1. **Project Status:** Domestic
2. **Taxes and duties:** GST as applicable.
3. **Location of Plant:** Location: Velallaviduthi is a village in Karambakudi Taluk (10 KM) in Pudukkottai district of Tamilnadu, Pin code: 622003.
4. **Payment shall be applicable as per clause no. 3.2 and 3.5 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev-01.**
5. **Clause-12 (Delivery Period) of GTC- shall be read as below-**

Vendor to ensure Supply of complete material as per BOQ of Un-priced bid and Technical Specification, within 15 weeks* from the date of manufacturing clearance from BHEL. However, Drawings/documents/Type test reports/MQP etc shall be submitted within 15 days from the date of PO/input and every revised submission incorporating comments within 7 days from the date of comments. In case there are delays in submission /resubmission of drawing /documents as per above schedule, that much days would be reduced from deliver period.

Time required for type test, if applicable, is to be separately indicated.

* BHEL has considered 15 days' time (in delivery period) for arranging inspection and issue of dispatch clearance (MDCC/MICC) from BHEL end. LR / GR date or invoice date (whichever is later) for indigenous supplies and BL / AWB date for FOB / CIF (if applicable) contracts shall be considered as delivery date.

6. **Delivery Requirement: 30.09.2019.**
7. **Customer Approval:** Credentials of technically qualified bidder will be submitted for customer approval. Bidders are required to submit following credentials along-with their offer.
 - a) Vendor approval letter from other TANTRANSCO projects /PGCIL/NTPC/public utilities.
 - b) Proof of supplies (PO/work order copies of above customers).
 - c) Performance certificate (wherever applicable)

8. **Guarantee:** Guarantee for goods and works shall remain valid for 36 months for the specified works from the date of commissioning of works in all respect and taking over by TANTRANSCO. Scheduled completion date for project is **27/12/2019** or 18 months from the last delivery whichever is later.
 9. **Pre-Qualifying Requirement:** Technical QR as mentioned at Cl No. 1.5 (Annexure PQR_48V, Page No.36), Section-1 of Technical Spec No. TB-399-316-020.
- **Deviations must be mentioned in deviation schedule(s) and deviation mentioned, if any, elsewhere shall not be considered.**

Guarantee and PBG Clauses of GTC modified as

1. Guarantee

Clause No. 5 of general Terms & Conditions for tender Enquiry / Contract (Guarantee Clause) should be as follows:

The equipment / material supplied and services rendered (if applicable) shall be guaranteed to be free from all defects and faults in design & engineering, material, workmanship & manufacture and in full conformity with the Purchase Order / Contract, Technical Specifications & approved drawings / data sheets, if any, for 36 (Thirty Six) months for the specified works from the date of commissioning of works in all respects and taking over by TANTRANSCO (date is 27.12.2019) or 18 months from the last delivery whichever is later.

The defective equipment / material / component shall be replaced free of cost at site. Freight & Insurance during transit shall also be in the scope of the supplier / contractor. Any expenditure for dismantling and re-erection of the replaced equipment / material / component shall be to supplier's / contractor's account. All replacements during the guarantee period shall be delivered at site promptly and satisfactorily within a period not more than 45 days from the date of reporting the defect / rejection etc.

In the event of the supplier / contractor failing to replace the defective equipment / material / component within the time period mentioned above, BHEL may proceed to undertake the replacement of such defective equipment / material / component at the risk and cost of the supplier / contractor without prejudice to any other rights under the contract and recover the same from PBG / other dues of this Purchase Order / Contract or any other Purchase Order / Contract executed by the supplier / contractor.

2. Performance Bank Guarantee

Clause No. 7 of General Terms & Conditions for tender Enquiry / Contract (Performance Bank Guarantee clause) should be as follows:

Supplier shall arrange to submit Performance BG / Deposit on a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value along with first invoice or within 60 days from placement of Purchase Order (PO) whichever is earlier, in line with follows :-

PBG for 10% of the total Ex works PO value, valid for 36 months from the date of commissioning of works in all respect and taking over by TANTRANSCO (27.12.2019) or 18 months from the last delivery whichever is later, with claim period of 3 months extra over and above. Total PO value at the time of placement of PO shall be considered for calculation of the PBG amount.

Option “C”

Not Applicable

All remaining terms which are not mentioned here shall remain unchanged.

- Offer of techno – commercially acceptable vendors shall be considered for Price Bid Opening / RA.
- For this procurement, Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 15.06.2017 & 28.05.2018 and subsequent orders issued by the respective nodal ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before finalization of contract/PO/WO against this NIT.

In the event of any Nodal Ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and/ or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable.
