- The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document and as detailed in this NIT. Bidders to note specifically that all pages of tender document, including these NIT pages of this particular tender together with subsequent correspondences shall be submitted by them, duly signed, as part of offer. Rates/Price including discounts/rebates, if any, mentioned anywhere/in any form in the techno-commercial offer other than the Price Bid, shall not be entertained. Unsolicited discounts received after opening of techno-commercial bids shall not be considered for evaluation.
- 2.0 No Deviation with respect to tender clauses and no additional clauses/ suggestions/ clarification in Techno-commercial bid/ Price bid shall normally be considered by BHEL. Bidders are requested to positively comply with the same.
- 3.0 BHEL reserve the right to accept or reject any or all offer without assigning any reasons thereof. BHEL also reserve the right to cancel the tender wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter (except for the refund of EMD). However, BHEL may communicate rejection to the unsuccessful bidder after award of work and acceptance by the successful bidder.
- 4.0 BHEL may decide holding of pre-bid discussion [PBD] with all intending bidders as per date indicated in the NIT. The bidder shall ensure participation for the same at the appointed time, date and place as may be decided by BHEL. Bidders shall plan their visit accordingly. The outcome of pre-bid discussion (PBD) shall also form part of tender.
- 5.0 Unless specifically mentioned otherwise, bidder's quoted price shall deemed to be in compliance with tender including PBD, if any.
- 6.0 The Price Bids of only those bidders will be opened who will be qualified for the subject job on the basis of evaluation on pre-qualification criteria/ techno-commercial bids etc. BHEL's decision in this regard shall be final & binding. BHEL also reserve the right to reject bidder with unsatisfactory past performance in execution of a contract. BHEL reserves the right not to consider offers of parties under HOLD. Pre-Qualification Criteria

Bidder shall essentially meet all the Qualifying Requirements as cited below:-

B Price Bid Opening

Price bids of those bidders who stand qualified subsequent to the compliance of PQR criteria A shall be opened.

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Chapter-II - Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR)

Explanatory Notes for PQR

- i. Bidder shall furnish relevant documents (wherein date, Value etc. is legible) in the respective attachments in their offer in support of PQR.
- ii. Latest date of offer submission (considering all tender extensions, if any) shall be reckoned as the date of Part-I opening and this date shall be considered for the evaluation of credential thus submitted for PQR-A.
- iii. Consortium bidding is not allowed.
- iv. After satisfactory fulfillment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all other terms of the tender.

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I) ABOUT BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED

Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) is a Central Public Sector Enterprise, wherein Government of India is holding 63.17% of its equity. It is an integrated power plant equipment manufacturer and one of the largest engineering and manufacturing companies of its kind in India having a turnover of about USD 4 billion. The company is engaged in the design, engineering, manufacture, construction, testing, commissioning and servicing of a wide range of products and services for the core sectors of the economy, viz. Power, Transmission, Industry, Transportation, Renewable Energy, Oil & Gas and Defence with over 180 product offerings to meet the needs of these sectors.

Since its inception in 1964, BHEL has been the solid bedrock of evolution of India's Heavy Electrical Equipment industry. BHEL has a mammoth 20,000 MW per annum capability for manufacturing of power generation equipment. A widespread network of 17 manufacturing units, 2 repair units, 4 regional offices, 8 service centres, 1 subsidiary, 4 overseas offices, 6 joint ventures, 15 regional marketing centres and current project execution at more than 150 project sites across India.

II) INTENT OF THE TENDER: -

Company under its policy on medical attendance provide medicines for treatment of its serving employees and their dependent family members. The company also provides medical benefits to retired employees and their spouses under its BHEL **Retired Employees Contributory Health Scheme (RECHS).** The serving employees & their dependents and Retired employees & their spouses hereinafter shall be referred as 'beneficiaries'.

The beneficiaries availing benefits under BHEL's schemes are settled in and around Nagpur district.

With the objective to ensure timely supply of medicines to its beneficiaries, BHEL invites tender in two parts bid system, from **Authorised Pharmacy** for being selected for Empanelment with BHEL as **Authorised Pharmacy** for supply of medicines to BHEL beneficiaries (based in and around Nagpur district).

III) NUMBER OF AUTHORISED PHARMACY AND VALIDITY OF EMPANELMENT:

BHEL intends to empanel a maximum of **Five (05 Nos.)** successful bidders of **Authorised Pharmacy in each category i.e. 'Modern Medicines (Non-Generic)' and 'Generic Medicines'** in Nagpur, for a period of **Three (03) years** from issuance of purchase Order.

The contract may be extended at same rates (as finalised in this contract) and same T&C for One Year at discretion of BHEL.

The **Authorised Pharmacy** will provide the medicines at the agreed **uniform rate of discount on MRP** (inclusive of all taxes) to the beneficiaries as required within reasonable time against the online/ offline requisition from BHEL/ its beneficiaries.

PERIOD UPTO WHICH SUPPLY ORDERS WILL BE PLACED IV)

Supply orders will be placed against the contract up to the last date of the contract. Orders received even on the closing date should be honoured in accordance with the terms of contract even though the last date of the contract may have expired on the date of supply of medicines.

V) Modality of empanelment of Authorised Pharmacy /(ies)

Evaluation shall be carried out separately for 'Modern Medicines (Non-Generic)' and 'Generic Medicines'.

Bidder offering highest discount on MRP shall be termed as L-1 bidder (highest discount) and subsequent bidders in order of price competitiveness (i.e. L-2, L3, L4 ... onwards shall be given opportunity to match the L-1 discount rates (highest discount) for being on panel. BHEL reserves all rights to operate this contract as per requirement and its sole discretion.

The broad mechanism will be as follows:-

- In case the number of qualified bidders is 'N' and N is greater than 6, the number of empanelled Authorised Pharmacy/(ies) shall be limited to (N-1) qualified bidders (maximum upto 05 bidders). BHEL shall give counter offer based on the L-1 discount rates (highest discount) to remaining bidders (i.e. L-2, L-3so on) for their acceptance for empanelment. However on acceptance of discount rates (highest discount) and as well other provision of tender specification, the preference shall be given to the bidders in order of their price status (i.e. L-2 will be given first preference for acceptance of L-1 discount rates (highest discount), then L-3 and onwards). In case case none of the bidders do not accept the offered L-1 discount rates (highest discount), then BHEL may consider awarding full quantity to the L-1 bidder as per other provision of tender specification.
- In case the number of qualified bidders is 'N' and N is less than or equal to 6, the number of empanelled Authorized Pharmacy shall be limited to (N-1) qualified bidders. BHEL shall give counter offer based on the L-1 rates to remaining bidders (i.e. L-2, L-3so on) for their acceptance for empanelment. However on acceptance of discount rates (highest discount) and as well other provision of tender specification, the preference shall be given to the bidders in order of their price status (i.e. L-2 will be given first preference for acceptance of L-1 discount rates (highest discount), then L-3 and onwards). In case none of the bidders do not accept the offered L-1 discount rates (highest discount), then BHEL may consider awarding full quantity to the L-1 bidder as per other provision of tender specification.
- In case the number of qualified bidders is only 01, full quantity may be awarded to that bidder as per other provision of tender specification.

BHEL reserves all rights to operate this contract as per project requirements and its sole discretion.

AWARD AND FORMATION OF CONTRACT

- The contract will be awarded to maximum upto Five bidders (05 Nos.) in each category i.e. 'Modern i. Medicines (Non-Generic)' and 'Generic Medicines'. (as applicable as described above).
- All the documents issued by BHEL as well as accepted by it up to the stage of PO will form part of the contract. Some of the examples are: Tender Document, Techno-Commercial /Price Bid, Certificate, No Deviation statement etc.
- iii. The successful bidder shall give acceptance to the Purchase Order (PO) to BHEL within 07 (seven) days of issue of the same by BHEL, by way of return of signed copy of letter of award.
- The Contract shall come into force from the issuance of Purchase Order.

EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL CUM COMMERCIAL BIDS

The Technical Cum Commercial Bid shall be evaluated as per qualification in Chapter-II – Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR) and complying to techno-commercial T&C of the tender.

BHEL reserves the right to seek clarification or call for supporting documents from any of the bidders, for which the concerned bidder need to submit the documentary evidence(s) within reasonable time period /as required by BHEL.

Price Bids of only those bidders shall be opened which qualify by fulfilling the PQR cum Techno Commercial qualification specified in this Tender.

EVALUATION OF PRICE BID

Price Bids of only those bidders shall be opened which qualify by fulfilling the PQR cum Techno Commercial qualification specified in this Tender. The date, time and place for opening the Price Bids will be communicated to the eligible bidders. The Bidders may send their representatives to attend the opening if they wish.

BID VALIDITY

The price quoted by the bidder shall remain valid for a period of 90 days after the date of opening of Techno Commercial Bid (Part I). In exceptional circumstances, BHEL may solicit the Bidder's consent for extension of the bid validity period. When the Bidder extends the period of validity, the same shall be done without any modification to the bid proposal by the Bidder.

SUPPLY & MECHANISM OF RECEIPTS / COLLECTION OF MEDICINES BY BENEFICIARIES

Serving Employees & dependent family:-

In case of serving employees, the outlets of Authorized Pharmacy may check the ID Card (at its sole discretion, may keep scan copy in soft form for record) and supply the allopathic medicines (modern / generic) at the discounted rate as finalised in this contract.

This facility shall be availed on **DEBIT** basis only for Serving Employees.

Retired Employees and their Spouse:-

In case of retired employees, the outlets of Authorized Pharmacy must collect OP Consultation Slip duly endorsed by the BHEL Doctor (PTMC) prescribing the medicines. OP Consultation Slip is part of Medical Book for beneficiaries of RECHS / retired employees.

OP Consultation Slip must be submitted by Authorized Pharmacy monthly along with bills to BHEL for payment purposes.

This facility will be availed on CREDIT basis and shall be applicable for only the Retired BHEL Employees and their Spouse.

Note: Those medicines / consumables which are not covered in this contract for supply on CREDIT basis to Retired Employees are not to be sold on Credit basis

SUPPLIES TERMS & CONDITIONS

- NON SUBSTITUTION: Specific brand of medicines shall not be substituted by another brand without consent of beneficiary/ doctor. Generic medicines with same composition as the required medicine may be supplied with the consent of beneficiary/ doctor. However, if any case is noticed during subsequent scrutiny where wrong medicines are supplied, the supplier may be penalized for Rs.500 for the supply of wrong medicines (i.e. different medicines as mentioned in prescription).
- **PACKED SUPPLIES:** Supplies are required to be made in original packing of manufacturer (if applicable). 2. The packing should be nearest to the total quantity demanded of any particular medicine on any particular order.

3. SUPPLY OF MEDICINES:

Sufficient stock of Medicines at all times will have to be maintained by the Authorized Pharmacy to avoid inconvenience to BHEL beneficiaries. In case the ordered medicines are not available with the AUTHORIZED PHARMACY, attempt shall be made by AUTHORIZED PHARMACY to make the same available within reasonable time.

The Authorized Pharmacy will indicate batch number, name of manufacturer, date of expiry of Medicines indented in the relevant columns of the billing sheet at the time of supplying the medicines to the concerned BHEL beneficiary.

Expired Products:- In case it is found that supplied medicines has expired or is spurious, Authorized Pharmacy may be debarred for a period of 2 years besides other legal action that may be initiated against them as per law. The due procedure prescribed in the Policy on Suspension of Business dealings and banning of Business as detailed in Chapter-II - Important Information shall be followed.

BILLING & PAYMENTS PROCEDURE

1. PRESENTATION OF BILLS (For CREDIT based supplies only):

- The Authorized Pharmacy shall present the bill to BHEL PSWR unit for the supplies made during each month (1st to last day of the month) within 10 days of closing of each respective month. The bill should clearly indicate the details of the supplies made each day such as name of the item, name of manufacturer, batch No., date of manufacture & expiry date, name of beneficiary, rate, discount as per contract etc., copy of prescription and any other information required by the BHEL.
- BHEL reserves the right to cross verify the MRP from the manufacturers.
- All Payment related documents (one copy) shall be furnished to the following address:

2. PAYMENT

Payment terms: Bill complete in all respect along with all the requisite documents will be paid within 30 days of receipt in BHEL. The payment will be made through ECS for which bidder should give requisite ECS Mandate Form with details of bank address, Account No. etc. & a copy of the cancelled Cheque.

Any change in the bank account details during the tenure of contract shall be informed to BHEL in writing (on letter head of firm) along with requisite documents as detailed above.

3. TAXES AND DUTIES

Payment shall be made to the bidder only after submission of GST complaint Tax invoice and other relevant documents. Bidder has to ensure the compliance under the GST Act & rules.

100% of GST & GST cess if any shall be paid to supplier along with the bills. However, the Vendor must ensure that vendor has declared such Invoice in their GSTR-1 & has paid the tax to the Government by filing GSTR-3B or any other return/form for payment of tax so that Vendor's invoice details appear in BHEL's GSTR-2A.

If any loss occurs to BHEL due to Non-compliance on account of the vendor's fault shall be dealt with strict actions and guidelines as per statutory laws. The bidder has to submit their GST registration certificate to BHEL within 30 days from the acceptance of order. GSTIN of BHEL will be provided to the bidder within 15 days from the placement of order.

Any statutory payment, including changes in taxes & duties, as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence. Payment to the bidder will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time.

The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time. A certificate to this effect shall be provided to the bidder by BHEL.

COMMUNICATION & COORDINATION:-

BHEL's concerned person, henceforth to be named as HR Manager (from Human Resource Dept.) shall have the authority to represent BHEL on all day-to-day matters relating to the implementation or arising from the

Contract. All notices, instructions, orders, certificates, approvals, and all other communications under the Contract shall be given by the concerned HR Manager, except as otherwise provided for in this Contract. All notices, instructions, information, and other communications given by the Bidder to BHEL under the Contract shall be given to the HR Manager, except as otherwise provided for in this Contract.

MISCELLANEOUS TECHNO-COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- i. No deviation from above terms and conditions will be accepted. Format at Techno-Commercial Compliance forms (TCF).
- ii. No Consortium bidding is allowed for the subject tender.
- iii. Tenders beyond the scheduled due time cannot be submitted by the bidders. The same may not be acceptable.
- iv. **Payment Terms Loading**:- For any deviation sought in Payment terms by bidder w.r.t. payment term, following loading shall be followed during evaluation of price bids:
 - → Base rate of State Bank of India (SBI) (as applicable on the date of bid opening; Techno-commercial bid opening in case of two part bids) + 6%; shall be considered for loading for the period of relaxation sought by bidders.
- v. The Bidder shall be solely responsible for all taxes, duties, octroi, license fees, etc., incurred for performance of the services. Any other tax, delivery cost & other cost shall be borne by the bidders during execution of the contract.
- vi. All expenses incurred towards boarding /lodging / travel etc. for attending any meeting or discussion convened by BHEL or in connection with the pre-contract and post-contract activities shall be borne by the bidder.
- vii. Bidder shall make its own arrangements for movement of human resources and equipment across the various locations covered in the Contract.
- viii. BHEL reserves the right to reject all / any application received from the Authorized Pharmacy without assigning any reason thereof.
- ix. The cost towards IT system development / integration with BHEL IT system (if required) shall NOT be payable separately.
- x. The bidder shall abide by the applicable statutory / regulatory / legislative requirement / government orders governing the business of Medicines/Drugs/Cosmetics in India.
- xi. BHEL also reserves the right to place the order on the other bidder who has taken part in this tender, subject to his compliance of procedures of BHEL in terms of price.

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Chapter-IV - Instructions for filling the Price Bid

- 1. Bidder must quote the offered discount as "Percentage" discount over the Maximum Retail Price incl. of all taxes. (MRP must be Printed on the package of Medicines).
- 2. No separate taxes, no delivery cost & no other costs shall be payable.
- 3. Bidder offering highest discount on MRP shall be termed as L-1 bidder (highest discount) and bidders L-2, L3, L4 onwards shall be required to match the L-1 discount rates (highest discount) for being on panel.
- 4. Bidder shall fill the % discount only in the Price format given by BHEL in Volume II.
