1. Two part Bid - Tender shall be submitted in two parts:

a. Part I – Techno commercial bid without prices.

b. Part II - Price bid

Tender (quotation) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope super scribed with RFQ NUMBER / and DUE DATE on it and the same must reach our office on or before the due date by 13:00 hrs. Quotation can also be dropped in the tender box placed in the Reception area with caption "Sub Assembly". Late quotations are liable to be rejected.

- **2. Delivery Period:** Equipment shall be delivered during April / May 2009.
- <u>3. Warrantee period</u>: Equipment shall have a comprehensive warrantee of one year from date of Commissioning.

4. Terms and conditions:

- 1. All the Bidders shall meet the **pre-qualification criteria** and Comply with **Technical Specification** mentioned in this specific tender.
- 2. Indian Bidders are required to comply with the **general terms and conditions** as per SA 01 (Annexure –I)
- 3. Foreign Bidders are required to comply with the **general terms and conditions** as per SA 02. (Annexure –II)



A. Scope	Supply, installation & commissioning of the Vertical Storage and Retrieval System as per the following specifications.	
B. Technical specifications:	Offer shall be corresponding to the parameters under the specifications below and pointwise compliance to the following specification is required.	
1. Description:	Automated Vertical Modular Storage System having Static Trays with mobile Extractor System. The system shall have series of trays positioned at both Front & Rear columns. A Retriever unit, controlled by an onboard controller, shall move up and down centrally. The Retriever unit, shall pick the required tray and position of the same at the access window for loading and unloading of components.	
2. Machine Dimensions:2.1 Height	6150±10mm. Supplier to specify the maximum height of proposed equipment and clearance required all around the machine for Installation & Maintenance. The system must have provision to add further modules for heightwise expansion at a later date.	
2.2 Width2.3 Depth	1975±25mm. Shall accommodate tray dimensions specified in clause 3. 2275±50mm	



3. Tray dimensions/Details: 3.1 Width 3.2 Depth 3.3 Storage height for each tray. 3.4 Material	1650±10mm. 620±20mm Shall be flexible to accommodate materials of different height automatically. Trays shall be of rustproof material.	
3.7 Capacity of each Tray	Shall be capable of carrying up to 300kg.	
3.8 No. of Trays:	60nos.	
3.9 Distance between the trays:	Should automatically adjust depending upon the component height.	
3.10 Safety:	When the load on individual trays exceed the limit as indicated at clause 3.7, the vertical storage system shall trip automatically.	

4. Component Storage& Retrieval4.1	Shall be accessible by part number of minimum of 15 digits Alphanumeric. Shall also be accessible by location number of 6 digits
4.2	numeric or alphanumeric. While loading and retrieving, only the desired tray shall move and be made accessible at the access Window.



4.3	Trays shall be placed on rubber or plastic loads to avoid vibrations.
4.4 Drive mechanism:	The driving system for the extractor movements has to be provided with suitable drive mechanism which ensures stability & balance.

5 ESD requirement:	System is meant for storing electronic components that are sensitive to electrostatic discharge. The system shall have suitable features of ESD protection while handling, storing and retrieval of components.
6. Access Window6.1 Number of window.6.2 Position	One: The base of the access window shall be at an elevated position of 833mm(approximate) above the ground level. Shall be alterable to different height in case need arises in future.
6.3 Height of opening:	850±150mm
6.4 Access time:	Shall be of the order of 30 to 45 seconds.
6.5 Safety	 Front end of access window shall be duly enclosed with lockable safety shutters to prevent settlement of dust. Photocell curtains shall be provided for protection against accidents at the outermost door of the access window. The operator control must be provided at/near the access window and the point of location of the console shall be external to the photo curtain. Working light at access point.



	4. The rear side of the access window shall de duly enclosed with automatic door mechanism. Automatic door mechanism shall be always in closed condition during the movement of the extractor & the same will operate only during storing & retrieval of components in any of the called trays. This door shall ensure safety & prevent accidental spillage of components into the intermediate space while loading & retrieval of components.

	9. There shall be a soft start/stop feature to avoid jerky movement of tray.

	11. Single phase preventer shall be provided in 3 phase machines.
	12. Imbalance status display – Permanent display of the system's load distributions during the positioning process.
8. Space Utilization.	Trays shall be optimally located in available storage slots depending upon the height of stored material without manual intervention.



9. Software, control & interface	 Shall have the feature of access control through password. System language: English
10. Power Supply	220V AC +/-10%, Single Phase, 50Hz (or) 415V AC+/-10%, Three Phase, 50Hz.
11 .Exterior finish & colour	Shall be suitably painted, colour selectable at the time of ordering, available options to be specified.
12 . Operating conditions	Temperature: upto 45 degree centigrade. Relative Humidity: 90 % RH.

13. Redundancy system (Expanded Safety By – pass system):

All the redundancy features provided with the standard equipment shall be mentioned. This is for uninterrupted function of the unit even in case of electrical/electronic component failure to enable operator to continue working without any problem with redundancy components available and defect shall be displayed on the screen.



14. Qualification criteria:

A) The vendor should have supplied and commissioned Vertical Storage System similar to the one called in this specification with a minimum height of 6meter and tray carrying capacity of minimum 250Kg to BHEL, EDN, Bangalore and the same should be working Satisfactorily.

OR

The vendor should have supplied and commissioned Vertical Storage System similar to the one called in this specification with a minimum height of 6meter and tray carrying capacity of minimum 250Kg to minimum two users in any of the BHEL units in India. The system should be working satisfactorily for minimum 3 years. User certificate from these users in the format prescribed in page no. 12 shall be furnished along with the quotation.

OR

The vendor should have supplied and commissioned Vertical Storage System similar to the one called in this specification with a minimum height of 6meter and tray carrying capacity of minimum 250Kg to minimum three reputed firms in India. Reputed firms shall be public sector or Private Ltd. Companies. The system should be working satisfactorily for minimum 3 years. User certificate from these users in the format prescribed in page no. 12 shall be furnished. BHEL reserves the right to visit or contact the responsible persons from these organizations for feedback



- B) Offers can be submitted by Indian or Foreign vendors. However a foreign vendor shall have an authorized Indian dealer(s)/ representative(s) for sales and service who has handled the sales and service of this system for atleast 2 years.
- C) If the offer is submitted by the dealer/ representative, authorization letter from the original equipment manufacturer (OEM), shall be enclosed along with the offer.
- D) No authorized representative shall quote for more than one OEM.
- E) The offer shall be only for new equipment and not for any refurbished/ used equipment. A declaration to the above effect to be furnished.
- F) All the parts used in the machine shall be new and not used / refurbished ones. A declaration to the above effect to be furnished.
- G) The vendor shall be in a position to provide service and spare support for the installation in India. The vendor/ Indian representative should stock critical spares required for the system in their warehouse in India and should be able to attend to service calls in one day time.
- H) The vendor or their authorized service representatives should have trained engineers in India for commissioning and service for the offered equipment. A declaration to the above effect to be furnished.
- I) The vendor shall be in a position to undertake AMC for the equipment with BHEL after the expiry of the warranty / guarantee period either directly or through a service representative. The vendor should have successfully completed AMC for similar machines for at least one year in India and necessary proof to be furnished.
- J) The vendor shall arrange for a demonstration of their machine or a similar system operating in India, if required by BHEL.



15. Details to be furnished along with the technical offer:

- 1. System parameters with brief explanation of features.
- 2.If more than one model is quoted, separate offer with complete technical details shall be submitted for each model.
- 3. Clause wise deviations, if any, have to be brought out clearly. If there are no deviations, the vendor has to positively certify compliance to the specifications in toto.
- 4. The complete technical information and catalogue shall be given.
- 5. Power consumption- maximum and average shall be specified.
- 6. All safety features shall be explicitly listed, including that of failure of drive motor, chain etc.
- 7. Make of controller and motor, Bearing.
- 8. Battery backup period
- 9. Type of computer interface.



16. Document to be submitted along with technical offer:

- 1. Details of authorized service agents in India to be furnished.
- 2. All commissioning/service requirements such as power, compressed air, water, lubricants, coolants, consumables and any civil requirements like special foundation arrangements etc. have to listed.
- 3. Time required for installation and commissioning shall be mentioned.
- 4. Drawing of internal arrangement
- 5. CD containing video presentation of the operation in English language.

17. Documents to be furnished along with Equipment(in English language):

- 1. Three **ORIGINALS** of Operation, Maintenance, Service & spare parts manual have to be supplied along with the equipment.
- 2. Detailed Hydraulic, Pneumatic, Electrical and Electronic circuit diagram have to be provided in triplicate.
- 3. The lubrication points are to be identified on the machine with respect to O& M manual. The schedules for lubrications are to be provided.
- 4. Test certificate/ Inspection Report shall be submitted prior to dispatch along with the equipment serial number details.
- 5. Warranty certificate mentioning serial number of the unit, customer name, date of supply etc. shall be provided with original documents of shipment.

17. OPTIONAL ACCESSORIES:

- 1. Network card with suitable software for interfacing multiple units with single P.C.
- 2. Network card with suitable software for interfacing with external SAP system
- 3. Additional trays.
- 4. Inventory management software.

Breakup of prices shall be given for each optional accessory. Main equipment and optional accessories shall be procured from a single vendor. Procurement of optional accessories is at the discretion of BHEL.



18) General Terms:

- 1. Supplier shall guarantee for one year of trouble free performance of equipment from date of commissioning and shall carry out preventive maintenance periodically, at least once in 3 months.
- 2. The equipment and accessories shall carry on site, comprehensive warranty of one year from the date of commissioning including spares and service.
- 3. Training shall be provided to minimum 3 BHEL personnel for operation & maintenance at no additional cost to BHEL.
- 4. The software upgrades during warranty period shall be provided free of cost.
- 5. Immediately after the Purchase Order, vendor shall survey the proposed site and identify the location and modification required for civil, electrical, mechanical, maintenance access, safety etc. features. This shall be completed within 15 days of purchase order placement.

General Terms and conditions for supply of Captal items : (indigenous -Two part bid) SA-01

Bidders are required to read the general terms & conditions carefully and submit their quotation covering all the points. Any order resulting from this enquiry shall be governed by the general terms and conditions listed below.

- 1. **TWO PART BID:** Quotation shall be submitted in two part bid.
 - (a) Techno-commercial i.e., un priced Bid: Techno-commercial bid shall be submitted with complete description of the equipment, specification compliances to the enquired specification and all the commercial terms & conditions indicated in the QUOTATION FORMAT (Annexure I (b)) preferably in the same format. Samples if asked and any other enclosures, which the supplier wish to submit like product catalogue etc., in a sealed envelope super scribed clearly as "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID" with RFQ No. and DUE DATE.

Un priced copy of price bid shall be enclosed with the techno-commercial bid Deviations to the specification / item description, if any shall be brought out clearly indicating "DEVIATION TO BHEL SPECIFICATION" without fail as a part of technical offer. Compliance / comments on all the clauses is essential.

Compliance to pre qualification criteria shall be part of Techno-commercial bid.

Manufacturer's name, their trade mark and brand if any should be invariably mentioned in the tender and illustrative leaflets giving technical particulars etc., are to be attached to the tender to facilitate consideration of the offer.

(b) Price Bid: Price bid should contain basic prices, discount if any, applicable taxes & duties, packing & forwarding charges (if applicable), Freight & insurances (if applicable) etc., in a sealed envelope super scribed clearly as "PRICE BID" with RFQ No. and DUE DATE. Erection and commissioning charges if any shall be included in the price bid.

Please indicate the rates in both figures and words. However in case of difference, the lowest of the two rates will be considered as correct.

Both these envelopes [(a) Techno-commercial i.e., un-priced BID (b) Price Bid] shall be kept in a single sealed envelope and super scribed clearly with **RFQ No.** and **DUE DATE.**

- 3. The rates quoted against each item shall be in the same units stated in the enquiry. If the quotations are submitted in any other unit than specified, relationship between two sets of units must be furnished in the offer.
- 4. As far as possible, the quotations shall be free from corrections / overwriting. Corrections if any should be initialed with your seal and signature. Any typographical errors, totaling mistakes, currency mistakes, multiplication mistakes, summary mistakes observed in your priced bids, BHEL may consider whichever is beneficial to BHEL for evaluating of the lowest quote.
- 5. Please sign the offers. Unsigned bids/offers are liable for rejection.
- 6. All the bidders or their authorized representatives can witness opening of technocommercial bid on the due date.
- 7. After evaluation of techno-commercial bids, price bids of only those who are technically accepted will be opened on a subsequent date, which will be intimated to the concerned in advance for witnessing of price bid opening.
- 8. The quantities in each item to be purchased may vary from quantities enquired according to the actual requirement at the time of placing the purchase order. Quantity discount if any should be mentioned in your offer.
- 9. BIDDERS shall indicate clearly Excise duty, Education cess, Sales Tax/VAT, Octroi, Entry tax, Service Tax as applicable for the quoted items. In the absence of clarity of these, any claim at a later date will not be entertained. Any changes in Taxes and duties after award of the contract will not be considered except such of those, which are imposed by Govt., notification within the contractual delivery. Seeking price amendments for change in Excise duty due to crossing of turnover limits will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 10.TOTAL COST TO BHEL: Lowest Bid (L1) is determined on the basis of the total cost to BHEL. Total cost to BHEL = Total basic value + Packing & forwarding charges + Excise duty + Education cess + sales Tax/VAT + Octroi / Entry tax+ Freight + Insurance (as per BHEL Insurance premium) + Service Tax (as applicable) + Loading factors for deviations to commercial terms & conditions.

Purchase order will be placed on Lowest bidder (L1) only.

- 11. **FIRM PRICE:** Rates quoted should be firm and no enhancement in the rates and changes in the techno-commercial terms will be allowed once the quotation is accepted and order placed.
 - If Erection & Commissioning is in supplier's scope, then the price shall remain FIRM till commissioning & handing over of the complete system. PVC clause is not acceptable.
- 12. **TERMS OF PAYMENT:** The terms of payments are as follows:
 - (a) 90% within 30 days from the date of acceptance of equipments & balance 10% against submission of PBG.
 - (b) In case where 90 % & 10% payment terms are opted instead of PBG, 90 % Payment will be released within 30 days of acceptance. Balance 10% payment will be paid against submission of supplementary invoice after 12 months of warranty period + 6 months claim period.
- 13. <u>ADVANCE PAYMENT:</u> Quotations with payment terms of "Advance" or "Inland letter of credit" will not be considered and such offers are liable for rejection commercially.



- 14. **PENALTY:** Failure to supply the item within the delivery date specified in the purchase order will make the supplier liable to an unconditional penalty of ½% (One half percent) of the value (basic material cost) of the goods in arrears per week subject to a maximum of 10%.
 - If pre-shipment inspection is involved, date of issue of pre-shipment call by the vendor along with test certificates / test reports / certificate of conformance / calibration reports as proof of completion will be treated as date of dispatch for penalty calculation.
 - In the absence of reports stated above, actual date of inspection will be considered as date of dispatch for penalty calculation.
- 15. <u>PBG:</u> Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) to be submitted as per the BHEL prescribed format (Annexure I (c)) for 10% of the basic equipment value obtained from any BHEL member banks.
 - PBG shall be valid for 12 months + 6 months claim period (totally 18 months) from the date of dispatch.
- 16. **WARRANTY:** Goods dispatched shall have warranty period of 18 months from the date of dispatch or 12 months from date of commissioning, whichever is earlier.

17. TERMS OF DELIVERY:

For Vendors in Bangalore jurisdiction: Equipment shall be delivered free at EDN / BHEL, Bangalore, inclusive of packing & forwarding charges.

- All other vendors: 1. Packing shall be Road / Air / Rail worthy, to take care of any transit damages.
 - 2. Dispatch the consignments through EDN/BHEL approved transporters (Annexure I (a))
 - 3. Small consignments can be dispatched through M/S First Flight Couriers Ltd or any other carrier approved by BHEL.
- 18. <u>DELIVERY PERIOD:</u> Equipment shall be delivered as per the requirement of specific R F Q / tender. Offers such as ex-stock subject to prior sale or delivery at the earliest will not be entertained.
 - 15 days time will be granted for giving order acknowledgement beyond which it will be treated as delay and considered as penalty zone if overall delivery does not take place in agreed delivery period.
- 19. **VALIDITY:** Quotation should remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the due date of tender.
- 20. <u>RISK PURCHASE</u>: The purchaser at his discretion may also make purchase of the materials NOT supplied in time at the RISK & COST of the supplier. In this event, it will be obligatory on the part of the supplier who fails to supply the goods in time to make good to BHEL any loss due to such risk purchase.
- 21.BHEL reserves the right to RE-FLOAT/REJECT/CANCEL this TENDER ENQUIRY (RFQ) without assigning any reason or cause thereof. Quotes received against this TENDER ENQUIRY are subject to and governed by all these terms and conditions. BHEL's decision will be final in awarding of the contract and binding on all vendors.
- 22. **REVERSE AUCTION**: BHEL reserves the right to go for reverse auction at any point of time before opening of price bid.
- 23. BHEL reserves the right to Accept / Reject the offer in full or part there off depending on BHEL's requirement.



24 **POST ORDER REQUISITS:**

- (a) Pre-shipment inspection at your works, if required, will be done by BHEL. Required assistance to be provided at the time of pre-shipment inspection.
- (b) Test certificates and warranty certificates as stipulated at the time of ordering shall be furnished.
- (c) Items shall be dispatched with road/air/sea worthy packing. Any rejection due to poor packing shall be to supplier's account.
- (d) Any rejection should be made good or replaced immediately without any extra cost to BHEL.
- (e) Wherever commissioning is involved, it shall be carried out on a turnkey/supervisory basis. Scope of work includes design, fabrication, supply, installation, commissioning and trial run till satisfactory performance level is reached as certified by the user department.
- (f) Copies of operation & instruction manuals to be supplied along with the equipment or before as per specification.
- (g) BHEL will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injuries to staffs sustained during erection/commissioning. Supplier shall ensure compliance with all statutory requisites as laid down by local bodies, state & Central Government.
- (h) Original invoice (2 copies) to be submitted at the office of DGM / EM -Coml for arranging payment.
- (i) As BHEL is also making payment through EFT, banker details in the prescribed format to be submitted.
- (j) Performance Bank Guarantee to be executed on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper as per BHEL prescribed format (Annexure –I (c)).
