BROAD SCOPE OF JOB:

Erection, Testing, Commissioning, Trial Operation & Handing Over of Boiler and its auxiliaries including Pressure Part, Non-Pressure Parts, Duct dampers and its support structure, Aux. Boiler, Rotating Equipment's, Air Pre-Heaters, ID/FD/PA fans, Mills, Refractory and Power Cycle Piping including Handling of materials at BHEL / Client's Stores / Storage Yard and transportation to site, preparation of foundation, NDT, fixing of hangers & supports, application of lining, Insulation, supply & painting, Stenciling & Labelling of Unit-1 at 3X800 MW NLC Talabira Project.

1.	Duration of Contract	33 Months - Refer Chapter VI of TCC.
2.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) [NIT Clause 1.0 (X) and GCC Clause 1.9]	Reduced EMD amount (Rs. 50 Lakh only)
3.	Price Variation Compensation (GCC clause 2.17)	Applicable. However, PVC & ORC Shall Not be applicable on Section-II of BOQ.
4.	Interest Free Mobilization Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.1)	Interest Free Secured Mobilization Advance as per GCC Clause No. 2.13.1 will be payable under exceptional circumstances on certification of BHEL Construction Manager at Site. Interest Free Mobilization Advance shall be disbursed in specifically mentioned stages of major respective resource mobilization as specified hereunder: 1. For Installation and Erection of Site Infrastructure by contractor i.e. site office stores, etc. – 1.0% of Contract value. 2. For Mobilization of Safety Equipments /PPEs at site as finalised with BHEL Engineer In-Charge – 0.5 % of Contract value. 3. For Mobilization of Measuring and Monitoring Equipment (MMEs), Baking oven, Portable oven, Hardness testing machine etc. for QA/QC at site as finalised with BHEL Engineer In-Charge — 0.5 % of Contract value. 4. For Mobilisation of 02 Nos. of 75/80 MT crane and 01 no. of 40 MT Trailer capacity – 1.0% of Contract Value 5. For Mobilization of 01 no. of Crane of 150 MT capacity - 1.0% of Contract value 6. For Mobilization of required balance T&Ps and resources at site to start the work of Boiler as finalised with BHEL Engineer In-Charge – 1.0% of Contract value. (Refer Chapter VII of TCC)
5.	Security Deposit (SD) (GCC Clause 1.10)	5% of Contract Value and shall be furnished before Commencement of Work. SD to be released after completion of Guarantee Period.
6.	Retention Amount (RA) (GCC Clause 2.22)	5% of contract value and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment.

		Alternatively, on successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected. RA to be released along with Final Bill.
7.	Over Run Compensation (ORC) As per GCC clause 2.12)	Applicable. However, PVC/ORC Shall Not be applicable on Section-II of BOQ.
8.	BOCW Cess (TCC Chapter – VIII, Clause 8.4)	Not to be borne by Bidder.
9.	T&Ps and MMEs (TCC Chapter-IV)	All T&Ps are to be provided by the Contractor as per Chapter-IV of TCC. BHEL shall provide T&Ps to Contractor on sharing basis as per Chapter-V of TCC.
10.	Construction Power: (Clause 3.10 of TCC Chapter - III)	Construction power (three phase, 415V/440V) will be provided to the contractor on chargeable basis at one single point by BHEL. The contractor shall make his own arrangement for further distribution with necessary isolator/LCB etc.
11.	Construction Water (Clause 3.11 of TCC Chapter - III)	BHEL shall establish pumping system for drawing water from Bhedan river for Construction purposes after about four months (04) from the commencement of contract period. On establishment of the system, Contractor shall draw water from BHEL's single point source for water supply. All Necessary pumps & accessories, pipes for drawing water from the given point and for further distribution shall be arranged by the contractor only at their cost. Till establishment of such construction water supply is made by BHEL, the contractor should make his own arrangement for alternative source of water suitable for construction purpose at their cost. No separate payment shall be applicable for this.
12.	Reverse Auction (NIT Clause 19.0)	Applicable
13.	'Assessment of Capacity of Bidders' to execute work	Applicable
14.	'Performance Evaluation' as per Clause 9 of NIT	Applicable
15..	Procurement at Risk and Cost of bidder, in case of default of Contractor is removed (replaced by "Breach of Contract" clause) ("Rights of BHEL" - GCC Clause 2.7)	The total liability on account of Breach of Contract is limited to 10% of the Contract Value.
