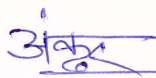

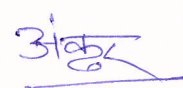

I. Scope of Work:

1. 600 nos. of green potted plants (along with earthen pots) of good quality as per list given below are to be supplied and maintained by contractor at different locations in our office complex.
 - a. Indoor Plants like Areca Palm/ Lady Palm/ Money plant/ Oxycardium / Epipremnum aureum / Croton / Aglaonema crispum / Chlorophytum comosum / Arocaria / English Ivy/ Boston Fern / Crotons
 - b. Outdoor plants like Ficus Benjamina / Morpankhi/ Rubber Plant/ Kochia plant/ seasonal flowers like Gulawadi, Dehilia, Rose, Sunflower etc.
2. In case of any deterioration in the health of any of the plant(s), the same will be replaced immediately. If not replaced within 2 days no charges will be payable for such plants until the same is replaced.
3. The gardener (mali) will be visiting our office on daily basis for cleaning the dust from the leaves, watering the plants and for periodical manuring. Fresh water for watering will be provided by BHEL.
4. The cost of all the material, cartage, staff salary, conveyance charges, etc. involved in the above arrangements will be borne by the contractor.
5. Pots will be painted by contractor's staff on as and when required basis.
6. After expiry of contract, the contractor shall clear the site by taking out all the potted plants supplied by them at their own risk and cost.

II. Instructions to Bidders:

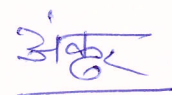
1. Bidders must go through all **annexures** carefully before submitting the bid.
2. The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document. One set of tender document duly filled, signed and stamped on each page shall be submitted as detailed further. Tenderer should note specifically that all the pages of tender document, including the NIT page for this particular tender shall be submitted by them (after signing/ stamping on each page) as a part of their offer. In case of any clarification, bidder may contact this office.
3. The tenderer should accept all terms & conditions of the tender unconditionally. Bids with deviations from terms and conditions of the tender shall be rejected.
4. In case any typing error/other clerical errors is noticed by the tenderer, in the tender documents, the same must be pointed out and got clarified before submission of offer, or else, BHEL's interpretation shall prevail and shall be binding on the tenderer.
5. No overwriting / correction in tender documents by tenderer shall be allowed. However, if correction is unavoidable, the same must be countersigned.
6. Only rate shall be quoted in Price Bid format and nothing else. Rates must be quoted in figures as well as in words. In case the rates in figures differ from the rates written in words, then the rates in words will be treated as valid rate. Any other terms and conditions mentioned in the Price Bid shall make the offer liable for rejection.



7. The price must be quoted in the enclosed Price Format Only. Price bids containing rates not written in words shall be liable for rejection.
8. The prices quoted should be firm and no revision of prices will be entertained after the tender is opened.
9. Tender must be submitted in a sealed envelope which has to be super scribed with NIT no. and due date written on the envelope and the bidder contact details.
10. Quotation shall be received up to 1430 hours on 10.01.2023, tenders received late /in open condition/ not meeting the tender condition / incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected.
11. Validity of offer will be 90 days from the date of opening of tender.
12. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter.
13. A bidder may visit BHEL office on any working day from 20.12.2022 to 09.01.2023 between 0900 Hrs to 1700 Hrs. Any queries regarding this tender may be clarified from Engineer (Administration) over telephone no. 011-41793301 or at email anks@bhel.in.
14. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments and clarifications to this Tender will be hosted in web page, www.bhel.com and not in the newspaper. Bidders shall keep themselves updated with all such amendments.

III. Pre-qualification Criteria:

1. EMD amount of ₹7,200.00 (Rupees Seven Thousand Two Hundred only) needs to be deposited through NEFT. The bank account details of BHEL for NEFT are enclosed as **Annexure V**. The bidder is required to enclose a copy of the acknowledgement of NEFT payment along with their bids. Bids without EMD will not be accepted and shall not be considered for further evaluation.
The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after award of work to the successful bidder. No interest shall be payable on EMD amount.
The EMD shall be forfeited in case of:
 - i) After opening the tender, the bidder revokes his bid within the validity period or increases his earlier quoted rates.
 - ii) The successful bidder does not commence the work within the period as per LOI / contract. In case the LOI / contract is silent in this regard then within 15 days after the award of contract.
2. The bidder should have PAN card and GST Registration No.
3. The bidder's average annual financial turnover during the last three financial years ending 31st March 2022 must be at least ₹1.08 Lakhs. Bidder needs to submit CA certificate, in original, stating the turnovers of last three financial years. CA certified documents must bear CA registration number.
In case, a bidding firm has been established less than three years ago, the average turnover shall be calculated by dividing the sum of respective turnovers by 3.
4. Copy of acknowledgements of IT return of last three financial years i.e., FY 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 is desirable.



5. The bidder must have an experience of having successfully completed similar Job / services during last 7 years ending on 30.11.2022 should be either of the following:
- i) Three similar completed jobs / services with value not less than ₹ 1,44,000 each.
 - OR
 - ii) Two similar completed jobs / services with value not less than ₹ 1,80,000 each.
 - OR
 - iii) One similar completed job / service with value not less than ₹ 2,88,000.

“Similar Job / service” refers to “Horticulture related services”.

Only work orders and related work completion certificates from the clients shall be submitted as proof against Sl. No. 5 of PQR. For example: If you are qualifying as per Sl. No. 5 (ii), only work orders and related work completion certificates of 2 clients each costing not less than ₹ 1,80,000 shall be furnished. The certificates shall be issued by competent authority with his / her contact details mentioned, for verification purpose. BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of the certificates of the clients.

6. The bidder must have a registered/ licensed well developed Nursery within 15 KMs from BHEL Lodhi office located at Integrated Office Complex at Lodhi Road for ensuring of fresh plants and providing smooth services.

Procedure for submission of bids

The bidders must submit their duly completed offers in a sealed envelope (Envelope #1) prominently super-scribed as “Offer for supply and maintenance of potted plants at BHEL, Lodhi Road” followed by tender reference and last date for submission of tender.

Inside sealed Envelope #1, two separate sealed envelopes viz. Envelope #2 and Envelope #3 are to contain two parts of the tender “Part-I: Techno-commercial Bid” and “Part-II: Price Bid” respectively. Both the sealed envelopes are to be super-scribed with “Part-I” or “Part-II” whichever is applicable, tender reference and details of the bidder.

A. Part-1: Techno-commercial Bid and EMD (Envelope #2)

The techno-commercial bid shall comprise of

1. Copy of Tender Enquiry Document duly signed in blue ink and stamped on each page as token of acceptance of tender conditions.
2. A copy of Price Bid format (**Annexure IV**) duly signed and stamped but without the prices.
3. Acknowledgement of deposit of EMD of ₹7,200.00 (Rupees Seven Thousand Two Hundred only) by way of NEFT in favour of BHEL, New Delhi, must be enclosed in Part-I envelope.
4. Copy of PAN and GST Registration Certificate duly signed and stamped by the bidder.
5. A copy of a cancelled cheque of the bidder.
6. Signed and stamped copy of CA certificate stating turnovers of last three financial years i.e. FY 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22. In case of unavailability of document for FY 2021-22, CA certificate for FY 2018-19 may be furnished.

7. Copy of acknowledgements of IT return of last three financial years i.e. FY 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 (desirable).
8. Copies of work orders indicating the duration of contract, quantum of business done along with certificates of successful completion in support of proof of experience for the jobs/ services executed by the bidders during last 7 years ending on 30.11.2022 as against Sl. No. 5 of Pre-Qualification Criteria. BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of the documents submitted against fulfilling the PQR criteria.

All the documents in this envelope should be self-attested by the bidder with required stamp. This envelope should be super-scribed as **"Part-I: Ref. ID/ HRM/ Pots-S&M-ENQ"** followed by **bidder details**.

The Prices **should not be** mentioned in the price format in this envelope.

B. Part-II: Price Bid (Envelope #3)

The price bid in the enclosed **"Price format" (Annexure-IV)** needs to be in sealed envelope #3. This envelope should be super-scribed as **"Part-II: Ref. ID/ HRM/ Pots-S&M-ENQ"** followed by **bidder details**.

The offer, complete in all respects, has to positively be dropped, on or before 1430 Hours of 10.01.2023, in the tender box kept at reception area of BHEL office at following address:

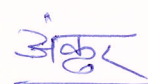
The offers received on or before 1430 Hours of 10.01.2023 shall be considered for opening of Techno-commercial bid scheduled at 1500 Hours on 10.01.2023 in presence of the bidders who may like to be present. Offers received after specified time of submission shall be liable for rejection.

BHEL also reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

Before submitting the offers, the bidders are advised to visit and survey the site. For any clarifications regarding the tender, kindly contact the undersigned at 011-41793301.

IV. Evaluation criteria:

1. On the date of opening of tender, only technical bid shall be opened in presence of the bidders who would like to be present.
2. The techno-commercial bids i.e. Part-I submitted by all the bidders will be evaluated first. After techno-commercial evaluation, only the Price Bids of the bidders who qualify the techno-commercial evaluation will be opened on a subsequent date. The date of opening of Price Bids shall be intimated to the concerned bidders through email separately.



3. In the Price Bid, the bidders are required to quote monthly rate in the Price Bid Format (**Annexure IV**) in the space provided.
4. The ranking of the bidders shall be made on the basis of total amount calculated on the basis of item wise rates quoted by the bidders.
5. In the event of more than one bidder having quoted identical lowest rates and there is a tie amongst the bidders, the respective bidders would be asked to submit their revised rates. This process would continue till the distinct L1 (lowest) rate is arrived.

Work will be awarded to the L1 bidder and final decision of BHEL on evaluation of bidders shall be binding on all the bidders.

V. General Terms & Conditions:

1. Tenders received late /in open condition/ not meeting the tender condition / incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected.
2. BHEL will not be responsible for the postal delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of Tenders by due date & time.
3. The offer of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offer of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of the banned firms is available on BHEL website www.bhel.com.
4. The bidders are required to quote for the complete scope of services in the Price Bid Format at **Annexure –IV**. Tenders for part of the services or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
5. Rates quoted by the bidder will be firm and inclusive of all except applicable GST which will be payable extra. No price variation and escalation due to increase in labour / material cost will be allowed.
6. The rate should be indicated both in words and figures. All entries in the Tender must be written in ink or typewritten. Over-writing should be avoided. Corrections, if any, should be attested with signature by the bidder.
7. **Validity of Offer:** Validity of offer will be 90 days from the date of opening of the techno-commercial bid.
8. **Quantity Variation:** The quantity of any item mentioned in the Price Format may vary $\pm$ 10% during execution of work as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.
9. **Subletting:** The Contractor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the full work or any part thereof to any other person/company/organization.
10. **Validity of Contract:** Validity of contract shall be 2 years from the date of start of work. The above contract may be short closed as per the requirement of BHEL with prior notice of one month.

11. **Payment:** 100% payment shall be made within 30 days from the day of receipt of original GST compliant invoice or completion of the work whichever is later.
12. **Taxes & duties:** The taxes and duties applicable on the contract have to be very clearly indicated in the price bid format Annexure IV. However, taxes and duties applicable at the time of generation of GST compliant invoice shall be payable by BHEL.
13. Security deposit (SD) of 5% of the order value shall be deposited by the successful bidder either within 07 (seven) days from the date of award of work or before start of contract whichever is earlier. SD can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However, in such case at least 50% of the SD shall be deposited within specified time and balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
If the successful bidder requests BHEL to adjust EMD amount towards SD then balance amount has to be deposited within the specified period. SD, without interest, shall be refunded after successful completion of contract period.
14. L.D. for bad Quality of Services: In case the services offered are not found satisfactory a 0.5 % per week subject to maximum 10% of total value will be deducted from the bill.
15. No excuses like hindrance because of extreme weather conditions, non-availability of labour and material etc. will be entertained for not providing services on time.
16. All necessary precautions with respect to safety at site and environmental aspects and their impacts shall have to be taken by the contractor for activities performed by his workers.
17. The contractor should ensure that their workforce shall be provided with all safety devices, tools and tackles required while working on the system and all safety precautions are adhered to by their workforce.
18. The contractor has to ensure that the workforce deployed under this contract is insured and BHEL shall have no liability towards them, in case of injury or death.
19. Work force of the contractor will not be entitled for any compensation for any loss/damage suffered by your work force deployed to execute the work under this contract. BHEL shall remain indemnified against any compensation that may arise out of any injury or death to any person deputed by you under this contract.
20. Termination of contract: If at any time the Service Provider defaults in proceeding with the work with due diligence and continues to do so or commit any default in complying any of the tender terms and conditions even after the notice in writing is given, BHEL may, without prejudice to any other right to remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to BHEL, terminate the contract by giving 15 days' notice in writing. The notice will be deemed to have been served as and when sent to the address given in the tender. In such a case, the Security Deposit of the contractor shall be forfeited.
21. BHEL also reserves the right to terminate the contract at any point of time without assigning any reason thereof.

22. In case of any dispute, the decision taken by BHEL Management will be final and binding on the contractor.
23. No party shall be permitted to tender for work in BHEL in which any of their near relatives is an employee connected with the award and execution of the contract. They shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with them in any capacity or subsequently employed by them and who are near relatives of any employee of the BHEL. Any violation of this condition which comes to the Notice of the BHEL after the work is awarded will entitle the BHEL to treat the contractors as having committed a breach of contract and to exercise all the rights and remedies available to the BHEL on account thereof.
24. **Recovery from Contractor:** Whenever under the contract, any sum of money shall be recoverable from or payable by the contractor, the same may be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the contractor under the contract or under any other contract with BHEL or from his security deposit, or the contract or shall pay the claim on demand without any terms & conditions.
25. **Arbitration:**
- a. In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of the execution of the Order/Contract or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties or in relation to interpretation of any provision between BHEL & Service Provider in any manner touching upon the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall (except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for therein) be referred to the arbitration of the person appointed by the competent authority of BHEL.
- Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.
- b. In case of order/contract on Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Govt. Deptt., the following clause shall be applicable - In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to by either party to the arbitration of one of the arbitrators in the department of public enterprises. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law secretary, Deptt. of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties hereto finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will bear equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the arbitrator.
26. **Laws governing the contract:** The Order/Contract shall be executed and governed by the laws of India and the courts of India alone shall have jurisdiction in respect of any matter arising under or in connection with the Order/Contract.

27. **Jurisdiction of court:** Courts at Delhi/New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract(s) to which these conditions are applicable.

28. Default/ breach of contract, insolvency and risk purchase

- a. If the Service Provider / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to / provide services covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Contractor (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitles the Court of debenture holder and creditors to appoint a receiver, liquidator or manager, the purchaser without prejudice to his right to recover any expenses, losses or damages to which the BHEL may be put to incur or sustain by reason of the Contractor's default or breach of Order/Contract shall be entitled to cancel the Order/Contract either in whole or portion thereof without compensation to the Contractor (Service Provider) and if BHEL so desires, may hire such services and in such manner as it deems appropriate, at the risk and cost of the Contractor (Service Provider) and the Contractor (Service Provider) shall be liable to the BHEL for any excess costs provided that the Contractor (Service Provider) shall continue the performance of the Order/Contract to the extent not cancelled under the provisions of this clause. The Contractor (Service Provider) shall on no account be entitled to any gain on such services.
- b. Cost of the service made by the BHEL/Service taker at the risk and cost of the contractor (Service Provider) shall be worked out after levying 30% overheads as departmental charges on the cost of services so hired.

29. Conflict of Interest

"A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
- c) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or

d) they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about. or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or

e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-assembly/ Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or

f) In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorise only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:

1. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
2. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal;

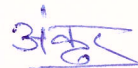

g) A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the Bid, or

h) In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing units, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders must proactively declare such sister/ common business/ management units in same/ similar line of business. "
