Material Stacking/shifting and Material retrieval activities in TRM

Nature of Work:-

To accomplish all the activities for Material shifting and Material retrieval with help of **semi-skilled** manpower as per details given in NIT & as per the “**Annexure- W**”.

For the above mentioned work, price on per day basis is as per following:-

Table –A

Bidder to **quote the service charge only** which should take care of all other statutory levies like leave, holidays, uniform, shoes, helmet, bonus, supervision/admin charges/margin etc or **any hike** in Basic, PF, ESI, Labour welfare contribution, as the above factors in Table-A inclusive of the quoted service charge shall **become fixed on the day of awarding of work** and shall remain **fixed throughout the contract period**.

Notes:-

1. Bidder to quote the **Service Charge in Rupees on the basis of per day only**. The quoted service charge should not be **Negative** and should be only **upto 2 decimal places**, otherwise such Price Bid shall be cancelled and the bidder shall be **disqualified**. The **Final rate per man hour** shall be equal to:
[“**Statutory Min Wage on per day basis on the day of awarding of work** (which currently for semi-skilled worker is Rs.501.87/- per day)” + “**Service charge quoted by bidder in Table -A on per day basis**] / 8. (Up to two decimal places)
2. This **Final Rate arrived on per man hour basis** on the day of awarding of work will be taken as the **final Work Order Awarding Rate** inclusive of PF, ESI, all other statutory Levies, leave/holiday, uniform, shoes, helmet, bonus, supervision/admin charges/margin etc. **but Excluding of the GST** and it shall **remain firm throughout the contract period** and **no variation/escalation** what so ever during the contract period shall be allowed.
3. The bidder shall follow **BHEL norms prevailing for wages to be paid to the contract workers**. “The Contractor shall also be liable to pay hike in statutory minimum wages in October month & April month with additional wages recommended by BHEL.”
4. The GST, as applicable, shall be paid extra, as per the Govt. rules. Any loss/delay in Tax credit due to the reason attributable to the contractors shall be recovered from them along with interest.
5. Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature of person signing the bid else the bid shall be liable for rejection. The firm should take care to fill up the rate, it should be legible and should be in the price bid provided with tender documents or else the bid shall be liable for rejection. No claim of confusion, unawareness etc shall be entertained after opening of bids.
6. If two firms happen to quote the **same Service Charge**, effective L-1 will be decided on the basis of “**Average Annual Financial Turnover**” (Income from operations excluding other miscellaneous income like Agricultural income, income earned from interest etc.) as shown in the Profit & Loss Statement of the last 3 years ending March -2018. The firm having higher turnover shall be treated as L-1. BHEL’s decision in such situations shall be final and binding.
