BROAD SCOPE OF JOB:

Package - A: Erection, Testing, commissioning, Trial Operation and handing over of Boiler and its auxiliaries including Pressure Part, Non-Pressure Parts, Duct dampers and its support structure, Auxiliary Boiler, Rotating Equipment's, Air Pre-Heaters, ID/FD/PA fans, Mills, Refractory etc. along with application of lining, Insulation, NDT, supply & final Painting/ Touch-up painting as applicable and wherever required as per painting schedule including Handling of materials at BHEL/ Client's Stores/ Storage Yard and transportation to site at 1x800 MW GSECL UKAI TPS (Unit#7), Tapi District, Gujarat.

Package – B: Material Handling and Management including Receipt, unloading, verifying, shifting, stacking, preservation, handling and handing over of components of Boiler with auxiliaries including Mills & Feeders etc.; ESP with auxiliaries, Steam Turbine & auxiliaries; Auxiliary Boiler, Turbo-Generator & auxiliaries; Pumps with aux., Rotating machines, Tanks & Vessels, Electrical, Controls and Instrumentation equipments, Panels, Cables / Cable trays, and other related items including items of Boiler, TG & other packages; HP & LP piping; Refractory & Insulation with cladding materials; BHEL T&P; components & equipment of various other systems, Pre-Fabricated Structures, Structural & Reinforcement steel, Cement, supply installation and maintenance of CCTV camera and providing services for Materials Management at 1x800 MW GSECL UKAI TPS (Unit#7), Tapi District, Gujarat.

2.	EMD AMOUNT (As per NIT Clause 1.0 (vii) and GCC Clause 1.9)	Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakh Only)
3.	ORDERING PHILOSOPHY (As per NIT Clause 35.0)	Awarding for the total work shall be done to one agency, however for the ease of operation and execution of contract, job shall be awarded in two separate Packages i.e Package-A for ETC of Boiler and Auxiliaries works and Package-B for Material Handling & Management Works. Value of Package - A shall be 97.190475% of Total amount quoted by bidder and Value of Package - B shall be 2.809525% of Total amount quoted by bidder + Fixed Cost
4.	Security Deposit (SD) (As per GCC Clause 1.10)	The successful Tenderer should deposit the 5% of the contract value as Security Deposit towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
5.	Retention Amount (RA) (As per GCC Clause 2.22)	5% of contract value and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment. Alternatively, on successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected.
6.	Duration of Contract (As per TCC Chapter VI)	Pkg-A: 36 Months Pkg-B: 40 Months.
7.	Reverse Auction (As per NIT Clause 19.0)	Not Applicable.

8.	BOCW Cess (As per TCC Chapter – VIII, Clause 8.4)	Not to be borne by Bidder.
9.	Price Variation Compensation (As per GCC Clause No. 2.17)	Applicable. However, PVC ORC shall not be applicable for Section- C, D & E payment terms of Material Management in line with Clause no. 7.4, 7.6 & 7.7 of Chapter-VII of TCC.
10.	Over Run Compensation (ORC) (As per GCC clause 2.12)	Applicable. However, ORC shall not be applicable for Section- C, D & E payment terms of Material Management in line with Clause no. 7.4, 7.6 & 7.7 of Chapter-VII of TCC.
11.	Construction Power (As per TCC Clause No. 3.13 of TCC)	Construction power (three phases, 415 V/ 440 V) shall be provided by BHEL free of cost Free of cost (at single point source) near the site at a distance of approx. 500 meters within 03 months from the date of start of work, as finalised at site for each Package i.e. Package- A and Package-B separately. Further, distribution shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and services. For Package-B (MM Package), it may be noted that apart from above, Power source for CCTV Camera shall be provided free of cost by BHEL at ground level at each of the pole from where Power will be utilized for CCTV Operation.
12.	Construction Water (As per TCC Clause No. 3.14 of TCC)	BHEL shall provide water supply free of cost (at single point source) for construction purpose as and when made available by customer for each Package i.e. (Package-A & Package-B) preferably within 3 months from date of start of work. Contractor has to make arrangement of further distribution. However, contractor shall make alternate arrangement of construction water till the same is made available by BHEL. No separate payment shall be made for any contingency arrangement made by contractor.
13.	Interest Free Mobilization Advance (As per GCC Clause 2.13.1 and TCC clause 7.9)	Limited to 5% of the Contract Value.
14.	Secured Advance Against Material Brought to Site (As per GCC Clause 2.13.3)	Limited to 5% of the Contract Value.
15.	Interest Bearing Mobilization Advance and Additional Interim Advance (As per GCC Clause 2.13.2)	Up to 10% of the Contract Value.
16.	T&Ps and MMEs	Refer Chapter-IV of TCC.
17.	T&PS AND MMES to be provided by BHEL on sharing basis	Refer Chapter-V of TCC.
18.	'Performance Evaluation' as per Clause 9 of NIT	Applicable
19.	'Assessment of Capacity of Bidders' to execute work	Applicable
