for this tender.
- 10. <u>PRE-DISPATCH INSPECTION CLAUSE:</u> BHEL is authorized to pre-inspect the material at vendor 's works. The material will be dispatched only after getting clearance from BHEL.

Bidders should give Pre-Dispatch Inspection (PDI) call at least 04 weeks before the scheduled deliv ery date. If supplier fails to give pre-inspection call with in stipulated time, this will not be a reason of penalty waiver or delivery extension.

Travel, Lodging & Boarding charges of BHEL inspectors / trainees during pre-inspection and training will be borne by BHEL.

- **11.** The evaluation currency for this tender shall be INR.
 - **12.** <u>Delivery Basis:</u> FOR Destination Basis Date of receipt at BHEL Hardwar.
- 13. <u>Delivery Period:</u> Delivery is required by within 140 days from the date of placement of PO.

- **14. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG):** Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) valid for 15 m onths (from the date of I&C certificate issued by BHEL) by Supplier from any of the scheduled Ban ks/Public financial Institutions as defined in the companies Act. of BHEL for 5% of total PO Value in the prescribed Format. The PBG confirmation charges shall be borne by vendor. This bank guarant ee shall have to be submitted before release of last balance payment.
- 15. Contract Execution Bank Guarantee (CEBG): Vendor has to submit Contract Execution Bank Guarantee for 5% of the total PO value in the currency of order within 30 days from the date of purchase order in the form of Bank Guarantee in BHEL format from any of the scheduled Banks/Public c financial Institutions as defined in the companies Act. of BHEL. CEBG shall be kept valid until 30 days after the date of I &C certificate, which will be issued on completion of Installation & Commissioning of equipment which includes erection, commissioning, job proving, performance tests, training to operators etc. as prescribed in PO. If the supplier fails to submit the CEBG even within 60 days from the date of PO, BHEL reserves the right to cancel PO & forfeit the EMD given by the supplier. In addition, in such case, action will be initiated in line with BHEL's extant guidelines for Suspension of Business dealings with Suppliers

Bidder agrees to submit performance security required for execution of the contract within the tim e period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate + 6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder.

Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amo unt of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT contract, from the bills along with due interest.

16. <u>ATTENDING TO ANY COMPLAINT DURING WARRANTEE PERIOD:</u> Vendor will have to ensur e deputation of their people for attending to any complaint during Warrantee period within 6 days of intimation.

In case of delay BHEL will be within their rights to get the job completed at the risk and cost of the supplier.

17. Purchaser i.e. BHEL, Haridwar reserves the right to cancel this GEM custom Bid Tender Enquiry at any stage of Tender Enquiry but, before Purchase Order Placement on GeM Portal. BHEL Haridwar shall not be liable to any of the bidder/or any other agencies to tell the reason for cancellation of this GEM Custom Bid Tender Enquiry. In this matter the decision of Purchase which is BHEL Haridwar shall be final and can't be challenged in any court of Law.

18. <u>Settlement of Disputes:</u>

If any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of, relating to, or in connection with, this contract, or the breach, termination or validity thereof, arises, both parties hereto shall endeavor to settle such dispute amicably. Should this attempt fail, the disputes between the parties shall be resolved through arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The attempt to bring about an amicable settlement is considered to have failed as soon as one of the parties hereto, after reasonable attempts (which attempt shall continue for not less than 30 days); give 30 days' notice, in writing, invoking arbitration and calling upon the other party to constitute the tribunal as provided.

All or any such disputes or differences arising between the parties to this contract shall be referred to an Arbitral Tribunal consisting of single arbitrators. Sole arbitrator shall be appointed on mutuall y agreed by both the parties.

The place of arbitration shall be New Delhi for foreign vendors. The language of arbitration shall be English. The substantive law applicable to the substance of the dispute shall be the Indian Law. GISTC clause may be referred for this clause.

For Indigenous Source. The venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar Courts, which will have exclusiv e jurisdiction.

19. <u>Conciliation Clause:</u> Model conciliation clause for conduction conciliation proceedings under the BHEL conciliation scheme, 2018 will be applicable against this enquiry.

20. Arbitration Clause:

In case of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract, the same shall be referred to arbitration under Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 of a sole arbitrator who shall be appointed by mutual consent of the parties. The seat & venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar. The proceedings shall be conducted in English. The governing law of the contract shall be the substantive Law of India.

21. Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination

In case of breach of contract, recovery of 10% of total contract value shall be applica ble. Recovery shall be done by encashing security instruments like Contract Execu tion Bank Guarantee, performance bank guarantee, EMD. In case value of security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the contractor, retention a mount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies shall be pursued. Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

22. Force Majeure Clause:

- a) Either party shall be entitled to suspend performance of his obligations under the contra ct to the extent that such performance is impeded or made unreasonably onerous by any of the following circumstances: fire, war, flood, riots, earthquake etc.
- b. The party claiming to be affected by force majeure shall notify the other party in writing i mmediately without delay on the intervention and on the cessation of such circumstances. If force majeure prevents the purchaser from fulfilling his obligations, he shall not be forced to compensate the contractor for expenses.
- c. Regardless of what might otherwise follow from these general conditions, either party sh all be entitled to terminate the contract by notice in writing to the other party if performanc e of the contract remains suspended under Clause Force Majeure for more than 6 months.
- d. Evidence for this would be "Force Majeure" certificate issued by chamber of commerce of the c oncerned country.

23. War Like Situation:

If the war like situation has developed in a country where a vendor's works involved in this ten

der is located or there is political instability and Indian Embassy located in that country forbids dealing with the said vendor or advises for not having any business dealing with vendor locate d in such zone / region/ country, then BHEL reserves the right not to consider the offer of such a vendor or to cancel the order in case the order has already been placed and suspend further dealings till normalcy in the country/ region is confirmed by Indian Embassy.

24. Action against Bidders / vendor / supplier / contractor in case of default:

In order to protect the commercial interests of BHEL, BHEL shall take action against supplies / cont ractors by way of suspension of business dealings, who either fail to perform or are in default with out any reasonable cause, cause loss of business/ money/ reputation, indulge in malpractices, che ating, bribery, fraud or any other misconduct or formation of cartels so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price etc.

Suspension of Business Dealings could be in the form of "Hold" or "Banning" a supplier/ contractor or a bidder and shall be as per "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/ Contractors" available at BHEL's website https://www.bhel.com/guidelines-suspension-business-dealings-supplierscontractors

25. Purchase Preference for (Make in India)

For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a Class-I supplier / class-II local supplier / Non-local supplier and purchase preference to class –I local supplier, is as defined in public procurement (preference to make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of Part-II bids against this NIT".

The local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide self-cert ification (Format enclosed) that the item offered meets the minimum local content and shall give details of the location (s) at which the local value addition is made.

26. Conflict of interest among Bidders/Agents
