## **PREAMBLE OF PRICE BID**

1.0. This Price Bid consists of three Schedules:

### **1.2 Schedule B**

Schedule B gives the details of free issue materials given by BHEL.

### **1.3 Schedule C**

Schedule C gives the details of Tools & Tackles provided by BHEL on Chargeable Basis.

2.0 The work to be carried out under the contract shall, except as otherwise provided in tender conditions, include all labour, materials, tools, plant, equipment, and transport which may be required in preparation of and for full & entire execution and completion of the Works. The descriptions given in the Schedule of Quantities shall, unless otherwise stated, be held to include waste on materials, carriage and cartage, carrying in return of empties, hoisting, setting, fitting and fixing in position and all other labours necessary in and for the full and entire execution and completion as aforesaid in accordance with good practice and recognized principles as laid down in Technical Specification & elsewhere in Tender Specification.

3.0 The price bid should not contain any condition. Conditional price Bids shall be summarily rejected.

4.0 The bidder should not leave any column blank in Price Schedules.

5.0 Price Quoted shall include all taxes, & duties except GST.

6.0 **Unless otherwise specified in the items involving cement or reinforcement steel, these items shall be issued free of cost by BHEL.**

1		Logbook to be maintained on daily basis to have record of all the above items.				

	2	In spite of instruction by Engineer-in-charge, if the contractor fails to deploy tractor with trolley/water tanker/ripper/plougher on a day, penalty will be imposed at 1.5 times the awarded rate of respective item of the contract.
	3	All repair work to the vehicle shall be in the contractor's scope. To minimise the down time, the contractor shall keep in his custody sufficient spares/components. In case of the vehicle remaining idle unnecessarily on account of the contractor or in case of break-down in the tractor or its attachment, the contractor shall arrange for a substitute tractor or respective attachment or arrange to restore the break-down tractor or its attachment to working condition within a reasonable time (not more than 4.00 hours in any case), otherwise penalty shall be imposed against the contractor as mentioned below:-  - If the time for restoration of services in case of the above said break-down or idle time on account of the contractor exceeds 4.0 hours, deduction shall be made on pro-rata basis for hours delayed @ 1.50 times the awarded rate (considering a day of 8 working hours) subject to the condition that the work has suffered in the opinion of engineer-in-charge.  - Even if the time for restoration of services in case of the above said break-down or idle time on account of the contractor exceeds 4.0 hours, deduction shall not be made from the contractor's bill subject to the condition that the work has, in spite of this default by the contractor, not suffered in the opinion of engineer-in-charge.  - It is preferable that the contractor deploys a replacement vehicle immediately to minimise the downtime so that the execution of work under scope does not suffer.
	4	Each vehicle shall, generally, perform a minimum of 4 trips (fully loaded) per day otherwise proportionate amount shall be deducted from the bills at the discretion of Engr-in-charge provided sufficient quantity of material/waste materials is available for disposal to designated locations. The stipulation of minimum number of trips to be completed by each vehicle per day as mentioned above may, however, be relaxed, at the discretion of engineer -in-charge depending upon the quantity of material/waste materials to be disposed and subject to the condition that no complaint regarding undisposed material/ waste materials is lodged /received from anywhere inside township area.
	5	The contractor shall ensure that there is no spillage/fall from trolley /vehicle during transportation of these waste materials. In case fall/ spillage takes place, the contractor shall immediately remove such fallen waste materials from roads/ ground levels failing which a suitable penalty shall be imposed on him as per discretion of engineer-in-charge.
	6	The contractor shall ensure that the drivers that are deployed in the work are medically fit and holder of valid driving licence to operate these vehicles. The vehicle engaged in the work shall be in good running condition and shall have all valid RTO papers such as registration, insurance, fitness certificate etc.
