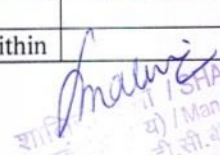

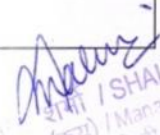

1.	Sealed Quotations are invited for entering into frame work agreement (rate contract) for procurement of Fibre optic Direct Hot Spot Temperature Monitoring System (FOTS), its accessories and its installation and commissioning, training for Two year period	
2.	Frame work agreement (FA) shall be valid for ordering up to 2 year from date of finalization of FA	
3.	Quantity of instruments mentioned in Enquiry Sheet is tentative and order shall be placed as and when required. Variation in quantity shall be $\pm$ 30% for each item.	
4.	Sealed quotations are invited in Two Part Bid System for supply of instruments/installation and commissioning/training as per BHEL specification TRE 219 Rev 00 enclosed along with enquiry. Any deviation shall be clearly brought-out.

Piplani, Bhopal-462 022, India so as to reach on or before 11.00 AM of tender due date. Tenders shall be opened on the same day at 02.00 PM. No late tender shall be entertained.	
7.	Bidders will have to quote for all the items in the enquiry. Offers where only some or part of the items are quoted shall be rejected. Vendor to submit unpriced price-bid along with technical offer.	
8.	PRICE:	
8a.	Prices for equipment/ accessories shall be quoted on FOR Destination basis, up to BHEL Bhopal, inclusive of freight and insurance charges and shall remain firm for entire period of framework agreement.	
8b.	Prices shall remain firm till validity and execution of the framework agreement.

9b1.	Supply Payment:	
	100% Payment within 90 days of receipt (45 days for MSE / NSIC registered suppliers as per relevant act in force) and acceptance of material at BHEL, Bhopal against SRV. Latest Udhog Aadhar/Udhya Certificate of vendor shall be enclosed to avail payment in 45 days as per MSE act.	
9c.	No "Advance Payment" Term will be accepted	
10.	VALIDITY: The offer should remain valid up to 120 days from the tender opening date.	
11.	DELIVERY:	
11a.	Delivery Schedule: Delivery schedule shall be quoted earliest possible from the date of PO, to meet the delivery requirement. Bidder shall commit delivery period in number of weeks/ months from PO date.	
11b.	Delivery Dates mentioned in Enquiry sheet are tentative. Actual delivery in PO shall be according to our requirement and delivery period quoted by vendor in its offer.	
11c.	Penalty for delay in supply: Penalty shall be levied as per clause 9 of general terms and conditions of enquiry (BP200102). Delivery shall be guaranteed by acceptance of penalty.	
11d.	Part shipment: Part shipment of material is not permissible.	
11e.	Short Shipment: In case of any short shipment in the main equipment/spares, where separates rates are not available in the contract, all taxes and duties levied on such supplies, if any shall be borne by the supplier.	
12.	WARRANTY:	
12a.	Warranty Period: The equipment shall be warranted for minimum 12 months from the date of successful commissioning or 18 months from the date of receipt, whichever is later.	
12b.	Warranty Replacements: Any warranty replacement during warranty period shall be provided on FOR, BHEL Bhopal basis only. Customs clearance and duty payments, if any, for such cases shall be to the account of vendor only. If Warranty Replacement is required to be done after commissioning of equipment at site, same will have to be done by vendor directly at site at their own cost.

In case GST credit is delayed/denied to BHEL due to non/delayed receipt of goods and/or tax invoice or expiry of timeline prescribed in GST law for availing such ITC, or any other reasons not attributable to BHEL, GST amount shall be recoverable from vendor along with interest levied on BHEL (if any).	
19.	In case vendor delays declaring any invoice in his return and GST credit availed by BHEL is denied or reversed subsequently as per GST law, GST amount paid by BHEL towards such ITC reversal as per GST law shall be recoverable from vendor/contractor along with interest levied on BHEL (if any).
