Special Terms and Conditions for Tender enquiry

01. Offer to be submitted by the bidders in two parts as called in Tender enquiry.

Bid Part - I Technical cum Commercial bid

Bid Part - II Price bid

Suppliers shall quote price on BHEL authorized third party service provider e-procurement site <https://bhel.abcpocure.com/EPROC/>. Any deviation from the price format shall be clearly brought out in the offer Bid part I.

02. The offer to be uploaded on BHEL e-procurement site using valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). Valid DSC refers to an Active- Signing and Encryption Certificate (both), with specification class III SHA2 2048 BIT.
03. Bidders to put sign and seal on all the uploaded documents. The quotation should be uploaded on the site before due date and time.
04. Part-I of the bid shall contain complete item-wise scope of supply as offered vis-à-vis the scope of supply as per enquiry, all commercial terms and conditions etc. It is expected that bidders shall meet all our technical and commercial requirements and shall not deviate from them.
05. Offer in 2-part bid is required to be submitted by bidder on or before due date. On due date, tender can be submitted up to 2.00 PM and will be opened at 2.00 P.M. on same date.
06. The vendor should submit their best price at this stage itself and they will not be allowed to revise the price. Any revision / discount given by vendor subsequently on their own after opening of part-1 bid , will be ignored.
07. "BHEL shall be resorting to Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) for this tender. RA shall be conducted among all the techno-commercially qualified bidders. Price bids of all techno-commercially qualified bidders shall be opened and same shall be considered as initial bids of bidders in RA. In case any bidder(s) do(es) not participate in online Reverse Auction, their sealed envelope price bid along with applicable loading, if any, shall be considered for ranking."
08. Castings will be weighed before machining as well as after machining by the shop planning and average actual weight of balance pieces of order quantity will be considered the same. For the above case the item which is weighed before machining shall be weighed after machining. Financial implications shall be based on actual chip retained by the vendor.
