The PBG amount can be reduced by equivalent amount of corresponding unit after expiry of Guarantee Period of corresponding unit subject to COD of the power plant for corresponding unit. The order/ billing value and corresponding PBG amount for each unit shall be based on the approved billing schedule. However, the final decision on unit-wise order/ billing value for the purpose of reduction of PBG amount shall be at the sole discretion of BHEL and the bidder shall be bound to accept the decision made by BHEL in this regard.

Bidder agrees to submit performance security required for execution of the contract within the time period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate + 6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT / contract, from the bills along with due interest.

the BG. The above mentioned payments shall be subject to submission of Performance Bank Guarantee and Collaboration Bank Guarantee (if applicable).

The BGs shall be released upon completion of supplies of equipments of corresponding billing value (as per the approved BBU), i.e. if 40% of billing value (gross value) of items are supplied, the 1st BG (Lot-1) as mentioned above shall be released. The other two BGs shall also be released in the same manner.

The seller/ contractor can also choose to submit a single BG for the entire 5% value mentioned above. In such a case, the initial validity of the BG shall be at least 24 months from the date of issue plus additional three months claim period and further extended till completion of supplies. - iii. Five percent (5%) of the total value (of respective unit) shall be released by BHEL-ISG, HQ on successful completion of PG/ Demonstration test(s) and handing over of the corresponding unit. D. For services (Operation & Maintenance):

Hundred percent (100%) payment on pro-rata basis for the work completed, as per approved billing schedule, shall be payable on submission of protocols, duly signed by BHEL Site/ Owner.

The order/ billing value for each unit shall be based on the approved billing schedule. However, the final decision on unit-wise order/ billing value for the purpose of payment of retention amount shall be at the sole discretion of BHEL and the vendor/ bidder shall be bound to accept the decision made by BHEL in this regard.

20. Standard Payment term

Refer clause 9.6 of General Conditions of Contract (GCC), Rev.01 Note 2 to 5 &7 of clause no. 9.6 are not applicable for this tender.

Foreign bidders can opt for payment (less agency commission, if applicable) through irrevocable and unconfirmed letter of credit. No loading will be done if foreign bidder agrees for LC with 120 days usance period. Any reduction in credit period, loading shall be for the period of relaxation sought on the value payable through LC, based on base rate of SBI (as applicable on date of Techno-Commercial Bid Opening) + 6%. Payment through LC is subject to following:

- i. LC is applicable only for <u>amounts payable in foreign currency against Supply</u> (i.e. Despatch & MRC). (Engineering/ Drawing submission, Advances, Stage / Final payments shall not be through LC)

Price Variation Clause (PVC)

PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR MAIN SUPPLY EXECUDDING MANDATORY SPARES -

- (i) The Contract price shall be subject to price adjustment during performance of the Contract to reflect changes in the cost of material components etc. in accordance with the provisions described below:
- (ii) The price adjustment provisions shall be applicable separately for price components relating to Supply of Equipments, erection and commissioning, as per price break-up furnished by the Contractor. The price adjustment is subject to a ceiling of (+/-) 20% of the said price component.
- (iii) Only following components of the Contract Price will be subject to Price adjustment:
 - (a) Ex-Works (India) Price of Plant and Equipments excluding Mandatory Spares manufactured within the Employer's Country and Type Tests Charges and FOB Price Component for Plant and Equipments excluding Mandatory Spares supplied from abroad and Type Tests Charges
 - (b) Installation Price Component of Contract Price consisting of Erection portion
- (iv) Price adjustment amounts towards aforesaid components of Contract Price shall be paid in the respective currencies of Contract.
- (v) The indices for price adjustment shall necessarily be of the country of origin of goods/labour and shall be well established and nationally recognised in that country. Preferably Government indices shall be used.
- (vi) The price adjustment formula for the components of the Contract Price, as mentioned at SI.No. (iii) above shall be as stipulated hereinafter.

(Vii) Ex-Works Price/FOB Price Component of Plant and Equipments excluding Mandatory Spares and Type Tests Charges

It is understood that the price component of the equipments for any shipment/despatch comprises of a fixed portion (designated as 'F' and the value of which is specified hereunder) and a variable portion linked with the indices for various materials and labour (description and co-efficients as enumerated below).

The amount of price adjustment towards variable portion payable/recoverable on each shipment/despatch shall be computed as under:

 - b) Ex-works/FOB price component for Mandatory spares & Recommended Spares.
 - c) Inland Transportation charges (including Inland Transit Insurance, port clearance, port handling & port charges) for plant & equipment and Spare Parts
 - d) Type Test Charges

For the purpose of this clause, month of execution of erection work shall mean the schedule month of execution of the erection work or actual month of execution of erection work whichever is earlier. The schedule date of completion of a particular erection activity shall be as identified in line with provisions of contract schedule.
