- 34.1 Providing suitable Strand jacks and associated equipments with required man power for smooth operation of the equipment & lifting of the Boiler Drums of capacity as shown below at the following Projects:

1. BHEL shall intimate site readiness for drum lifting program of each unit about one month in advance.
2. These dates are given for guidance purpose only and likely to vary. The contractor has to execute the work as per site requirements

35.0 TIME SCHEDULE

- 35.1 Within 15 days of issue of LOI by BHEL, contractor is required to submit procedure with complete Engg. and required inputs, to BHEL for carrying out subject work and to the satisfaction of BHEL site.
- 35.2 The Contractor is required to Plan the work in such a manner so that after the issue of mobilization letter from Site with a Notice period of 4 (four) Weeks, the entire job for providing suitable Strand jacks and associated equipments with

required man power for smooth operation of the equipment & lifting of each Boiler Drums shall be completed within a total subsequent Period of 20 days from the Date Of Commencement of Work at Site. Date of Commencement of Work at Site for each unit shall be certified by BHEL site-engineer. Dates for each unit of Chabbra, Anpara and Govindwal shall be different based on actual site conditions.

Contractor may also make early mobilization to ensure timely readiness. Irrespective of provisions of time schedules indicated elsewhere.

- 35.3 The work under the scope of this contract is deemed to be completed in all respects for each unit, only when the contractor has discharged all the responsibilities laid down in the contract. The decision of BHEL on completion date shall be final and binding on the contractor.

35.4 DETENTION CHARGES

In case the equipment is retained beyond 20 days, from the Date Of Commencement of Work at Site as certified by BHEL site-engineer, for the reasons not attributable to the contractor, the contractor shall be paid @ Rs.15,000/- per day for such additional period as Detention charges.

The total detention charges and compensation covered under 35.4 & 41.3 shall be limited to 10 % of the contract value.

36.0 TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 36.1 **95% of accepted rates per unit per project** shall be paid by respective BHEL sites on successful and satisfactory completion of the entire work
- 36.2 Balance 5% of accepted rates per unit per project along with proportionate amount of security deposit applicable per unit shall be payable after one months on contractor discharging his responsibilities as stipulated in the contract. The certificate of BHEL engineer regarding such approval and passing of sums shall be final and conclusive against the contractor.
- 36.3 BHEL site at its discretion may further split up the above percentages of breakup and effect payment to suit the site condition, cash flow requirement, according to the progress of work.

37.0 TERMS & CONDITIONS:

(A) SCOPE OF WORK OF AGENCY

- 37.1 Design of Jacking system
- 37.2 Supply of Jacking system and it's accessories including Pin, Sleeve etc
- 37.3 All necessary consumables
- 37.4 Power Source and fuel for the Power packs
- 37.5 Design of Jack support

- 37.6 Transportation of equipment to site.
- 37.7 Provision of all necessary supervision to oversee the skidding, lifting, dismantling & to operate the equipments provided by them.
- 37.8 Provision of technicians for the equipment assembly and installation
- 37.9 Suitable personnel /technicians to operate and maintain the equipment
- 37.10 Accommodation at site for their crew members.
- 37.11 Local Transportation of personnel.
- 37.12 Communication arrangement during drum lifting operation for all associated persons deployed by the Contractor.
- 37.13 Manufacturer's test certificates of STRAND JACKS & each coil of strand.
- 37.14 Procedure and write up from start to finish of the drum lifting activity.
- 37.15 Adequate third party insurance cover
- 37.16 Workmen's compensation for their workmen
- 37.17 Insurance for Equipments
- 37.18 Designing of Cat head structure.
- 37.19 Providing qualified safety engineer during drum lifting operation.
- 37.20 Lifting of Boiler Drum and completion of all the activities.

38.0 FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED BY BHEL

- 38.1 Load information for the design of Jacking Supports
- 38.2 All necessary cranes and tools & plants for unloading, handling, positioning, erection, dismantling & loading of the strand jacks & its accessories.
- 38.3 Transportation of boiler drum and its positioning for lifting in the boiler area.
- 38.4 All necessary unskilled/ skilled labour required for handling, assembly, erection & dismantling of the equipments provided by the agency.
- 38.5 Suitable access to the work site.
- 38.6 Storage area for equipment.
- 38.7 Required platforms for strand jack equipment.
- 38.8 Use of telephone and Fax for project related business only
- 38.9 Illumination at site

- 38.10 Drawings of the item to be lifted.
- 38.11 T&Ps like welding machine, grinding machine, gas cutting set & gases etc will be provided by BHEL free of charges
- 38.12 Fabrication, lifting, positioning & welding of cat head structure.
- 38.13 Lifting & Positioning of U-Rod with the help of winches along with boiler drum.
- 38.14 Drum alignment.

39.0 OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 39.1 The agency should provide the services with equipments well in advance so as to meet the above schedule on receipt of intimation from Construction Manager of respective site.
- 39.2 Equipment to be deployed should be serviced before dispatch.
- 39.3 One service engineer with fast moving spares and one barrel of hydraulic oil should be made available at sites during operation.
- 39.4 All the technical requirements are to be ensured by the contractor so that the operation during lifting will not cause any deformation to BHEL equipments wherever the Strand jacks and related equipments are positioned and anchored.
- 39.5 It is the responsibility of the contractor to take necessary precautions for safe working and avoid any damages to the property/equipments belonging to client failing which the cost of damages/repair/replacement will be recovered from the contractor
- 39.6 It is the responsibility of the contractor to arrange passes or entry permit as per the procedure followed in the plant premises through BHEL site office.
- 39.7 It is the responsibility of the contractor to follow safety precautions while carrying out the work.

40.0 INCOME TAX, SALES TAX, VAT ETC.

- 40.1 TDS under Income Tax, Sales Tax, VAT and surcharge etc, if any, shall be deducted at prevailing rates on gross invoice value from the running bills unless Exemption Certificate from appropriate Authority / Authorities is furnished.
- 40.2 Price quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes except service tax. The service tax, as legally leviable & payable by the contractor under the provisions of applicable law/act, shall be paid by BHEL as per contractor's bill. However, contractor shall have to submit proof of service tax deposited by them immediately after the deposit but not later than the next bill submitted after the due date of deposit. The contractor shall furnish proof of Service Tax registration with Central Excise Division covering the services covered under this contract. Registration should also bear endorsement for the premises from where the billing shall be done by

contractor on BHEL for this project The contractor shall obtain prior approval of BHEL before billing the service tax amount and should submit proper CENVATABLE invoice as per Service Tax Rules.

With introduction of Cenvat credit rules 2004 which came into force w.e.f. 10.09.2004, excise duty paid on input goods including capital goods used for providing the output service and service tax paid on input service can be taken credit of against the service tax payable on output service. As such, while offering the rates, the contractors may take into account the benefit of above provisions as the cost of input to contractors will be the cost net of excise duty and service tax and adjust their offer price accordingly to make it more competitive.

- 40.3** In VAT applicable States, "Tax Invoice" if required under the relevant State VAT law shall be submitted alongwith other compliances as per concerned VAT Act.
- 40.4** Contractor shall get his organization registered with concerned sales tax/VAT authorities within 15 days of award of this contract, if applicable. The delay on this account and delay in bringing the material shall be to contractor's account and no extension of time shall be allowed on this account. The sales tax/VAT registration for this contractor shall be forwarded to BHEL within 30 days from the date of LOI. In case the contractor is already registered for sales tax/VAT with Govt. Authorities he must quote his registration no, while submitting their tender.
- 40.5** Contractor has to make his own arrangement at his cost for completing the formalities, if required, with Sales Tax/VAT Authorities, for bringing their materials, plants, and equipment at site for the execution of the work, including arrangement of Road permits as applicable under this contract.

41.0 CONTRACT PERIOD & PRICE VARIATION

- 41.1** For each project site, separate order shall be issued against this tender.
- 41.2** The contract shall remain valid for one year from the date of LOI. The rate quoted shall remain firm during the contract period.
- 41.3** In case of delay in availability of fronts, for the reasons not attributable to the contractor, the contract can be extended by one year. The rates during such extended period shall be escalated @10 % for unexecuted portion of the work provided the date of commencement of work at site as certified by BHEL Site Engineer falls beyond the contract validity date.

42.0 RATE SCHEDULE

- 42.1** Contractor shall fully understand equipment description and scope of work before quoting. The scope of work and responsibility of the contractor as mentioned under these specifications shall be covered within the quoted rates.
- 42.2** The tenderer shall quote the rates as per the rate schedule only, in part II price bid (Original). Conditional price bids or price bids with any deviation / clarification etc. are liable to be rejected. No cutting / erasing / over writing shall be done.
- 42.3** **BHEL RESERVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE MORE THAN ONE CONTRACTOR FOR THE TOTAL REQUIREMENT**

43.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

- 43.1 Offers received without data / information required to be submitted under tender clauses-11.1 to 11.11 are liable to be rejected. All these data / information should be duly supported by documentary evidences (Refer note below clause-11)
- 43.2 No deviations to the tender conditions will normally be accepted.
- 43.3 The tenderer are advised to physically visit the site and fully acquaint themselves with site conditions, **safety norms being followed / to be followed during working**, transportation routes, various distances and the fact that other contractors would be working in this area their structures are to be protected. The material brought and stacked for construction should not make hindrance to other contractors. Necessary precaution and arrangements including sprinkling of water during work as acceptable to BHEL for safety & security for the above have to be made by the contractor. No claim whatsoever will be entertained by BHEL on any such account and the contractor's rates shall be deemed to have taken this into account.
- 43.4 The contractor in the event of this work awarded to him, shall establish a site office at site and keep posted an authorized responsible officer who should hold a valid power of attorney for the purpose of the contract. Any order or instruction of the Engineer or his duly authorised representative shall be communicated to the contractor's representative at site office and the same will be deemed to have been communicated to the contractor at his legal address.

43.5 The contractor shall comply with following towards Social Accountability;

- (a) The contractor shall not employ any employee less than 15 years of age in pursuant to ILO convention. If any child labour were found to have been engaged , the Contractor shall be levied with expenses of bearing his education expenditure which will include stipend to substantiate appropriate education or employ any other member of family enabling to bear the child education expenditure.
- (b) The contractor shall not engage Forced/Bonded Labour and shall abide by abolition of Bonded Labour System(Abolition) Act, 1976.
- (c) The contractor shall maintain Health & safety requirement as stipulated in the Contract and Contract Labour(Regulation & Abolition) Act,1970.
- (d) The Contractor shall abide by UN convention w.r.t Human Rights and shall be liable for Discrimination/Corporal punishment for failure in meeting with relevant requirements.
- (e) The Contractor shall abide the requirement of Contract Labour(Regulation & Abolition) Act,1970 for working hours.
- (f) The Contractor shall abide by the Statutory requirement of Minimum Wages Act 1948, payment of Wages Act 1936.

43.6 Contractor shall ensure following:

1. Contractor has to maintain contact with local hospital having ambulance facility, scanning & other ultra modern medical facilities required during emergency.
2. Contractor has to ensure pre employment medical check for all staff & workers.
3. Contractor has to ensure that adequate First Aid facilities are available at work site for emergency purpose.

In addition to above, BHEL (through its other contractor) has arranged ambulance at work site for emergency purpose, which can be utilized by contractor in case of emergency. In case , under unavoidable circumstances , if the ambulance is not available , the contractor will have to arrange for the same as [under clause 43.6 \(1\)](#).

44.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES (LD)

44.1 This clause shall be applicable as per clause no. 25.5 of the GCC of the tender.

45.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT

45.1 The contractor shall submit Security Deposit within 15 days from the date of issue of LOI as per clause no. 16.2 of the General Conditions of Contract (GCC). In case the contractor opts to furnish Bank Guarantee as a part of Security Deposit, the BG shall be issued as per the Performa enclosed as per Annexure-H of the GCC and also that the BG should be issued preferably through any of the Member Banks listed on Page No. 34(a) of the GCC;

For BG through any other Nationalized Bank (Not covered in the list of Member Banks of GCC), the discretion of its acceptance shall lie solely with BHEL.

46.0 OTHERS

46.1 In case of any contradiction between General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), the latter shall prevail.

46.2 **BHEL reserve the right to have more than one contractor for the total requirement based on evaluation in each case individually. BHEL decision in this regard shall be final & binding on the bidders.**

46.3 The tenderer shall specifically confirm that he has inspected the site of work and acquired full knowledge and information about the site conditions, wage structure, Industrial climate, total work involved and will not raise claim of any nature due to lack of knowledge of site condition. He will also confirm that local taxation laws at the site have been clearly understood by him.

46.4 **The Price Bids of only those bidders will be opened who will be qualified for the subject job on the basis of pre-qualification evaluation / Techno-commercial bids and acceptance of customer. BHEL reserves the right to reject the bidders with unsatisfactory past performance in the execution of a contract. BHEL's decision in this regard shall be final & binding.**
