After reviewing the credentials BHEL will approve the vendor and take up with customer for vendor approval. **Price Bid of only BHEL registered and customer approved vendors shall be opened.**

Pre-Qualification Requirement:-

1. Please find the Technical & Financial Pre-Qualification Requirement Criteria as Annexure- B & C and vendors to submit their credentials.
The bidders, who are already registered with BHEL PEM without any ordering/financial limit, need not submit the financial PQR. They will consider qualified on financial PQR based on their registration with BHEL PEM.

Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical as well as Financial pre-qualifying requirements. Credentials of the bidders meeting the prequalifying requirements shall be taken up with customer for approval. Price Bid of only BHEL and customer approved vendors shall be opened and same shall be covered in NIT.

Only those vendors, who fulfil these requirements, are eligible to participate in this tender.

2. In case bidder himself does not meet the above PQR, they can quote based on the experience of their collaborator/associate that should have the requisite experience. In such case, the bidder shall be required to execute Joint Deed of Undertaking(JDU) with its collaborator/associate for back up guarantee of the plant and vetting of design by their collaborator, with additional bank guarantee/performance bond of amount equivalent to (five) 5% of the value of the total contract, in case being the successful bidder.

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
