

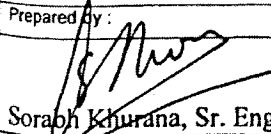
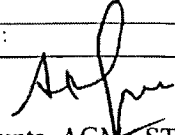

PI-240108104: Pre-Qualification Requirement for supply of rough machined forgings

The bidder shall produce documentary evidence for meeting the following Pre-Qualification Criteria along with their offer.

3	Vendor should have manufactured and supplied forgings during last 3 years (ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited) .	a) Vendors have to submit un-priced PO copies of two no. PO of alloy steel forging. Vendor to submit un-priced PO copies with item description, grade, date of PO. Along with PO, vendor has to submit documents to establish successful supply of material. For this, vendor can submit any of following : inspection clearance certificates or Material dispatch clearance certificate or delivery challan or lorry receipt. b) In case grade of material is not mentioned in the PO, a confirmation that the PO's are for alloy steel forgings is to be made. c) Vendor to provide its product catalogue, confirmation regarding the availability of a quality control department, and provide the details of available certifications, if any.
