4. Proposed delivery plan is **15.10.2017**. However, vendor has to quote their best possible delivery plan in activity schedule in activity schedule to meet the tender delivery requirement. In case, BHEL's delivery requirement is not met by vendor(s), then a chance may be given to all such vendors to review their quoted delivery schedule in line with BHEL's delivery requirement. However, if vendor fails to meet the requisite delivery plan, then BHEL reserves the right not to consider the offer of such vendor(s).
