

## SCOPE OF WORK

<p>Scope of Work :- Rate Contract for “To and Fro Transportation of Reefer container containing COPPER WINDING WIRE”</p> <p>To transportation - Loaded reefer container from Nhava Sheva Mumbai port/Mumbai Airport to BHEL Bhopal by maintaining +8 degree Celsius. Fro transportation – Empty reefer container from BHEL, Bhopal to Nhava Sheva Mumbai port/Mumbai Airport (No power supply needed as no refrigeration required for empty container to be returned)</p>	
Quantity to be transported	29 Sets (1 set weight- 26207.90 Kg) Total Weight - 760029.10 Kg for 29 sets
Required vehicle type	Suitable for transportation of 40 ft (l) x 8 ft (b) x 8.6 ft (h) reefer container, <u>Max load 25 MT Each</u> and having features to provide <u>required electrical supply/Power supply to reefer container for running continuously to maintain required temperature (+8degree Celsius) during “To” transportation.</u>
No of vehicles required	102 Nos ± 20%
Temperature to be maintained during “To” transportation	+8 degree Celsius
Validity/Tenure of contract	2 years from the date of Contract

(a) During execution of the contract, bidder has to deploy proper vehicles to transport consignments covered under the scope of work suiting the weight and dimensions and suitable vehicles complying to Motor Vehicle Act / Rules stipulated by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH).

(b) Transporter has to ensure for safely return of empty reefer container to respective person at Nhava Sheva Port Mumbai/Mumbai Airport/any other port or location at Mumbai and get receiving from the respective officials and submit the same to BHEL, Bhopal with freight bill.

(c) Transporter shall be responsible for temperature excursion, breakdowns and emergency arrangements. Vehicle should be equipped with temperature control & measuring system and transporter to show the data of it.

(d) Transporters shall ensure direct to destination vehicles placement. However, in exceptional cases, transshipment can be done with prior permission of BHEL, Bhopal only. For unauthorized transshipment, a penalty of 5 % of basic freight shall be imposed.

(e) In all cases of transshipments, the entire responsibility for safety of goods shall be at the risk and cost of the transporter.

**Note :- Safe return of Empty reefer container From BHEL, Bhopal to Nhava Sheva Mumbai Port/Mumbai Airport is the responsibility of transporter. Damage/loss of container shall be recovered from transporter.**
