Only those bids will be opened which has been submitted with requisite EMD & tender fee.

1.0 The tenders shall be submitted in three parts (part I Techno -Commercial Bid & part II Price Bid & part III Vendor Registration & Evaluation Form) as described below on or before the due date.

- **The Quotation should be from the Principal / Original Equipment Manufacturer, failing which the quotation is likely to be ignored.**
- Any corrections / amendments shall be properly & fully authenticated with signature.

1.1 PART-I (TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID) shall comprise of following documents:

- a) Complete Technical offer in TWO sets (one original + one copy).
- b) Catalogue of the Equipment, Complete reference of the past supply of equipment for the same or similar specification giving details of customer with Name of the contact person, Fax no, phone no, E-mail if available.
- c) Acceptance of commercial terms by vendor as per **Annexure I**.
- d) Deviation with reference to specification to be laid down on separate sheet.
- e) Copy of Un-priced Bid (without prices).

1.2 PART-II (PRICE BID)

The price Bid (with price), which has been submitted with part I as **Un-priced Bid**, for the complete scope as specified in the price Format attached as **Annexure-II**.

- 1.2.1 a) Dispatching port & Country to be mentioned: The vendor has therefore **essentially to quote sea freight up to Mumbai port** / (Air freight up to Delhi AirPort). The foreign bids will be compared on C&F Mumbai port basis. For this purpose, the freight rates as per BHEL's rate contract shall be taken into account if the vendor has not quoted the freight rate up to Mumbai Port.
- b) Indigenous Supplies: - F.O.R. Destination means FOR – BHEL, Stores (Packing & Forwarding, Freight & insurance are in supplier scope i.e., included in the quoted price).
 - c) Applicable sales Tax, Excise duty, service tax, educational cess and any other statutory levy should be indicated separately and clearly in the quotation, else it will be concluded that the offer is inclusive of all taxes and duties. The comparison between foreign and indigenous bids shall be done based on the Landed price basis (FOR DESTINATION).

1.3 Part-III (Vendor Registration/ evaluation form)

The VREF (to be downloaded from www.bhel.com or <http://varanasi.bhel.co.in>) duly filled up will be assessed for manufacturing capability, quality systems being followed, organizational soundness and financial worthiness.

2.2 PART-I containing techno-commercial part and part-III containing vendor Registration/ evaluation form will be opened on the date and time specified in the covering letter, in the presence of those tenders who wish to attend.

2.3 BHEL reserves the right to open the price bid (part-II) along with the opening of techno-commercial offer at its option and in that case vendor will be informed accordingly.

2.3.1 The part-II price Bid along with supplementary priced bid if necessary will be opened at a later date of only those bidders whose techno-commercial bid and financial health has been found acceptable.

1) Payment terms: 80% of equipment cost plus 100% taxes & duties will be paid directly through EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer) within 90 days of receipt of equipment at BHEL, Stores. Balance 20% of material cost and E&C charges, if applicable will be paid after successful Erection & Commissioning.	
NOTE: a) As per payment terms, minimum 20% will be released by BHEL after successful erection, commissioning. Further this 20% will be released against submission of performance bank guarantee valid for entire Guarantee/Warranty period from the date of commissioning. b) The security deposit is to be as per the tender condition. c) Dispatch of Goods on door delivery basis only. - 2. The vendors found technically acceptable against their original technical offer and subsequent technical discussions, BHEL will communicate equivalent scope of supply to the qualified bidders who will be required to submit their supplementary technical bid along with impact in the form of addition and deletion in their price bid in separate sealed envelopes. They will also be required to submit copy of un-priced price bid of these impacts in a 3rd sealed envelope duly super-scribed. These will be submitted within 15 days. The technical bid along with un-priced price bid of impact will be opened on the communicated date and no extension in this time will be given.

It is clarified that no correspondence – technical or commercial – other than the above bids is permissible.
