- 1: Technical Specification of the Product :Personal Protective Equipment - Safety Footwear as per BIS specification No IS 15298 (Part 2): 2016 Latest
- 2:Pattern: NA (Not required Derby pattern we need only plain finished leather pattern)
- 3:Mass of one pair of Footwear (gram): For 8 size shoes mass of one pair should not exceed 1100 grams
- 4:Colour Black/Brown
- 5:Insocks: Full Insocks with Leather ; Non Removable
- 6:Laces: Nylon or cotton
- 7:Cross Section Shape of Laces : Flat Laces with 90 cm length
- 8:Additional Requirements for Special Applications- Whole Footwear : Penetration Resistance (Metallic anti-penetration insert as per IS 15298) Electrical Properties-Conductive Footwear Antistatic Footwear Electrically Insulating Footwear Heat Insulation of Sole Complex Cold Insulation of Sole Complex Energy absorption of seat region Water resistance Metatarsal protection Ankle protection Cut resistance
- 9:Water penetration and absorption :Yes
- 10:Logo/ Totem/ Emblem : 1. Month and Year of Manufacturing on shoes 2. IS/CE marking on the shoes
- 11:The Shore hardness of the shoe shall be 55 to 65A
- 12:The shoes are to be machine stitched and no nails shall be used.
- 13:Free replacement shall be given for any manufacturing defect within 6 months from the date of acceptance at BHEL Stores.
- 14:The shoe shall be packed in a good quality cardboard box with shoe size supplier identity mark and year of manufacturing.
- 15:Each pair should bear shoe size supplier identity mark year and month of manufacturing and IS/CE/EN marking on the shoes
- 16:The bulk order to be placed only on single manufacturer. Order not to be split.
- 17:The vendor has to submit a pair of sample of size 8 inches along with the technical bid and the sample will be technically evaluated by evaluation team. And further selected by Safety Shoes Selection Committee. The committee has the right to select or reject the sample submitted by the vendor and the decision of the committee is final.
