A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BIDDERS/TENDERERS:

1. The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document. Only one set of tender document duly signed & stamped on each page shall be submitted as detailed further. Tenderer should note specifically that all pages of tender document page for this particular tender shall be submitted by them (after signing/ stamping on each page) as a part of their offer. In case of any clarification, bidder may contact this office.
2. Tender documents are also available on BHEL web site (www.bhel.com) & on CPP Portal (<http://eprocure.gov.in/cppp/>) which can be downloaded and used as tender document for submitting the bid.
3. This tender is invited from the Limited bidders only, to whom this tender is emailed. No tender will be accepted from other bidders.
4. Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid, etc. any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature (s) of person (s) signing the bid else bid shall be liable for rejection.
5. Tender must be submitted in single part bid including all pages of tender document. The tenderer must submit their tenders in sealed envelope along with NIT No. & due date of opening written on the envelope.

6. The tenderer shall submit the Bank details along with a cancelled cheque for payment through NEFT/RTGS.
7. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter.
8. In case any typing error/other clerical errors is noticed by the tenderer, in the tender documents, the same must be pointed out and got clarified before submission of offer, or else, BHEL's interpretation shall prevail & shall be binding on the tenderer.
9. The Tenderer should accept all terms & conditions of the tender unconditionally. Tenders with deviations from terms and conditions are likely to be rejected.
10. **Tenderers are requested to go through the scope of work, visit the site/location etc. and get fully acquainted with the work place and prevailing working conditions to get all their doubts clarified regarding the above work before submitting the offer. Engineer-in-charge's decision will be full and final in the event of any clarification. 11. The tenderers or their representative may attend the opening of Limited Tender, if they so desire. The tenders shall be opened on schedule date & time even if the bidders or their representative are not present.

B. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS: -

- 1) Tenders received late /in open condition/ not meeting the tender condition / incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected.
- 2) BHEL will not be responsible for the postal delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of Tenders by due date & time.
- 3) BHEL has the right to reject all or any of the tenders and accept any tender(s) irrespective of its / their being the lowest / highest.
- 4) The Bidder Must Submit a declaration (enclosed at Annexure –I), that the bidder has not been suspended / blacklisted by any organization.
- 5) No deviation certificate as per Annexure –II (enclosed) must be signed and stamped.
- 6) Bidder must submit the bidder's details in the enclosed format (Annexure-III).
- 7) The offer of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offer of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of the banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com
- 8) The Tenderers are required to quote for the complete scope of work. Tenders for part of the work or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- 9) Rates/amount quoted by the bidder will be firm for the contract period or extended period of contract. No price variation and escalation due to increase in labour / material cost will be allowed.
- 10) The Rates/amount quoted by the bidder are deemed to be inclusive of all and any other incidental works required to complete the work and inclusive of all the taxes including GST.
- 11) The rate should be indicated both in words and figures. All entries in the Tenders must be written in ink or typewritten. Over-writing should be avoided. Corrections, if any, should be attested with signature by the bidder.
- 12) **OFFER VALIDITY:** Validity of offer will be **20 days** from the date of opening of the tender bid.
- 13) **EVALUTION CRITERIA:** Evaluation will be done on overall L-1 rate inclusive of all including all taxes and duties (i.e. **on Sl.No.-6 of Price Format**). In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/ draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative (s). Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final and binding.

- 14) **CORRECTION OF ARITHMETIC ERRORS:** Provided that the bid is substantially responsive, BHEL shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:
- If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the BHEL there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
 - If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected.
 - If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (a) and (b) above.
 - In case, gross total price does not match with the total of item wise breakup, the highest price so calculated shall be considered for evaluation but in case of order, the same shall be placed at the lowest price.**
 - If any bidder does not accept the correction of errors, their bids are liable to be disqualified.
- 15) If GST is applicable to the vendor then the vendor should provide the GST registration Certificate also.
- 16) **CONTRACT PERIOD:** The contract period for providing the services will be for five days. The tentative period of services will be from 18th November 2023 to 23rd November 2023.
- 17) **COMPLETION PERIOD:** All the arrangement with proper setting shall be completed latest by as per given below

Lunch: - 12:30 PM
Dinner: - 8:00 PM
- 18) **QUANTITY VARIATION:** The excess variation in quantity of any item mentioned in the BOQ may vary 25 % and can be reduce upto any extent as per site requirement as per the direction of Engineer in charge during execution of work due to site requirement.
- 19) **SUBLETING:** The Contractor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the full work or any part thereof to any other person/company/organization. In case it is found that the work has been subletted, the contract shall be terminated immediately & Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
- 20) The contractor should have PF code number & ESI code number before the start of work. However, in case of not having any or both the documents, the contractor shall arrange & submit the documents before claiming bill.
- 21) Accommodation in any manner will not be provided to the workers of the contractor deployed in the execution of work.
- 22) **WATER & ELECTRICITY:** Water and electricity shall be supplied to the contractor by BHEL subject to the following conditions: -
- Water & Electricity shall be provided free of cost.
 - Contractor shall make his/ their own arrangement of water/ electricity connection and laying of pipelines/ connection from existing main of source of supply as directed by Engineer in charge.
 - BHEL do not guaranty to maintain uninterrupted supply of water/ electricity and it will be incumbent on the contractor to make alternative arrangement for proper supply of the same at his/ their own cost in the event of any break down in the government water/ electricity mains so that the progress of his/ their work is not held up for the want of the same. No claim of damage or refund will be entertained on account of such break down.

23) TAXES AND DUTIES:

- i) To enable BHEL to avail GST input tax credit, contractor shall submit GST compliant Tax invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under invoice Rules of GST Law. Payment shall be made to the contractor only after submission of GST complaint Tax invoice. The successful bidder shall raise GST compliant invoice affixing GSTIN of BHEL's unit availing the services.
- ii) BHEL reserves the right to protect its interest against any loss on account of availability of GST credit.
- iii) GSTIN of BHEL is "09AAACB4146P2ZC".
- iv) Any new/ change in statutory levy as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.
- v) Payment to the contractor will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the contractor by BHEL.
- vi) Invoice submitted should be in the format as specified under GST Laws viz. all details as mentioned in Invoice Rules like GSTIN registration number, invoice number, quantity, rate, value, taxes with nomenclature – CGST, SGST, IGST mentioned separately, HSN (Harmonized System of Nomenclature) Code/ SAC (Services Accounting Code) Code etc.
- vii) The Contractor has to give an undertaking that GST as mentioned in the invoice has been/ will be paid and also file returns as per respective extant rule.

24) PAYMENTS TERMS:

- i) Payment shall be made for the actual executed quantity of items, i.e. actual no. of plates/ items provided/ consumed by the participants.
- ii) No advance payment or the payment for mobilization of work will be made to the contractor.
- iii) All payment will be subject to deduction of taxes at source as per rules.
- iv) Any tax incurred on purchase of materials by the contractor in respect of this contract shall be treated as included in the charges and BHEL will not entertain any additional claim whatsoever in this respect.
- v) Payment shall be made to contractor within 45 days from the date of submission of GST complaint Tax invoice as mentioned above and other relevant documents.
- vi) The successful bidder shall submit the bank details along with the cancelled cheque for NEFT/RTGS.

25) L.D. FOR BAD QUALITY OF SERVICES & FOOD ITEMS AND DELAY IN SERVICES:

- a) In case the quality of services & food items offered are not found satisfactory an L.D. of up to 10% of total value will be deducted from the bill. For finalization of L. D. Engineer-In-Charges decision shall be final and binding on contractor.
- b) All the arrangement with proper setting shall be completed latest by as per given below:
 - i) Breakfast: - 7:15AM
 - ii) Lunch: - 12:30 PM
 - iii) Dinner: - 8:00 PM

Any delay from the prescribed time table in providing catering services, will not be accepted and 0.5 % of total value per delay of 10 minutes from the prescribed time will be deducted from the bill. However, after delay of half an hour from the prescribed time table in providing the catering services, the LD of 10 % of total value will be deducted from the bill and BHEL shall have the right without any prejudice to get the work done through any other alternate agency at the risk and cost of Contractor. The additional cost including loss, if any incurred by BHEL will be recovered from the Contractor. Further, BHEL shall have the right to terminate the Contract effective immediately by giving written notice to the Service Provider.

26) SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- a) The security deposit shall be collected from the successful tenderer. The rate of Security Deposit will be **5% of work order value**. The security deposit should be collected before start of work by the contractor.
- b) Security deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:

- ii) Pay order / demand draft in favour of BHEL.
- iii) Local cheques of schedule banks, subject to realization.
- iv) Securities available from Post Offices such as National Saving Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (Certificate should be held in the name of the contractor furnishing the security and duly pledged in favour of BHEL and discharged on the back).
- v) Bank Guarantee from Schedule Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
- vi) Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) issued by Schedule Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The FDR should be in the name of the contractor, A/C BHEL, duly discharged on the back.
- vii) Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However, in such cases at least 50% of the Security Deposit should be deposited before start of the work and balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
- viii) The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

(Acceptance of Security Deposit against Sl. No. (iv) & (vi) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith).

- c) The security deposit will be released only after completion of work.
- d) Failure to pay the security deposit shall be treated as failure to discharge the duties under the contract and may result in cancellation of the contract and the contractor shall be liable to compensate BHEL for any losses incurred by BHEL. BHEL reserves the right to appropriate any part / whole of the amount of the security deposit without prejudice to other claims against the contractor for losses suffered by BHEL due to failures on the part of the contractor, due to termination of contract or contractor becoming dis-qualified because of liquidation / insolvency. The decision of BHEL in respect of such losses, damages, charges, expenses or costs, shall be final and binding to the contractor.
- e) In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (Repo rate + 4%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder.
- 27) **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:** BHEL may terminate the contract earlier by giving written notice of termination to the successful tenderer, if the successful tenderer does not remedy a failure in performance of their obligation under the contract or without assigning any reason and without prejudice to the rights of the Company to recover any amount becoming due under this Contract. In such a case, the Contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation thereof. The decision of BHEL about the failure on the part of the Contractor shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

- 28) **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT ON DEATH:** Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the contractor dies, the accepting officer shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contractor's survivors.
- 29) **RECOVERY FROM CONTRACTOR:** Whenever under the contract, any sum of money shall be recoverable from or payable by the contractor, the same may be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the contractor under the contract or under any other contract with BHEL or from his security deposit, or the contractor shall pay the claim on demand without any terms & conditions.
- 30) **POST TECHNICAL AUDIT OF WORK AND BILLS:** BHEL reserves the right to carry out a post payment audit and technical examination of the work and final bill including all supporting vouchers, abstracts etc. and to enforce recovery of any sums becoming due as a result thereof in the manner provided into the proceeding sub-paragraph provided however, that no such recovery shall be enforced after three years of passing the final bill.
- 31) **ARBITRATION / CONCILIATION:** In the event of any dispute arising between the parties hereafter referred as BHEL and Contractor in respect of or connected with this contract, General & Special terms & conditions of tender, then the same shall be referred to Arbitration and Arbitrator will be nominated by the Head of Administration of BHEL Corp. Office, New Delhi, whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. However, any differences or doubt pertaining to meaning/ interpretation of any phrase word used in terms or in the schedule of services, their nature and manner of rendering of such services shall be the excepted matter and be referred to the Head of Administration of BHEL Corp. Office, New Delhi, whose decision shall be the final and binding. The provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification and re-enactment thereof will apply to such arbitration provided however, in all matters the venue of proceedings will be Delhi and only Delhi or appropriate Courts will have jurisdiction over the same.
- 32) **RISK CLAUSE:** In case the contractor do not accept the work awarded to him or do not turn up after the award of work, BHEL shall have the right without any prejudice to get the work done through any other alternate agency at the risk and cost of Contractor. The additional cost including loss, if any incurred by BHEL will be recovered from the Contractor.

B. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. All materials/ items including cleaned utensil & fuel for cooking of food etc. shall be arranged by the contractor.
2. The quantity of each food items should be sufficient for Kabaddi players. The food items should be served in **buffet system with unlimited quantity of each items for 200 persons.**
3. There should be Sufficient number of Electric Toaster to serve breads for 200 nos. Kabaddi Players during Breakfast of every Day.
4. The full quantity of Bone china plates or Melamine plates & other necessary utensils should be available to cater 200 persons before the start of Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. However, tables with cover & frills, chairs with cover and space for cooking shall be provided by BHEL. Bidders may visit the site location prior to submitting their offer.
5. It will be ensured by the caterer that all eatables are of best quality, fresh and hygienic. Raw material like Olive Oil, Ghee, Milk, Atta, Masalas, Dals will have to be procured of excellent quality bearing Agmark / ISI mark only. Only fresh vegetable shall be used.
6. The eatables / snack items shall be of standard size. Vegetables and other food items should be cooked and prepared properly with right amount of ingredients.
7. The Spoons and other cutlery/ Dongas/ Paper plates/ Napkins / Ban marry etc. of good quality shall be arranged by the caterer.

8. None of the items of Single Use Plastic (SUP) shall be used during the function.
9. Sufficient number of waiters are to be there for prompt service. The waiters deployed for serving the food & water shall be well dressed, in uniform, neat & clean. If any waiter is found not good in appearance, he will not be allowed to be deployed.
10. The contactor shall deploy a supervisor for supervision of full arrangement. He will follow all the instruction of Engineer-in-charge.
11. Washing of utensils and reusing them will not be permitted during the same service time.
12. Two sets of serving counter would be operational at the same time.
13. After completion of function the contractor shall remove all the arrangement at the earliest.
14. The Lunch and Dinner Menu may be interchange.
15. All materials/ items including cleaned utensil & fuel for cooking of food etc. shall be arranged by the contractor.
16. The full quantity of plates & other necessary utensils should be available to cater 200 persons.
17. It will be ensured by the caterer that all eatables are of best quality and hygienic.
18. The eatables / snack items shall be of standard size.
19. The Dongas/ Paper plates/ Napkins etc. of good quality shall be arranged by the caterer.
20. None of the items of Single Use Plastic (SUP) shall be used during the function.
