

1) Offer shall be submitted in Two-Part bid basis, i.e Part I (Techno-Commercial Bid), Part - II (Price Bid).

Part I (Techno-Commercial Bid) shall consists of technical offer and commercial terms & conditions. All the commercial documents listed at point no 9 shall be submitted as a part of Techno-Commercial Bid only.

Part II (Price bid) shall consists of price bid.

2) Qualification Criteria for participation in the tender:

i) Technical qualification requirements mentioned clearly in the technical PQC

ii) Annexure 3F i.e Financial Criteria.

Suppliers shall meet all the requirements mentioned in the above referred documents i.e for participation in the tender.

3) Job specification refers to TC62780 and standard specification refers TC52545. In case of conflicts between standard specification TC52545 and job specification TC62780, job specification prevails

4) These items are required for 2x500 MW NTPC Sipat Project. Items shall be dispatched at site.

10% within 12 months from the date of receipt of material at site or PG test whichever is earlier. For claiming this 10% payment PBG in equivalent value shall be submitted (This is to cater concern of BHEL regarding performance of equipment). The PBG format is as per BHEL standard format.

100% SUPERVISION CHARGES for erecting and Commissioning (E&C) will be paid through NEFT within 75 Days (45 days for MSE) on successful completion of E&C against submission of invoice with E&C completion certificate issued by
