

BHEL wishes to enter into Rate Contract / Framework Agreement for supply of “**Outdoor Live Tank CT**”. Rate Contract Agreement will be valid for a period of **24 months** for ordering & **30 months** for supply from the date of Rate Contract finalization. The total requirement for the period is as given in enquiry copy separately. Same need to be supplied against Purchase Orders issued to supplier(s) time to time during the rate contract period.

Instructions for supplier(s) :

- 1) Quotations are invited in TWO PART BID only. Price bid(s) shall be opened only of PQC (Pre-Qualification Criteria) qualified and Techno-Commercially acceptable bidders. Quotation received in SINGLE BID will normally be rejected and will be considered only if the bid is PQC qualified & techno-commercially acceptable without seeking any clarifications from the bidder.
- 2) BHEL prefer the information to be furnished exactly in this format which will help to minimize repetitive clarifications / confirmations.
- 3) Ensure to sign and affix seal on each page of this annexure and submit along with your Techno-commercial bid.
- 4) However, if any of the terms of clause is not covered in this annexure, same may be indicated separately in your techno-commercial bid.
- 5) Acceptance of all the following terms & conditions is required in your offer. The same is to be signed by bidder(s) and submitted along with offer.

7	Validity of offer: 90 days from the date of tender opening.	
8	Quantity indicated in enquiry is tentative & PO will be placed item wise after receipt of customer PO / as per requirements.	
9	Payment Term:- 100% payment in 90 days of receipt (45 days for MSE including NSIC/ Udyog Aadhar registered suppliers as per relevant act in force), subject to acceptance of material at BHEL, on direct presentation of the documents.	

	In case of despatch of material to site directly, site certification for receipt of materials is required unless otherwise provided for in the PO. Any deviation from the above payment terms, if accepted (by BHEL), shall be loaded @ SBI base rate + 6% for the purpose of bid evaluation.	
10	For vendor covered under MSMED If yes, a copy NSIC certificate / CA certificate with EM II / Udyog Aadhar memorandum of registered suppliers is/are required to be submitted.) “MSE suppliers (manufacturers only) can avail the intended benefits only if they submit above documents, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (Format enclosed at Annexure-II where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. Documents should be notarized or attested by a gazette officer.”	
11	Integrity Pact as per enclosed Annexure to be essentially signed by vendors for consideration of bids.	
12	Vendors should meet Pre-Qualification Criteria as per attached PQC to participate in subject Tender otherwise offers will not be considered for further process.	
13	Penalty Clause: Please accept BHEL’s standard penalty clause “An unconditional penalty of half percent (0.5%) of the price of the goods in arrears per week subject to a maximum of 10% of the order value”	
14	Price Impact clause due to variation in quantity (i) BHEL shall not consider any kind of price impact offered by bidder on overall package price quoted by them due to change in quantity of any of the items of the enquiry. (ii) In case there is increase in quantity of any of the items of the enquiry, bidder is allowed to offer percentage discount w.r.t the unit rate quoted by bidder against those item(s) only. BHEL shall evaluate bidder’s package price for the enquiry based on discounted unit rate or original quoted price whichever is lower. (iii) In case there is decrease in quantity of any of the items of the enquiry before price bid opening, BHEL shall consider the unit rate quoted by bidder against those item(s) only for evaluation of bidder’s package price for the enquiry.	
15	Reverse Auction : “BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bids, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA. In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit “online sealed bid” in the Reverse Auction.	

	Non-submission of “online sealed bid” by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per latest extant guidelines.” H1 bidder (whose quote is highest in online sealed bid) may not be allowed to participate further in RA process.	
16	Packing Instruction: Utmost care must be exercised in packing and transporting the finished material, PO NO / Gross weight / Net weight should be mentioned in bold letters, on each case / Box. Packing list shall be furnished along with each consignment.	
17	Basis for deciding lowest (L1) offer: • Only offers meeting the terms and conditions of the enquiry will be considered. • All the offers shall be compared for total cost to BHEL stores. • In case of more than one bidder happens to occupy the L1 status, effective L1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from each L1 bidders. Even after soliciting discounts, if more than one bidder are L1, then the L1 bidder shall be decided by a toss / draw of lots, in presence of L1 bidders or their representatives. BHEL’s decision in such situations shall be final and binding. • Offers having deviations to the terms and conditions will be suitably loaded or liable to be rejected.	
18	Vendor has to quote against the enquiry or give regret letter with reason for not quoting.
