PREAMBLE OF PRICE BID

1.0. This Price Bid consists of three Schedules:

1.1 Schedule A

Schedule A consists of two Annexures:

1) Annexure-I includes items based on previous work order & Rate Analysis

Bidders are requested to quote their rates in Percentage above/below/at Par for Annexure-I.

2) Annexure-II – Scope of work

1.2 Schedule B

Schedule B gives the details of free issue materials given by BHEL.

1.3 Schedule C

Schedule C gives the details of Tools & Tackles provided by BHEL on Chargeable Basis.

2.0 The work to be carried out under the contract shall, except as otherwise provided in tender conditions, include all labour, materials, tools, plant, equipment, and transport which may be required in preparation of and for full & entire execution and completion of the Works. The descriptions given in the Schedule of Quantities shall, unless otherwise stated, be held to include waste on materials, carriage and cartage, carrying in return of empties, hoisting, setting, fitting and fixing in position and all other labours necessary in and for the full and entire execution and completion as aforesaid in accordance with good practice and recognized principles as laid down in Technical Specification & elsewhere in Tender Specification.

3.0 The price bid should not contain any condition. Conditional price Bids shall be summarily rejected.

4.0 The bidder should not leave any column blank in Price Schedules.

5.0 Price Quoted shall include all taxes, & duties except GST.

6.0 **Unless otherwise specified in the items involving cement or reinforcement steel, these items shall be issued free of cost by BHEL.**

Note:-					
1	The rate of Rs.1562.04 per vehicle per day consists of minimum wages of MP Govt for unskilled worker (4Nos) on each vehicle inclusive of PF, ESI & contribution to Labour Welfare Board, contribution to Bonus, uniform, shoes, tools & tackles & contractors profit & Overheads etc.				
2	Vehicle means Truck/Mini Truck etc. suitable for disposal of garbage/building rubbish/waste materials having payload capacity of at least 2 MT or more.				
3	One day will have 08 working hours. The work may be required to be done on all days of the year including sundays & holidays (if so required) except for 3 nos of national holidays.				
4	The vehicle must be in good running condition fulfilling all RTO Compliances with necessary valid documents/permissions/permits. The contractor shall also submit fitness certificate of the vehicles in this regard.				
5	Disposal of garbage/building rubbish/waste materials shall be done only at the pre specified places identified by Nagar Nigam & as directed by Engineer Incharge. If it is found that garbage has been disposed at any place other than that specified by Nagar Nigam, penalty shall be imposed on the contractor by the department as deemed fit.				
6	The weight of garbage/waste materials/ building rubbish per vehicle(s) may vary from 1.0 ton to 2.0 ton. The bidders are advised to take this aspect into account while quoting their rates.				
7	In case extra number of vehicle is/are required for disposal of garbage/waste materials/building rubbish in addition to 4 vehicles per day as mentioned in annexure-I above, contractor shall deploy vehicle as per requirement & instruction of Engineer-in-Charge which shall be payable at the relevant awarded rate of item at SI No 1.2 of Annexure -I				
8	The contractor or his authorized representative shall report to each N'hood Incharge of the civil maintenance subdivision at 8.00 am daily along with vehicles and specified man power for their movement to execute the work as per instruction and direction of the N'hood Incharge and shall ensure cleanliness of dust bins, weekly/bi-weekly market places with adjoining drains and other places under scope of work as per the programme given by the Incharge.				
9	If, in spite of deployment of labourers and vehicles as stipulated in the contract, there is non-performance/below par performance in the matter of activity/activities as mentioned at Sr No 1(a) to 1 (e) of price schedule, penalty shall be imposed as per the following :				
	i) Penalty for non-performance of an activity on a particular day as indicated in Sr. nos. 1(a) to 1(e) above shall be @ 0.07% of the originally awarded contract value and penalty for below-par performance of an activity on a particular day indicted in sr. nos. 1(a) to 1 (e) above shall be @ 0.06% of the originally awarded contract value.				
	ii) In case of the above said default by the contractor for more than one activities, penalty shall be worked out after multiplying the above said percent rates accordingly with the number of activities in which the contractor has defaulted. All this will be applied on originally awarded contract value				
10	The work is quite sensitive in nature as it is related to health and hygiene. The BHEL management shall not, therefore, tolerate any irregularities in execution of work. If the contractor fails to deploy the minimum stipulated number of vehicles on any day, a penalty of 1.25 times the relevant awarded rate of item at Sr No 1.2 of Annexure 1 shall be imposed on the contractor subject to the condition that the work also suffer due to this default by the contractor.				
11	If the contractor fails to deploy the minimum stipulated number of vehicles on any day, he shall be paid at the awarded rate (as mentioned at Sr No 1.2, of Annexure 1) for only those vehicles which have been deployed but no penalty shall be imposed provided the work, in the opinion of Engineer-in-charge, does not suffer due to this default by the contractor.				
12	The contractor shall deploy a minimum of 4 labourers to be associated with each vehicle. If the contractor fails to deploy the minimum stipulated labourers as mentioned above, a penalty @ 1.25 times the built up CLC rate for unskilled worker prevailing at that point of time shall be imposed on the contractor for this shortfall subject to the condition that the work also, in the opinion of Engineer-in-charge, suffers due to this default by the contractor.				
13	If the contractor fails to deploy the minimum stipulated labourers as mentioned above, simply a deduction @ the built up CLC rate for unskilled worker prevailing at that point of time shall be imposed on the contractor even after this shortfall in deployment of labourer provided the work, in the opinion of Engineer-in-charge, does not suffer due to this default by the contractor.				
14	If the contractor persists with his default in deployment of stipulated number of vehicles and manpower causing work to suffer, BHEL, in place of effecting deduction/imposing penalty as mentioned above, reserves the right to make any alternative arrangement at risk and cost of contractor with prior notice. The decision of Engineer-in-charge shall, in this regard, be final and binding on the agency.				
15	Daily record shall be maintained of all works performed under this contract. The work done shall be entered in the register duly signed and dated by both parties viz representative of Engineer Incharge and the contractor or his authorized representative each day on completion of work.				
16	Work on a holiday shall be taken up at the sole discretion of the area-in-charge of TCL for which the agency shall seek prior written permission.				
17	The contractor shall maintain a log book for record of deployment of vehicle and man power on daily basis. The record shall be duly verified by the Engineer-in-charge.				
18	Price variation (PVC) is not applicable in this contract.
