The Bidder hereby agrees to extend the validity of the Bank Guarantee for such further period or periods as may be required by BHEL and if the Bidder fails to obtain such extension(s) from the Bank, the Bidder, shall pay forthwith or accept recovery of **an amount** \_\_\_\_\_ from the bills in one installment and the Bidder further agrees that failure to extend the validity of the Bank Guarantee or failure to pay the aforesaid amount in the manner specified above shall constitute breach of contract. In case the Bidder furnishes the bank guarantee at a later date the Bidder hereby agrees to extend the validity of bank guarantee for such further period or periods as may be required by BHEL and if the Bidder fails to obtain such extension(s) from the bank, the Bidder shall pay forthwith or accept recovery of the amount of bank guarantee given in lieu of security deposit from the bills in one installment and the Bidder further agrees that failure to extend the validity of bank guarantee or failure to pay the aforesaid amount in the manner specified above shall constitute breach of contract.

7. That the Bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined this Agreement and the documents governing the same and also to have satisfied himself as to the nature and character of the Works to be executed by him.
8. That the Bidder shall carry out and complete the execution of the said works to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer or such other officer authorised by BHEL, within the agreed time schedule.
9. That BHEL shall, after proper scrutiny of the bills submitted by the Bidder, pay to him during the progress of the said works such sum as determined by BHEL in accordance with this Agreement.
