1. The scope of supply shall be as per technical specification & there are no exclusion/ deviation with regard to same.

3. Only those technical submittals which are specifically asked for in NIT to be submitted at tender stage shall be considered as part of offer. Any other submission, even if made, shall not be considered as part of offer.
4. Any comments/ clarifications on technical/ inspection requirements furnished as part of bidder's covering letter shall not be considered by BHEL, and bidder's offer shall be construed to be in conformance with the specification.
5. Any changes made by the bidder in the price schedule with respect to the description/ quantities from those given in "BOQ-Cum-Price schedule" of the specification shall not be considered (i.e., technical description & quantities as per specification shall prevail).

 BIDDER'S STAMP

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1.0 GENERAL

BHEL has been awarded a contract by NTPC for executing a power plant at Lara site in Raigarh district of Chhatisgarh. This specification is intended for finalization of contract between BHEL PEM and Bidder. Standard technical detail as indicated in the specification shall be agreed upon between BHEL PEM and bidder.

2.0 SCOPE

As a part of contract BHEL has to procure Two (2) English language copies of all national and international codes and/or standards used in the design of the plant/equipment and supply to NTPC.


The scope is to provide Indian Standard (IS) codes and relevant standards in hard copy/PDF (2 Nos.) as indicated in document no PE-LC-508-600-C011/11A (BOQ for List of codes) for 2 X 800 MW LARA STPP Stage-II.

3.0 BILL OF QUANTITIES

The bidder has to quote for every item indicated in BOQ-cum-price schedule attached with NIT. Bidder's offer shall be for complete scope as per specification. Part offers are not acceptable.

4.0 QUALITY ASSURANCE, INSPECTION & DELIVERY

- a) Bidder assures that the procurement of authentic and updated versions of the requested IS codes and standards has been made directly from the Bureau of Indian Standards to ensure compliance and reliability. For procurement of codes issued by other agencies responsibility of establishing authenticity lies with the bidder.
- b) Bidder guarantees the authenticity and completeness of the codes and standards procured, ensuring they meet the requirements of specification.
- c) The codes and standards shall be subject to inspection and approval by BHEL site upon delivery. Any discrepancy or issue shall be promptly addressed by Bidder.
- d) The delivery of codes and standards shall be made via a reputed courier service capable of handling sensitive documents securely.

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- e) All pdf standards shall have the watermark of the end user (BHEL's customer) as per the detail to be provided by BHEL.
- f) All codes & standards shall be latest version as on date. Any deviation from this will be duly communicated by BHEL to the bidder.
- g) After award of contract, final list of codes and standards to be procured will be prepared and submitted to NTPC for approval. Bidder will supply the codes/standards within 30 days of receipt of approved list from BHEL. In case a particular code is not available, "non-availability proof" from BIS/other agencies will have to be furnished.
- h) No payment shall be made for any codes or standards originally present in the initial list but removed from the approved list.

5.0 MODE OF AWARD

The award of work will be placed on the successful L1 bidder who will supply all the codes and standards present in BOQ.
