SUB: TENDER FOR EXECUTION AND HANDING OVER OF CIVIL WORKS FOR 220/20 KV SUBSTATION AT CHARIKAR AND 220/20 KV SUBSTATION AT DOSHI IN AFGHANISTAN

Sealed Tenders (Under two part bid system) are invited from competent civil contractors for execution and handing over of Civil works for 220/20 kV substation at Charikar and 220/20 kV substation at Doshi in Afghanistan. Only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the Job and who fulfil the Pre-Qualifying Requirements [PQR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents. The PQR of contractor for tender submission shall be as under:

- A. Vendors should have a minimum average annual turnover of **USD 991,500 / INR 4,53,75,000 INR** for last two financial years ending on 31.03.11 and should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account for last two financial years (2009-10 & 2010-11 or 2009 & 2010 as applicable)/ However, in case of contractors from Afghanistan, if audited balance sheets are not available, bidder may furnish annual financial statement certified by recognised finance practitioner for last two years ending not later than 31.03.2011 along with bank statement.
- B. Vendor should have successfully executed/executing similar job (ref note below) during last seven years ending 30.11.11. Vendor should produce certification/proof in support of execution/executing similar package from user/end user and should be either of the following:
- i. **Three similar jobs executed /executing each costing not less than USD 4,00,000/ INR 2,00,00,000**
- OR
- ii. **Two similar jobs executed /executing each costing not less than USD 5,00,000/ INR 2,50,00,000**
- OR
- iii. **One similar job executed / executing each costing not less than USD 8,00,000/ INR 4,00,00,000**
- C. Vendor should have earned profit in at least one year during last two financial years ending on 31.03.11.

NOTE: 1. similar job shall mean successful executed/executing of civil works of switchyard or substation or power house or industry /infrastructure predominantly concrete work.

2. For converting values from any currency other than INR to USD for purpose of this clause, the exchange rate (TT selling rate of SBI) as on schedule date of tender opening (Part-I, Technical bid) shall be considered. In case of non availability of TT selling rate of SBI for currency, BHEL shall have discretion to take conversion rate from another source.

Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the PQR shall be summarily rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.

Important Notes

- 1) BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
- 2) BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
- 3) BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
- 4) Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
- 5) If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
- 6) Bidder's selection is subject to approval of BHEL's customer for this work i.e M/s Power Grid Corporation of India Limited
