#### **B. Technical Terms and conditions:**

1. Contractor shall be equipped with a team having sufficient well-qualified, knowledgeable and having proven experience of E&C activities at site.
2. Contractor is responsible to employ required number of skilled workmen as per site requirements to complete the work in his scope as per site schedule & requirement.
3. Contractor will have to ensure that Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) requirements are clearly understood and faithfully implemented at all levels at site. They will have to ensure adequate safety precautions at site as per the statutory requirement and shall be entirely responsible for the complete safety of their workmen/employees. Necessary Personal Protection Equipment's (PPE's) (such as Helmets, Goggles, safety Belts, Gloves, First aid box etc.) shall be provided to worker/staff as per requirement during erection work. While execution of work, all COVID / pandemic related guideline as issued by local administration / Central government need to be followed at site.  
Any casualty or damage caused to the property or person by any untoward incidents while executing this contract will be at the contractor's risk and cost.
4. Bidder has to comply as well as obtain requisite license, if any, from the Central Govt./ State Govt. enforced by them time to time.
5. Please quote in Indian Rupee, (INR) offer received in other currency will not be acceptable.

**C. Scope of Contractor:**

1. Unloading of Material to be done at site, stacking in appropriate manner to be done by contractor to remain material in healthy condition.
2. Electricity, water and compressed air, if required for carrying out work against Sl. No. A1 & A2 under scope of work of NIT. Construction supply, Water & Compressed air at one point will be provided by customer. However, contractor will have to arrange required cable, water pipe & hose to get the required supply at working point.
3. Contractor shall furnish all labour, material, equipment, tools and tackles required for carrying out work against Sl. No. A1 & A2 under scope of work of NIT.
4. Installation, Commissioning & Testing of EV charger i.e. placing of EV Charger on the pedestal / Foundation. (Construction of foundation shall be in Customer's scope). This include Cable termination and necessary lugs for termination with sleeves (required lugs with sleeve is in EMRP's scope) and tools required i.e. crimping tool etc. shall be in contractor's scope.
5. Design, Supply and Erection of a Mini Canopy to avoid sun and rain exposure along with associated civil work (Construction of foundation shall be in Contractor's scope). Signage display/branding on Canopy.
6. All the instruments / equipment's required for carrying out work against Sl. No. A1 & A2 under scope of work of NIT shall be arranged by contractor. All the instruments / Equipment's used shall be of reputed make and shall have valid calibration certificate.
7. After receipt of intimation from BHEL, Contractor has to depute the team for execution of work including unloading of truck at site, Installation, commissioning and testing to be completed within ONE WEEK of site ready intimation by BHEL. Contractor will notify Customer's / BHEL concerned officer for any damage or missing items/parts.
8. Required consumables for carrying out above job are in vendors' scope.
9. Watch & ward of the site during the execution of the work shall be in contractor' scope.
10. In the event of halt in work for whatsoever reason, if BHEL requires for demobilization of contractor's team from site and re-deployment as per requirement then contractor has to do so after receipt of such information from BHEL in writing and hence, Contractor shall keep the provision for mobilization and redeployment in their scope for such contingencies
11. Customer can shift / re-locate the charger from one retail outlet to other retail outlet as per business needs. Contractor shall help in de-installation, shifting and re-installing the charger at new location. The charges for the same shall be dealt separately.
12. Contractor will help /support Customer to integrate EV Charger with Central server / Cloud for generating MIS monitoring sales performance.

- 1.4 Delivery Period:** After receipt of intimation from BHEL, Contractor has to depute the team for execution of work including unloading of truck at site, Installation, Commissioning and testing to be completed within ONE WEEK of site ready intimation by BHEL. Contractor will notify Customer's concerned officer for any damage or missing items/parts.

2.4 As per directives of CENTRAL VIGILANCE COMMISSION, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, one agent cannot represent two or more suppliers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender. ### **3. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**3.1** BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer and or award the work in full or part without assigning any reason.

**3.2** Tender should be free from over writing and erasers, additions if any, must be attested.

**3.3** Purchase Order will be subject to general conditions of purchase prevailing in Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited.

**3.4** Any dispute arising out of this shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Unit Head, BHEL, EMRP, Mumbai OR any other officer nominated by him and his award shall be final and binding on the parties. The venue of the arbitration in all cases shall be Mumbai.

**3.5** All suits in respect of this NIT shall be in the courts of Mumbai.

**3.6** In case dispute is not settled in negotiation, it shall be referred to a Conciliation appointed by BHEL.

**3.7** In case dispute is not settled in conciliation proceedings too, the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of General Manager of the Department/Executive Director of the unit or any person nominated by any of them as per corporate Guidelines of BHEL and the arbitration proceedings shall be taken out as per provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended read with BHEL's Corporate guidelines in force.

**3.8** The place of arbitration shall be at Mumbai only.

**3.9** The Civil Courts at Mumbai shall have jurisdiction to entertain the cases arising out of the arbitration proceedings.

**3.10** "For this procurement, Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 15.06.2017, 28.05.2018, 29.05.2019 & 04.06.2020 and subsequent Orders issued by the respective Nodal Ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before finalization of contract/PO/WO against this NIT.

In the event of any Nodal Ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and/or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable."
