Security services shall be provided by the contractor at Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited - Regional Operations Division 8, South Avenue, Choubey Colony, Raipur, comprising of following:

- ➤ 6000 Sq.ft. of premises of the Office including of Building having approx. 2000 Sq ft. (Ground floor)
- 2 Nos. of Gates of the office Premises in the front side only.
- > 3 Nos Gate of building.
- > Security of office car, security of appliances like Air conditioner, cooler and other items fitted in building but accessible from outside.

Security services to be provided by you shall fulfill the following conditions:-

- a) To provide Security services round the clock at the aforesaid premises/ gate. Security personnel deployed to carry out the job should be ex-Servicemen. They should not be above the age of 55 years and physically fit.
- b) To provide effective surveillance of the security services.
- c) To guard/patrol/check during day and night and ensure that no theft, pilferage, trespass, accident, nuisance, disturbance of peace and disorderliness etc. take place in the area.
- d) To take all preventive measures to avoid fire or accident taking place. However, in case of such an eventuality, suitable action to be taken immediately for fire fighting, inform the Head of the Office and designated officers of BHEL immediately.
- e) To man the person on entry point, regulate and check the flow of men/ material and ensure to guard the premises in such a manner that no property is taken away by any one in unauthorized way.
- f) To apprehend immediately any trespasser or person moving in an unauthorized way and under suspicious circumstances and deal as per law in consultation with designated officer of BHEL.
- g) To search the person and their belongings on a random basis as well as in suspicious cases both during entry and exit and inform the designated officer in case the person is found to be in an unauthorized way carrying any property of the Company.

- h) To watch habitual offenders and mischief makers and inform the designated officer of BHEL if anything unusual is noticed.
- i) To provide protection in case of assault/ apprehension of assault to any employee of BHEL.
- j) To seize goods suspected to be stolen and hand them over to the designated officer of BHEL.
- k) To bring any untoward occurrence/ incidents in the company premises to the notice of designated officer of BHEL without delay.
- I) To maintain liaison with Police/Fire /Civil Authorities.
- m) To maintain proper records/ documents as per requirement of the company in connection with security services.
- n) To ensure that lights/fans are not in use beyond office hours and are switched off and water taps are turned off.
- o) To periodically inspect the fire equipments, water hydrants to ensure that they are operational. To periodically carry out mock drill also.
- p) Tools and tackles will comprise of Torches, batons, lathies, Guns/ rifles if required and permissible.

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MEASUREMENT OF WORK AND PAYMENTS THEREOF

- The designated officer of the Unit will periodically inspect the security services being provided by the contractor and find out deficiencies, negligence etc. If any the contractor shall rectify the same immediately within 24 hours to the satisfaction of the designated officer.
- 2. Payment towards work satisfactorily executed shall be made to the contractor.
- 3. Payment will be made to the contractor on the basis of work carried out by him on a monthly basis.
- 4. All payments will be subject to deduction of income tax at source as per income tax laws and Goods & service tax as per the applicable Rules.
- 5) Above rates are subject to variation as per the formula given below to compensate the variation to contractor, in case there is increase in the minimum wages by the Govt. Auth. during currency of contract.

CONTRACTOR'S OBLIGATIONS

A) Contractual:

- a) Contractor shall decide the number of employees to be deployed for execution of the work awarded to him and he or his authorized representative will be solely entitled to dictate such workers about the manner of carrying out the work as per the prescribed specifications and quality plan. However, contractor will be bound to ensure security staff is changed after the required working hours i.e. after the shift is over. The shift duty hours will be decided by BHEL, contractor will ensure that the security staff replaces the previous staff immediately on change of shift.
- b) Contractor shall supervise the work allotted to him and to be carried out by his employees.
- c) Contractor to ensure that the employees deployed in the premises of BHEL are physically and mentally fit and do not have any criminal record. Such employees should possess requisite skill, proficiency, qualification, experience etc.
- d) Contractor to maintain appropriate records of his employees deployed to carry out the job(s).
- e) Contractor should issue appropriate appointment letters to his employees.
- f) Contractor to provide employment card/ identity card with photograph duly verified and attested by the Contractor to his employees. Contractor to indicate the name of the proprietary/ partnership firm/company, place of work, contract number and duration of validity of card.
- g) Contractor will be responsible for the good conduct of his employees. In case of any misconduct /misbehavior by any employee, the contractor will replace such employee(s) immediately.
- h) Contractor shall not sub-contract the job without prior written permission.
- i) Contractor will keep watch on his employees and he will be liable for any pilferage/loss to BHEL due to acts of omission and commission by his employees. Similarly, liability for any compensation to outsiders on account of any act of omission and commission by the employees deployed by the contractor shall lie exclusively with him.
- j) Contractor to provide safety appliances and safety shoes to his employees. The contractor shall be responsible for enforcing all safety regulations as applicable.
- k) The contractor has to provide a distinct uniform different from BHEL employees. The uniform shall be kept in neat, tidy and wearable condition. Wherever necessary, the cap shall be integral part of the uniform.
- I) Contractor to ensure that all precautions are taken for safety of his employees and equipments.
- m) In the event of termination of contract for any reason whatsoever, the contractor shall withdraw all his employees from establishment of BHEL. In case contractor decides to terminate services of his employees, he should settle all terminal dues including retrenchment compensation.
- n) Contractor shall provide to his employees all tools, tackles and equipments and maintain the same to carry out the job under the contract at his cost and if necessary contractor may take insurance policy of his men, material, equipments and tools and tackles.
- o) Contractor shall provide safety appliances and maintain the same at his own cost which may be required under the statute or otherwise.
- p) Contractor shall provide material at his cost as mentioned in the contract to his employees for carrying out the job

B)Towards statutory liability

- a) All statutory requirements under Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Payment of Wage Act, 1936, Workmen Compensation Act 1923, EPF & MP Act, 1952, Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, ESI Act. 1948, The Contact Labour (R&A) Act, 1970, Payment of Bonus Act. 1965, Income Tax Act, Goods & Service Tax Act and all other applicable Acts, Rules, Regulation, as per Government, shall be complied with by the contractor.
- b) Contractor shall comply with all statutory requirement, rules, regulations, notifications in relation to employment of his employees issued from time to time by the concerned authorities.
- c) Contractor shall ensure payment of statutory prescribed minimum wages as applicable from time to time in the presence of authorized representative of BHEL and maintain proper records of their timely disbursement. These records need to be preserved for a period of at least 3 years and should be made available even after the contract is over for any verification by the statutory authorities / BHEL authorities.
- d) Contractor to provide PF pass book to his employees and ensure payment of PF, EDLI, pension dues under EPF & MP Act, 1952 to the RPFC.
- e) Contractor shall ensure payment of ESI contribution under ESI Act, 1948 and provide ESI membership No/ card of each employee.
- f) Contractor shall produce proof of deductions as well as remittances of PF, EDLI, Pension, ESI contribution, administrative charges etc. wherever applicable and shall maintain proper records. Contractor to issue wage slips to his employees.
- g) Contractor shall furnish proper returns to the concerned statutory authorities and provide a copy of the same to BHEL.
- h) Contractor shall be solely responsible for non payment/ delayed payment of wages/ DA, contributions under EPF & MP act, ESI Act etc.
- i) In case the contractor fails to make payment of wages to his employees or remittance of contribution to the concerned authorities, the security deposit /other dues/running bills under the contract can be utilized by BHEL to discharge the liability of the contractor.
- j) Contractor shall indemnify BHEL against all claims and losses under various Labour Laws, statutes or any civil or criminal law in connection with employees deployed by him.
- k) The liabilities for any compensation on account of injury sustained by an employee of the contractor will exclusively that of the contractor.
- Contractor to obtain insurance cover to his employees/equipment /tools and tackles etc and take third party risk insurance coverage at his own cost. BHEL shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, pilferage of his property and /or his employees.
- m) Contractor should have independent code numbers/ exemptions under EPF& MP Act, 1952 and ESI Act, 1948 and shall cover his employees under the said codes.
- n) Payment of bonus under the Payment of Bonus act. Payment of gratuity under Gratuity Act and retrenchment compensation under Act will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
- o) Over and above the daily wage rate, payment shall be made for leave with wages.
- p) Contractor shall observe provisions of the Factories Act in respect of working hours, holidays, rest intervals, leave and overtime to his employees. No work shall be done on second/ third shift, overtime, Sundays or on other declared holidays without written permission.
- q) In case a contractor employees women as employee he will discharge his obligation under law in respect of such woman prohibition of employing them for more than 9 hours per day provision of crèche facility, grant of maternity leave as per rules etc.
- r) Contractor shall be responsible for making payment of wages before the expiry of 7th day after the last day of the wage period in respect of which the wages are payable and to ensure disbursement of wages in the presence of the authorities representative of contact operating division who shall record under his signature at the end of entries in the Register of wages.
- s) Contractor to obtain license under CL (R&A) Act, 1970.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BHEL shall have the privity of the contract with the contractor only and will give instructions to the contractor or his authorized representative. BHEL will have nothing to do or be concerned with the employment of employees working for the contractor. The relationship between BHEL and the Contractor will be that of independent entities and nothing herein contained will amount to joint venture, partnership or an employer-employee relationship.

The contractor shall maintain regular contact with the designated employee (s) of BHEL and will interact on matters relating to the work awarded under this contract.

In case the contractor does not carry out the contractual/ statutory obligations or the services rendered by him are found to be unsatisfactory, BHEL shall bring the same to his notice and he will be obliged to discharge the obligations and rectify the /anomaly within specified time (Unit to specify the time) failing which BHEL reserves the right to impose the specified penalty (units to specify the quantum of penalty in the contract) in the and/ or terminate the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever. In such an event, no damages will be payable for short closure of the contract.

The decision of BHEL regarding interpretation of any terms and conditions set forth in the agreement shall be final and binding on the contractor.

Any matter arising out or in connection with the agreement shall be under jurisdiction of RAIPUR Court.

The contract will commence on 01.01.2023 date and will remain valid for a period of 1 year (s) till 31.12.2023 date. BHEL reserve the right to extend the contract further at the same rates & conditions for another one year

All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached the dispute shall be settled in accordance with provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the rules made there under. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the Unit. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be Raipur in India. The award to be given by the Arbitration shall be a speaking award. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be to the exclusive jurisdiction of RaipurCourts.

Towards Finance.

Contractor to arrange his own finance for carrying out the job including supply of tools, tackles and equipments to his employees, materials, payment of wages to his employees etc. Rates quoted shall be net and inclusive of all the capital cost, material cost, taxes and levies which might be applicable to this type of job.

Rights and obligation of BHEL.

- b) Without prejudice to the aforesaid clause, BHEL reserves its right to terminate or alter the scope of contract without assigning any reason thereof by giving 15 days notice in writing to the contractor.
- c) The cancellation of contract may be either for whole or part of the contract at BHEL's option. In the event of termination of contract in whole or part BHEL may procure upon such terms and in such manner as deemed appropriate, supplies or services similar to those so terminated and the contractor shall be liable to BHEL for any excess costs for such similar supplies or services provided that the contractor shall continue the performance of this contract to the extent not terminated under the provisions of this clause.
- d) The decision of BHEL regarding interpretation of any terms and conditions set forth in the agreement shall be final and binding on the contractor.

Duration of the Contract

Duration of the contract will be for one year i.e. from 01.01.2023 to 31.12.2023. BHEL reserve the right to extend the contract on same rates, terms and conditions for another one year. (subject to revision in minimum wages as notified/issued by CG Govt periodically in regard to minimum wages).

Arbitration and Governing law

All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached the dispute shall be settled in accordance with provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the rules made there under. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the Unit. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be RAIPUR in India. The award to be given by the Arbitration shall be a speaking award. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be to the exclusive jurisdiction.

Security deposit:

The security deposit will be collected from the successful tenderer, the rate of security deposit will be as below:

Up to 10 lac: 3 % of contract value.

The security deposit will be collected before start of the work by the contractor.

Security deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:

- 1. Cash (as permissible under the income tax act)
- 2. Pay order, demand draft in favour of BHEL.
- 3. Local cheques of schedule bank, subject to realization.
- 4. Security available from post office such as National saving certificate, Kisanvikaspatras etc. (certificate should be held in the name of contract furnishing the security and duly pledged in favour of BHEL and discharged on the back)
- 5. Bank guarantee from scheduled banks/Public financial institutions as defined in the companies act subject to a maximum of 50% of the total security deposit value. The balance 50% has to be remitted either by cash or in other form of security. The bank guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
- 6. Fixed deposit receipt issued by schedule bank /public financial institutions as defined in the companies act. The FDR should be in the name of the contractor, A/c BHEL, duly discharged on the back.
- 7. Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills, however in such cases at least 50% of the security deposit should be collected before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
- 8. EMD, if any, of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted against security deposit.
- 9. The security deposit shall not be carry any interest.

NOTE:

Acceptance of security deposit against SI. No. (4) and (6) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL, however BHEL will not be liable / responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or other matter connected therewith.

Security deposit shall not be refunded to the contractor except in accordance with the terms of contract.

Two Part Bid: The Tender will be submitted in two parts.

<u>Techno- Commercial Bid</u>: Comprising of Commercial conditions & confirmation to accept all Terms & conditions. The Commercial bid will be sealed in one envelope separately.

In addition, the confirmation for the few salient features detailed in PART-A will also be enclosed in Techno-Commercial Bid.

<u>PRICE BID</u>: The Price Bid will be submitted strictly as per the format given in Schedule-1 enclosed in separate sealed envelope. Please note, in case, Price Bid is submitted in any other form the same will be rejected out rightly.

Both these envelopes will be superscripted as Techno-Commercial Bid & Price Bid.

Signature of the Parties.

The contract needs to be executed on proper stamp paper (stamp fees be ascertained as per the applicable rates in the Chhattisgarh State). It should be singed with seal of the firm/Company and witnessed.

Due Date of Submission of Tender:

The Tender will be accepted upto 15:00 HRS. on 22/12/22. The Commercial Bid will be opened at 15:30 HRS on 22/12/22 at ROD, BHEL Office at 8, South Avenue, Choubey colony, RAIPUR. The Tenderer will sign each & every page of Annexure A, B, C, D & Annexure-II of tender document as a token of the acceptance.

Please note that Price Bid will be opened only for the bidders, who are found qualified.
