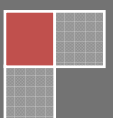

- 2.0 The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document and as detailed in this NIT. Bidders to note specifically that all pages of tender document, including these NIT pages of this particular tender together with subsequent correspondences shall be submitted by them, duly signed & stamped on each page, as part of offer. **Rates/Price including discounts/rebates, if any, mentioned anywhere/in any form in the techno-commercial offer other than the Price Bid, shall not be entertained.**
- 3.0 Unless specifically stated otherwise, bidder shall remit cost of tender and courier charges if applicable, in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd, payable at Power Sector Regional HQ at Nagpur issuing the Tender, along with techno-commercial offer. Bidder may also choose to deposit the Tender document cost by cash at the Cash Office as stated above against sl no iv of 1, on any working day; and in such case copy of Cash receipt is to be enclosed with the Techno Commercial offer. - 4.0 Unless specifically stated otherwise, bidder shall deposit EMD through Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd, payable at Nagpur. For other details and for 'One Time EMD' please refer General Conditions of Contract.

SPECIAL NOTE : All documents/ annexures submitted with the offer shall be properly annexed and placed in respective places of the offer as per enclosure list mentioned in the covering letter. BHEL shall not be responsible for any missing documents.

7.0 No Deviation with respect to tender clauses and no additional clauses/ suggestions/ in Techno-commercial bid/ Price bid shall normally be considered by BHEL. Bidders are requested to positively comply with the same.

8.0 BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Offers without assigning any reasons thereof. BHEL also reserves the right to cancel the Tender wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter (except for the refund of EMD).

9.0 Assessment of Capacity of Bidders: (Shall be applicable for bid evaluation from 1st Jan- 2011 onwards)
Bidders capacity for executing the job under tender shall be assessed as per the following:

I. **Assigning Weightages (A) for Similar Jobs Under-Execution:** Weightages shall be worked out and assigned based on the average number of Similar Works under execution including works yet to be commenced by the agency, in the following manner:

i). **Number of Similar Jobs**

- a) No. of jobs in BHEL, PSER : Say 'J'
- b) No. of jobs in BHEL, PSSR : Say 'K'
- c) No. of jobs in BHEL, PSWR : Say 'L'
- d) No. of jobs in BHEL, PSNR : Say 'M'
- e) No. of jobs with other customers* : Say 'N' (*: Other than BHEL PSER, PSSR, PSWR & PSNR)
- f) Average No. of Jobs is 'P' = (J+K+L+M+N) divided by 5

ii) **Weightage "A" assigned to bidders based on Average Number of jobs "P":**

- a) If 'P' = 0-1, "A" will be equal to '3'
- b) If 'P' = 2-3, "A" will be equal to '2'
- c) If 'P' = 4-5, "A" will be equal to '1'
- d) If 'P' is Above 5, "A" will be equal to '0'

II. **Weightage "B" for Quarterly Performance Reports of Vendors:** This shall be based on the averages of the net weighted score obtained by the bidder for the jobs under execution (excluding works not commenced) for the quarter previous to the last quarter reckoned from the date of latest due date of submission, in all four Regions i.e BHEL PSER, PSSR, PSWR & PSNR, in the following manner.

i). **Ratings by Power Sector Region:**

- a) PS ER's Rating 'R_{er}' = (X₁ + X₂ + .. + X_n) divided by n
- b) PS WR's Rating 'R_{wr}' = (X₁ + X₂ + .. + X_n) divided by n
- c) PS SR's Rating 'R_{sr}' = (X₁ + X₂ + .. + X_n) divided by n
- d) PS NR's Rating 'R_{nr}' = (X₁ + X₂ + .. + X_n) divided by n

- e) **Over all Power Sector Region Rating ' R_{BHEL} ' = ($R_{er} + R_{wr} + R_{sr} + R_{nr}$)**
divided by 4

(where " $X_1, X_2, X_3, \dots, X_n$ " is the net weighted score obtained by the bidder as per the "Evaluation of Contractor Performance (Quarterly)" against the various contracts 'n' under execution in the respective Region).

- ii) Weightage "B" assigned to bidders based on Overall Power Sector Rating (R_{BHEL}):

- a) If R_{BHEL} is 80% and above, "B" will be equal to '6'
- b) If R_{BHEL} is $> 70\% < 80\%$, "B" will be equal to '5'
- c) If R_{BHEL} is $> 60\% < 70\%$, "B" will be equal to '4'
- d) If R_{BHEL} is $\leq 60\%$, "B" will be equal to '0'

III. Evaluation of Bidders capacity to execute the job under tender: shall be based on the sum of scores obtained in 'A' and 'B', as below:

- a) **6 or above : Considered 'Qualified' for the job under tender**
- b) **Less than 6: Considered 'NOT Qualified' for the job under tender**

IV. Explanatory note:

- a) Similar work means Boiler or Turbine or Civil or Electrical or CI, etc irrespective of rating of Plant
- b) Quarter shall be as per the quarter defined in the "Evaluation of Contractor performance (Quarterly)". For contracts where annexed Quarterly Evaluation performance was not part of the contract, 'Quarterly Performance Reports' previous to the last quarter reckoned from the date of latest due date of submission, given by the respective project site against the contract will be the basis for evaluation.
- c) Vendors who are not executing any jobs presently in the Region and first timers to the Region, may be considered subject to satisfying all other tender conditions
- d) 'Under execution' shall mean works in progress upto Boiler Steam Blowing (for Boiler and Auxiliaries) or Synchronisation (for all other jobs including Civil) shall be considered.

10.0 Since the job shall be executed at site, bidders must visit site/ work area and study the job content, facilities available, availability of materials, prevailing site conditions including law & order situation etc before quoting for this tender. They may also consult this office before submitting their offers, for any clarifications regarding scope of work, facilities available at sites or on terms and conditions. No additional claim shall be entertained by BHEL in future, on account of non-acquaintance of above.

11.0 For any clarification on the tender document, the bidder may seek the same in writing or through e-mail, as per specified format, within the scheduled date for seeking clarification, from the office of the undersigned. BHEL shall not be responsible for receipt of queries after due date of seeking clarification due to

postal delay or any other delays. Any clarification / query received after last date for seeking clarification may not be normally entertained by BHEL and no time extension will be given.

- 12.0 BHEL may decide holding pre-bid discussion [PBD] with all intending bidders as per date indicated in the NIT. The bidder shall ensure participation for the same at the appointed time, date and place as may be decided by BHEL. Bidders shall plan their visit accordingly. The outcome of pre-bid discussion (PBD) shall also form part of tender.
- 13.0 In the event of any conflict between requirement of any clause of this specification/ documents/drawings/data sheets etc or requirements of different codes/standards specified, the same to be brought to the knowledge of BHEL in writing for clarification before due date of seeking clarification (whichever is applicable), otherwise, interpretation by BHEL shall prevail. Any typing error/missing pages/ other clerical errors in the tender documents, noticed must be pointed out before pre-bid meeting/submission of offer, else BHEL's interpretation shall prevail.
- 14.0 Unless specifically mentioned otherwise, bidder's quoted price shall deemed to be in compliance with tender including PBD.
- 15.0 Bidders shall submit Integrity Pact Agreement (Duly signed by authorized signatory who signs in the offer), **if applicable**, along with techno-commercial bid. This pact shall be considered as a preliminary qualification for further participation. **The names and other details of Independent External Monitor (IEM) for the subject tender is as given at point (xi) of 1 above.**
- 16.0 The Bidder has to satisfy the Pre Qualifying Requirements stipulated for this Tender in order to be qualified. The Price Bids of only those bidders will be opened who will be qualified for the subject job on the basis of pre-qualification evaluation/ techno-commercial bids, approval/ acceptance of customer (as applicable), etc. and date of opening of price bids shall be intimated to only such bidders.
- 17.0 In case BHEL decides on a 'Public Opening', the date & time of opening of the sealed PRICE BID shall be intimated to the qualified bidders and in such a case, bidder may depute one authorised representative to witness the price bid opening. BHEL reserves the right to open 'in-camera' the 'PRICE BID' of any or all Unsuccessful/Disqualified bidders under intimation to the respective bidders.
- 18.0 Validity of the offer shall be for **six months** from the latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any) or specified otherwise in SCC of tender.
- 19.0 BHEL reserves the right to decide the successful bidder on the basis of Reverse Auction process. In such case all qualified bidders will be intimated regarding procedure/ modality for Reverse Auction process prior to Reverse Auction and price will be decided as per the rules for Reverse Auction. .

However, if reverse auction process is unsuccessful as defined in the RA rules/procedures, or for whatsoever reason, then the sealed 'PRICE BIDS' will be opened for deciding the successful bidder. BHEL's decision in this regard will be final and binding on bidder.

- 20.0 On submission of offer, further consideration will be subject to compliance to tender & qualifying requirement and customer's acceptance, as applicable.
- 21.0 In case the bidder is an "Indian Agent of Foreign Principals", 'Agency agreement has to be submitted along with Bid, detailing the role of the agent along with the terms of payment for agency commission in INR, along with supporting documents.
- 22.0 The bidders shall not enter into any undisclosed M.O.U. or any understanding amongst themselves with respect to tender.
- 23.0 In case Consortium Bidding is allowed as per Pre Qualifying Requirement, then Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner shall enter into Consortium Agreement. Validity period of Consortium Agreement shall be 6 months after which the same can be re validated.
- 'Stand alone' bidder cannot become a **'prime bidder' or a 'consortium bidder' in a consortium bidding**. Prime bidder shall neither be a consortium partner to other prime bidder nor take any other consortium partners. However, consortium partner may enter into consortium agreement with other prime bidders. In case of non compliance, consortium bids of such Prime bidders will be rejected. .
- 24.0 The bidder shall submit documents in support of possession of 'Qualifying Requirements' duly self certified and stamped by the authorized signatory, indexed and properly linked in the format for PQR. In case BHEL requires any other documents/proofs, these shall be submitted immediately.
- 25.0 The bidder may have to produce original document for verification if so decided by BHEL.
- 26.0 Order of Precedence

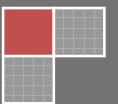

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 **NAME OF WORK:** Renovation of BHEL Staff Quarters at BHEL - Staff Quarters, Trimurti Nagar, Nagpur, Maharashtra, India.

2.2 THE WORK INVOLVES

(A) Dismantling of existing BHEL staff Quarters like Brick work, WC, Doors, windows, Ventilators, Tiles (both floor and wall) on the kitchen Sink Area, Toilet area and wash basin area, Existing plumbing line including all fitting and fixtures etc and shifting and dumping all the Dismantled material at the specified place as shown by BHEL in well planned manner and cleaning and making the surface suitable to receive new work/fixings at suitable place.

(B) Providing, Supply fixing and commissioning of various items like Brick work, painting work over plastered (both new and old) / painted surface, wood Doors & frame / chaukhat, Steel Glazed window, ventilators, WC, All associated plumbing fittings and fixtures, Mirror, White Glazed Tiles on floor and wall and MS grill works at balcony area etc.

Bidders should note that the above works is to be carried out in BHEL staff quarters in where BHEL employees are leaving and hence all the fronts cannot be handed over at a time. Also much noise and disturbance has to be avoided. All necessary steps are to be taken to avoid damage of BHEL staff quarters / flat's floors, partitions etc during movement of labors engaged on the job. Any damage occurred to BHEL staff quarters/flats premises/property of BHEL during renovation work shall be rectified by contractor at their cost.

2.3 SPECIFICATION OF FITTINGS

- b) Tiles (wall, floor and wall border) ----Kajaria/MCPL/Jhanson/Nitco.
- c) Mirror ----As per sample approval.
- d) Steel glazed Ventilators ----Jindal section/As per sample approval.
- e) All GI Pipe (medium class) ----As per sample approval.

2.3 **FIXING OF SANITARYWARE, WHITE GLAZED TILES, PLUMBING, WOOD DOORS, STEEL GLAZED WINDOW/ VENTILATORS, MIRROR AND OTHER ITEMS.**

All the above fitting shall be fixed by experienced and skilled fitters, masons, plumbers properly as per the standard procedure and instruction of BHEL. Leak test shall be carried out after completion of fitting and any defect noticed during the test shall be rectified properly to the satisfaction of the BHEL. Any fitting/item broken during the fixing shall be replaced without any extra cost.

2.4 **FINISHING OF DAMAGES IN EXISTING WALL, FLOOR ETC.**

During the dismantling of existing sanitary fitting and fixture, tiles, door, window, ventilators etc. and fixing of new items there may be every possibility of damages in existing wall and floor. All this damages shall be made good matching with adjacent surface. The quoted rate of various items in rate schedule/BOQ shall be inclusive of the above finishing and no separate payment shall be made on this account.

2.5 GENERAL TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION:

2.5.1

Cement Concrete: This shall include supplying and placing PCC at all levels .Concrete of 1:2:4 mix as defined in IS- 456 with 6mm and downgraded stone aggregates. Nominal mix (volumetric) shall be allowed to use as per the guidelines of IS-456 (latest edition) with min. W/C ratio & cement content as per IS 456 for moderate condition. **However in certain unavoidable circumstances, hand mix shall be permitted with 10% extra cement content as per the discretion of BHEL engineer.**

2.5.2

Formwork: The formwork should be capable of carrying the dead load of concrete and some sort of live load if any. After sufficient curing period & after attaining adequate strength of concrete, the formwork shall be removed with the approval of BHEL engineer. The item of cement concrete shall be deemed as completed after removal of forms and required finishing is completed.

2.5.3

Brick masonry: Brick masonry shall be done by using best quality locally available burnt clay bricks / Fly Ash Lime (FAL) bricks of standard size. Minimum strength of the bricks should not be less than 35 KG/sq. cm. Other quality requirement shall be in line with the relevant IS Code. One-brick thick brickwork shall be constructed as specified, in Cement mortar 1:4 including linking, plumbing, leveling, pacing, joints curing etc. Including all materials, tools, plants and labor complete at all level/elevation.

2.5.4 STEEL/ IRON WORK

- 1) **Steel MS Grill:** All MS Grill works shall be supplied and fixed as per standard practice and instructions of Engineer-in-charge with all fittings and fixtures, etc. Complete.
- 2) **Steel Window:** All steel Windows shall be supplied and fixed as per standard standard practice and instructions of Engineer-in-charge with all fittings and fixtures, etc. Complete.
- 3) **Steel Ventilators:** All steel ventilators shall be supplied and fixed as per standard standard practice and instructions of Engineer-in-charge with all fittings and fixtures, etc. Complete.
- 4) **Fly Proof:** All ventilators shall be covered with Fly Proofs using galvanized ms wire gauge with average width of aperture 1.4mm in both directions with wire of dia. 0.63mm with 12mm MS U beading.

2.5.5 PAINTING

2.5.5.1

Three coats of white / color washing with one coat of primer shall be provided uniformly on all wall surfaces as per IS specification and standard practice.

2.5.5.2

Two or more coats of OBD (Oil Bound Distemper) of required colour with one coat of primer shall be provided uniformly on all wall surfaces as per IS specification and standard practice.

2.5.5.3

Two or more coats of Water Proof Cement Paint (Snowcem Paint) of required colour with one coat of primer shall be provided uniformly on all wall surfaces as per IS specification and standard practice.

2.5.5.4

All the Wood items such as Door, Cupboard, Showcase, etc. shall be provided with one coat of primer and two coats of oil paint of approved color and quality. Painting shall be done after fixing in position of all mentioned items as per IS specification and standard practice.

2.5.5.5

All the steel items such as MS Grill, steel Windows and Ventilators, etc. shall be provided with one coat of red oxide primer and two coats of synthetic enamel paint of approved color and quality. Painting shall be done after fixing in position of all mentioned items as per IS specification and standard practice.

2.5.5.6

The contractor shall provide and maintain at his own cost all T & P for carry out the work. The T & P shall be for fabrication & Erection of the structures (MS Grills, steel window & ventilators etc.).

2.5.5.7

The unutilized suitable debris shall be disposed & leveled to the proposed mentioned area for surface clearance with prior approval of BHEL.

2.5.6 ANTI-TERMITE TREATMENT

2.5.6.1

Providing exhaustive Ant termite Treatment by drilling 6mm diameter holes a distance of 30 cm centre to centre, at downward angle of 45 degree at junction of wood work (door frame / panel, showcase & cupboard etc) and masonry and in between, as instructed by engineer, as per requirement, at the rate of 75 ml per sqm. Of chlordane of 58 percent emulsion concentrate and filling with putty, etc. with two years guarantee bond as per I.S. – 6313 (part iii) of 1971.

2.5.6.2

Providing post constructional exhaustive Ant termite Treatment to the sides of flooring by injecting one percent of Chlordane Emulsion Concentrate at the rate of 50 ml per hole of 6mm diameter drilled at a distance of 30 cm centre to centre or more as per requirement and sealing the same with proper filling with two years guarantee bond as per I.S. – 6313 (part iii) of 1971.

TAXES, DUTIES, LEVIES

8.0

Refer to Clause 2.8.4 of General Conditions of Contract. Notwithstanding anything contained therein, the following provisions shall be applicable for this contract.

8.1.1

The contractor shall pay all (save the specific exclusions as enumerated in this contract) taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tools, royalty, VAT/WCT, commissions or other charges which may be levied on the input goods & services consumed and output goods & services delivered in course of his operations in executing the contract. In case BHEL is forced to pay any of such taxes, BHEL shall have the right to recover the same from his bills or otherwise as deemed fit (**i.e. rate quoted by bidder shall be inclusive of all Taxes and Duties, VAT/WCT except Service Tax**).

However, provisions regarding Service Tax on output services and goods shall be as per following clauses.

8.1.2 Service Tax & Cess on Service Tax

Service Tax and Cess on Service Tax as applicable on output Services are excluded from contractor's scope; therefore contractor's price/rates shall be **exclusive** of Service Tax and Cess on Output Services. In case, it becomes mandatory for the contractor under provisions of relevant act/law to collect the Service Tax & Cess from BHEL and deposit the same with the concerned tax authorities, such applicable amount will be paid by BHEL.

Contractor shall submit to BHEL documentary evidence of Service Tax registration certificate specifying name of services covered under this contract. Contractor shall submit serially numbered Service Tax and Cess Invoice, signed by him or a person authorized by him in respect of taxable service provided, and shall contain the following, namely,

- I. The name, address and the registration number of the contractor,
- II. The name and address of the party receiving taxable service,
- III. Description, classification and value of taxable service provided and,
- IV. The service tax payable thereon.

All the four conditions shall be fulfilled in the invoice before release of service tax payment.

Contractor shall obtain prior written consent from BHEL before billing the amount towards such taxes.

Chapter-VIII: Taxes and Other Duties

With introduction of Cenvat Credit Rules 2004, which came into force w.e.f. 10.09.2004, Excise Duty paid on Input Goods including Capital Goods and Service Tax paid on Input Services that are used for providing the output services can be taken credit of against the Service Tax payable on output services. However BHEL may opt for availing the abatement provision in which case CENVAT credit may not be available on input duty.

8.1.3 Modalities of Tax Incidence on BHEL

Wherever the relevant tax laws permit more than one option or methodology for discharging the liability of tax/levy/duty, BHEL will have the right to adopt the appropriate one considering the amount of tax liability on BHEL/Client as well as procedural simplicity with regard to assessment of the liability. The option chosen by BHEL shall be binding on the Contractor for discharging the obligation of BHEL in respect of the tax liability to the Contractor.

8.1.4 New Taxes/Levies

In case the Government imposes any new levy/tax on the output service/ goods/work after award of the contract, the same shall be reimbursed by BHEL at actual.

In case any new tax/levy/duty etc. becomes applicable after the date of Bidder's offer, the Bidder/Contractor must convey its impact on his price duly substantiated by documentary evidence in support of the same **before opening of Price Bid**. Claim for any such impact after opening the Price Bid will not be considered by BHEL for reimbursement of tax or reassessment of offer.

No reimbursement/recovery on account of increase/reduction in the rate of taxes, levies, duties etc. on input goods/services/work shall be made. Such impact shall be taken care of by the Price Variation/Adjustment Clause (PVC) if any. In case PVC is not applicable for the contract, Bidder has to make his own assessment of the impact of future variation if any, in rates of taxes/duties/ levies etc. in his price bid.
