- A) Product/package/services should have been successfully in use for atleast two years in thermal power station unit or in a similar industry/application.
- B) Performance Certificate (along with copy of relevant order copy) from the end-user for at least two successfully executed contracts.

OR

The Supplier have been awarded repeat contracts by same customer for the product for similar industry / application after 2 years of commissioning or on regular basis.

- C) The Bidder shall have designed, engineered, manufactured, supplied, erected, tested, inspected and commissioned at least two nos. of Oil Free Screw Type Air Compressors of minimum capacity of 6 Nm³/Minute with minimum discharge pressure of 8 Kg/ cm² installed in a thermal power station unit/ Refineries/ Steel Plants /similar industry. The system shall be complete with Refrigerant type air drying plant of matching capacity, Air receivers, Interconnecting piping, Control & instrumentation etc.
- D) Supplier should be an engineering organization / manufacturer for the selected package dealing with the package on regular basis.

In case the bidder is not manufacturer of proven equipment as above but has a collaboration/ joint venture or valid licensing agreement for Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Supply of such equipments in India/ abroad with manufacturers who meet the requirements as above for respective equipments/ system is also acceptable.

- E) Supplier to submit the following major documents:
- Supplier registration form duly filled in, (to be downloaded from www.bhhelpem.com separate forms for Indian and Foreign suppliers), supported by credentials / documents mentioned therein.
 - Registration Certificate from the registrar of companies/ partnership deed / Proprietorship documents etc as applicable.

- iii) Experience details for last 10 recently executed contracts/ evidence of continuity of business. Please use the format given in technical specifications for details.
 - iv) Indian suppliers need to submit the audited balance sheet for last 4 years to establish financial soundness commensurate with value of the package.
 - v) Foreign supplier need to submit a report from a reputed third party business rating agency like Dun & Bradstreet, Creditreform etc.
 - vi) Agency agreement needs to be submitted by foreign supplier in case of associating with Indian entity. (Refer Guidelines regarding dealing with Indian Agents of foreign suppliers- OEMs on website).
 - vii) Necessary supporting documents for verification of collaboration/ joint venture or valid licensing agreement shall be submitted.
- F) Mere submission of above documents does not entitle suppliers for enlistment or issue of tenders. It shall be subject to BHEL scrutiny of documents and / or physical survey and on merit, enlistment / issue of tenders shall be considered.
- G) Supplier to also apprise themselves with General Conditions of Contract available at above website for future business.
- H) The bidders, who are already registered with BHEL-PEM without any technical/financial limit, need not submit documents listed at E above.
