PART 'A' - TECHNO- COMMERCIAL BID

A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BIDDERS:

- 1. The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document. Only one set of tender document duly signed & stamped on each page shall be submitted as detailed further. Tenderer should note specifically that all pages of tender document, including the NIT page for this particular tender shall be submitted by them (after signing/ stamping on each page) as a part of their offer. Price shall not be mentioned by them anywhere in the techno-commercial portion of offer, except in the relevant price bid and submitted in separate sealed envelope. In case of any clarification, bidder may contact this office.
- 2. Tender documents are also available on BHEL web site (www.bhel.com) & on CPP Portal (http://eprocure.gov.in/cppp/) which can be downloaded and used as tender document for submitting the bid.
- 3. All documents submitted by the Tenderer in his tender may be accompanied with a covering letter giving index interlinking all the documents.
- 4. Documents not signed & stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidder shall not be accepted and considered for evaluation of bid.
- 5. Tender must be submitted in two parts, i.e., (i) Techno-Commercial Bid along with un-price bid (Annexure-I) and (ii) Price Bid. The tenderer must submit their tenders in three separate sealed envelopes prominently super scribed as 'EMD Deposit', Part A 'Techno- commercial bid' and Part-B 'Price Bid' along with NIT No. & due date written on each of the envelope. These three separate envelopes shall together be kept in fourth envelop super scribed with name of Work, NIT No. & due date of opening.
- Techno-commercial bid should contain all the documents in proof of Pre- qualifying criteria, signed tender document having NIT page, Instructions for tenderer, general conditions, Special Conditions, un-price bid, all the annexure duly filled & signed by the tenderer and the envelope containing EMD.
- 7. Bid without requisite Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will not be considered.
- 8. Bidder(s) has to provide at least one valid email ID for fast communications. Two email IDs are desirable. All communications related to the tender shall be sent to these email IDs and hard copies will not be sent. Such communication(s) shall be deemed as delivered and final. Bidder(s) has to regularly view their email and also remain in touch with the Notice Inviting Authority to remain updated.
- 9. The tenderer shall submit the Bank details along with a cancelled cheque for payment through NEFT/RTGS.
- 10. Price Bid should contain only the "Part-B, Price Bid Format" after quoting the rates as specified in the Price bid format.
- 11. On the date of opening of tender, only Techno-Commercial Bid shall alone be opened.
- 12. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter (except for the refund of EMD).
- 13. In case any typing error/other clerical errors is noticed by the tenderer, in the tender documents, the same must be pointed out and got clarified before submission of offer, or else, BHEL's interpretation shall prevail & shall be binding on the tenderer.
- 14. The Tenderer should accept all terms & conditions of the tender unconditionally. Tenders with deviations from terms and conditions are likely to be rejected.
- 15. In case any document required as per PQR is not submitted in techno-commercial bid (part-A) the party shall be asked to submit the same within stipulated time by email, etc. If the document(s) is/are not received within stipulated time the offer may be rejected.

The tenderers or their representative may attend the opening of techno-commercial bid (Part-A) and the technically qualified tenderers or their representative may attend the opening of Price bid (Part B), if they so desire. The tenders (both the parts) shall be opened on schedule date & time even if the bidders or their representative are not present.

B. PRE QUALIFYING CRITERIA:

- 1) The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs 63,000.00 (Rupees Sixty-Three Thousands Only) only in the following forms in favour of BHEL, payable at New Delhi, must be submitted in a separate envelope:
 - a) Cash deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening)
 - b) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening)
 - c) Banker's cheque/ Pay order/ Demand draft, in favour of BHEL (along with offer)
 - d) Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Bidder, a/c BHEL).

Tender not accompanied with EMD will not be accepted except for MSE Suppliers who have submitted valid NSIC certificate along with tender's Techno-commercial Part I- Bid.

- 2) The bidder should have valid PAN. copy of PAN card has to be submitted along with bid.
- 3) Physiotherapist should have following minimum Qualifications:
 - a) Educational Qualification: Should have a recognized qualification (Bachelors*/ Master Degree in Physiotherapy from Institute/ University recognized by Central/ State Govt.) in Physiotherapy (Copy of valid Degree has to be submitted along with bid). *BPT awarded from recognized University.

Note: BPT is the minimum qualification required.

- b) Past Experience: Should have an experience of at least 05 years after BPT or atleast 03 years after MPT for providing the physiotherapy services in any Pvt. Institution/ Hospital/ Govt. or Public Institution or in his/ her Independent establishment during the last 07 years ending 30.11.2020. (Copy of duly certified experience certificate has to be submitted along with bid).
- c) Should have valid registration with council/ Indian association of physiotherapy/ any other body duly recognized by state government/ central government. (Copy of valid registration certificate has to be submitted along with bid).
- d) <u>Financial capability: -</u> Self-certified copy of ITR or certificate from Chartered Accountant for last three financial years (FY 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20) having minimum average annual income of Rs 4.7 Lakhs.

C. Other Documents to be submitted along with bid: -

- a) Complete tender document in all respects duly signed & stamped on each and every page by the authorized signatory of the bidder as a token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions of tender.

D. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT WORK:

In view to provide the freedom of work, independency, and minimum interference from BHEL, BHEL will only provide to the Physiotherapist a portion of the already constructed building along with already installed fixtures, fittings, electricity and water supply. The available space and infrastructure can be examined by the Physiotherapist before submitting the tender with prior permission from BHEL.

1) All arrangements, which are not in the scope of BHEL, as mentioned in the tender document, but required by the Physiotherapist for smooth functioning of the services has to be done by the Physiotherapist. Any modification/alteration/ addition etc. in the already constructed building have to be done by the Physiotherapist at its own cost and risk after seeking approval from BHEL.

2) The Physiotherapist has to procure at its own cost, all medical and non-medical equipments, stationary, drugs, dressings, consumables, non-consumables and any other material or service

required to run the Physiotherapy services.

3) The Physiotherapist shall be provided fully furnished dedicated space (as per dimensions shown in Anneuxre – VI). The room is adequately lighted, properly ventilated, affording protection from all kinds of weather etc. The space provided to the Physiotherapist will not be utilized for any other purpose rather than running & managing the physiotherapy services only.

4) BHEL shall provide Housekeeping, Cleaning and Maintenance to the Physiotherapist for the

proposed centre.

- 5) The arrangement of electricity and water supply shall be made available to the Physiotherapist by BHEL. In case there is any failure in the electricity or water supply, the adhoc or emergency arrangement for the proposed services has to be made by the Physiotherapist at own cost before starting the service.
- 6) The Physiotherapist has to procure all computers, telephones, internet connection and all other required facilities at its own Cost.
- 7) If Hospital/ Agency submits the tender, then the Physiotherapist, whose educational documents are submitted along with this bid in response to PQR, shall provide the services for entire period of contract.
- 8) PHYSIOTHERAPY CENTRE TIMINGS: Timing for operation of the Physiotherapy Centre shall be from 09:00 AM to 05:30PM (at least 08 Working Hrs.) from Monday to Friday and 1st half of all Saturday.

9) PHYSIOTHERAPY CENTRE CLOSING DAYS: Physiotherapy Centre shall be closed on Sunday, National Holidays, BHEL' Holidays and 2nd half of all Saturdays.

- 10) The Physiotherapist has to provide all services to the BHEL beneficiaries on priority basis only after referred by the BHEL Medical officer. The Physiotherapist has to keep all equipment maintained and in working condition.
- 11) All waste should be disposed-off as per the standard guidelines issued by the State Government/ Central Government from time to time.

12) Running cost of all facilities including staff salaries, if any, to be borne by the Physiotherapist.

13) Physiotherapist should make alternative arrangements in the event of breakdown of the services at his/her own cost. In case the Physiotherapist fails to make such arrangement and any damages claimed by the patient/BHEL shall be the responsibility of the Physiotherapist.

14) Physiotherapist must keep all records in the computerized form and should be able to provide all statistics and other records in the soft copy to the administration on demand.

15) Physiotherapist must obtain insurance cover for all its equipment/ employees at his/her own cost.

16) Physiotherapist will ensure remedial measures with regard to any deficiency in services pointed out by the authorities.

17) BHEL beneficiaries reporting to the BHEL institution must be attended to by the Physiotherapist without delay on the prescribed prescription/form issued by BHEL, along with attested signature of the patient/ attendant over it. The Physiotherapist will undertake the services and maintain records for billing purposes. The Physiotherapist will keep check on the patient's Identity.

- 18) Physiotherapist will be authorized to make changes in fittings, cablings, etc. as per requirement of operating equipments with permission from the administration.
- 19) No modifications of structure will be allowed without permission from the administration.
- 20) Any medico-legal issues arising in the course of or out of treatment of patients will be the responsibility of Physiotherapist.
- 21) Provision of Consumer Protection Act, RTI act etc. shall be applicable to the Physiotherapist also.
- 22) The contractor should get the character/ antecedence of all the workforce deployed by them at the work premises, verified by the Police authorities from engaging & deploying them in BHEL premises.
- 23) The Contractor will have full and exclusive liability for Wages, PF, ESI, Bonus, Insurance, Uniform etc.; for the personnel deployed by the contractor and other obligation referred under the law now and thereafter imposed by the Government / Local Bodies. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the timely payment of wages, provident fund, bonus or any other benefits payable under the aforesaid Acts. Laws and regulations to the Workforce engaged by him at the work premises of the BHEL. BHEL shall not be responsible for these payments or any other liability on this account. The Contractor shall also indemnify and compensate BHEL for any liability incurred by BHEL, if any, including costs incurred thereon. In that event, the nominated officer of BHEL shall be entitled to recover the amount so paid, from the contractor, including forfeiture of the Security Deposit; and, if the sum so payable and / the Security Deposit is less than BHEL's claim, it shall be lawful for BHEL to recover the balance amount as a debt from the Contractor.

E. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS: -

- 1) Tenders received late /in open condition/without EMD/ not meeting the tender condition / incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected.
- 2) BHEL will not be responsible for the postal delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of Tenders by due date & time.
- 3) BHEL has the right to reject all or any of the tenders and accept any tender(s) irrespective of its / their being the lowest / highest.
- 4) If any information/ documents submitted by the tenderer are found false/fake at any stage, the tender will be cancelled and Earnest Money deposited (EMD) shall be forfeited.
- 5) The offer of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offer of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of the banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.in
- 6) The bidder shall quote the discount percentage in English language and international numerals ONLY. The rates shall be entered in figures as well as in words. Rates shall be considered up to TWO decimal points only. Digits beyond TWO decimal points will be ignored and not rounded off. No representations on this account shall be entertained.
- 7) Currencies of Bid & Payment: Indian Rupees (₹) only.
- 8) The Tenderers are required to quote for the complete scope of services. Tenders for part of the services or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- 9) Discount percentage quoted by the bidder will be firm for the contract period or extended period of contract. No price variation and escalation due to increase in labour / material cost will be allowed.
- 10) The discount percentage quoted by the bidder are after considering all cost, cost of site clearance and any other incidental works required to execute the services and inclusive of all including GST.
- 11) Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid, etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature(s) of person(s) signing the bid else bid shall be liable for rejection.
- 12) If the discount percentage is not filled in the Price Bid and is not as per the requirement of the tender document, the same shall be omitted from evaluation.

- 14) **VALIDITY OF RATES:** Validity of rates will be **90 days** from the date of opening of the technocommercial bid.
- 15) **EVALUATION CRITERIA: EVALUTION CRITERIA**: The criteria of evaluation of technocommercial bids will be on the basis of documents submitted by the bidders. Along with the scrutiny of the documents in line with tender terms & conditions, BHEL reserves the right to visit the dispensaries/ clinic/ hospital of the Physiotherapist to assess and confirm their credibility. BHEL may finalize successful tenderer by **opening of sealed price bid**. Date of opening of sealed Price Bid will be intimated, by e-mail separately to the tenderers who qualify in the Techno-Commercial bid. The decision of BHEL will be final in this regard. The order will be placed on the physiotherapist, who quotes maximum discount percentage on the BHEL scheduled rates along with the payment of License fee as per clause no. 22 below. Evaluation of bid will be on total cost to 'BHEL'.

In the event of Sealed Price Bid opening and if more than one bidder having identical lowest amount of Price Bid and there is a tie amongst the bidders, the respective bidders would be asked to submit their revised rates. This process would continue till the distinct L1 rates is arrived

- 16) **CORRECTION OF ARITHMETIC ERRORS**: Provided that the bid is substantially responsive, BHEL shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:
 - a) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
 - b) If any bidder does not accept the correction of errors, their bids are liable to be disqualified.
- 17) You should ensure the equipment to be provided under the contract against perils like fire, earthquake, theft, high voltage etc. i.e. your own cost.
- 18) L.D. FOR INFERIOR QUALITY OF SERVICES: BHEL reserves the right to inspect the services of physiotherapy treatment provided to the employees of BHEL. In case BHEL finds the Services as unsatisfactory the contractor will be penalized as per follows: -

- 19) **CONTRACT PERIOD:** The contract period will be for **two years** from the date of award which can further be extended for one year on the same rates, terms & conditions on the mutual agreement between the company and the Physiotherapist on satisfactory performance of the contract and will be decided later.
- 20) **SUBLETING:** The Contractor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the full work or any part thereof to any other person/company/organization.

21) TAXES AND DUTIES:

- a) Price shall be all inclusive, except GST. The amount towards GST shall be indicated separately as specified in the price format.
- b) To enable BHEL to avail GST Input Tax Credit (ITC), Service Provider shall submit GST Compliant Tax Invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under Invoice Rules of CGST Rules, 2017 as amended from time to time. Such invoice shall be submitted within prescribed time limit in the name of BHEL, Estate Office, Sector-17, Noida.
- c) Service Provider shall ensure strict compliance under GST Act & Rules so that Input Tax Credit is available to BHEL.

- d) In case of any loss to BHEL on account of non-compliance by vendor, the same shall be to Service Provider's account. BHEL has a right to take necessary steps to protect its interest at the time of
- e) Any Statutory Changes as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.
- While making the payment, statutory deductions as applicable, shall be made by BHEL. Payment to the Service Provider will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act and GST as applicable, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the vendor by BHEL.

22) LICENSE FEE:

- a) The Physiotherapist shall pay a sum of Rs 11,160.00 per month to BHEL and shall also provide medical treatment to the employees of the BHEL, both serving and retired and their eligible family members, at a discount of percentage as quoted in the price bid on BHEL Schedule rates.
- b) During the tenure of the contract period, the license fees of Rs 11,160.00 shall stand enhanced on each yearly anniversary of the agreement @ 5%, which shall be rounded off to the next higher ten rupees.

23) PAYMENT TERMS:

- a) The Physiotherapist/ Contractor shall raise the bill on BHEL at the end of every month for services provided for the respective month.
- b) Bills raised by the Physiotherapist/ Contractor shall be certified by the official in-charge of BHEL and the payments will be made within 21 days from the date of receipt of GST complaint Tax invoice (if applicable) having no discrepancy and other relevant documents.
- c) The contractor shall not be entitled to any interest with respect to any money which may be due to him from BHEL.
- d) The quoted rates will remain firm during the contract period except taxes as applicable by the Government against documentary evidence. The successful bidder shall submit the bank details along with the cancelled cheque for NEFT/RTGS.
- 24) Accommodation in any manner will not be provided to the workers of the contractor deployed in the execution of work.
- 25) No party shall be permitted to tender for work in BHEL in which any of their near relatives is an employee connected with the award and execution of the contract. They shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with them in any capacity or subsequently employed by them and who are near relatives of any employee of the BHEL. Any violation of this condition which comes to the Notice of the BHEL after the contract is awarded will entitle the BHEL to treat the contractors as having committed a breach of contract and to exercise all the rights and remedies available to the BHEL on account thereof.

If the performance in whole or in part or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by any reason of FM for a period exceeding 90 (Ninety) days, either party may at its option terminate the contract without any financial repercussion on either side.


