Sealed tenders are invited under **two bid system**, Techno-Commercial Bid (Part-I) and Price Bid (Part-II) from the reputed and experienced contractors with sound technical and financial capability for the subject work.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- I) Average annual turnover of the contractor during the last 3 years ending 31st March 2016 should be at least 30% of the estimated value. (i.e. ₹ 24,750/-). Turnover for last 3 years certified by the Practicing Chartered Accountant should be submitted as a proof. Tenderer should enclose copy of EPF, ESI, PAN, Service Tax New registration certificate along with Techno-Commercial bid.
- II) The Contractor should have experience of completing similar works during last 7 years ending 30th Nov'2016 as given below:
 - (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated value (i.e. ₹ 33,000/- each)
 - OR
 - (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated value. (i.e. ₹ 41,250/- each)
 - OR
 - (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated value. (i.e. ₹ 66,000/-)

Work/ Job Completion Certificates from the customer shall be enclosed in support of successful and satisfactory completion of the orders.

Note: Similar work means Electrical Maintenance works/ retrofitting of electrical works on regular contract basis for State / Central Govt. or under takings or private firms.

- III) The works executed in the own name of the tenderer will only be considered for eligibility criteria.

2. SCOPE OF THE WORK

The detailed scope of work is given in the special conditions of contract and as per schedule of Quantities.

3. LOCATION OF WORK

- a) The subject job is to be carried out inside BHEL-HPVP premises.
- b) The intending tenderers are advised to visit the above place, note down the entry procedures, safety requirements, work permit system etc. and satisfy themselves of all conditions prevailing there before submission of their tenders.

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT

- I. The tenderer shall submit EMD for ₹ 1,650/- (Rupees One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty) only in the following forms:
 - a) Cash Deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening).
 - b) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening).
 - c) Banker's Cheque/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft, in favour of BHEL, Visakhapatnam along with offer
- II. EMD by the tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:
 - a) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
 - b) The contractor fails to deposit the required security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract.
 - c) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- III. EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within 15 days of award of work.
- IV. EMD shall not carry any interest.
- V. EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit.

Note: Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) are eligible for exemption of EMD as per clause no. 15 annexure – II.

5. WORK COMPLETION PERIOD:

The work shall be completed within **45 Days** from the date of work order / date of intimation by Engineer - In - charge of BHEL – HPVP, Visakhapatnam. If the vendor fails to complete the job in stipulated time, **penalty** for delayed period is of **1% per week subjected to maximum of 10% of Work order value.**

6. INSPECTION:

Inspection shall be carried out by BHEL / BHEL Authorized inspection agency.

7. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Security Deposit shall be collected from the successful tenderer as per clause no. 10 of annexure – II.

8. INCOME TAX & WORK CONTRACT TAX:

Income tax & work contract tax as per statutory requirement will be deducted on payment made to the contractor and TDS certificate will be issued to this effect.

9. PAYMENT TERMS:

- a. 90% payment will be released within 30 days from the submission of bill to Electrical maintenance department along with completion certificate issued by Engineer-in-charge.
- b. 10% of the total amount will be released after the completion of guarantee period i.e., 2 months from date of completion or on closure of contract whichever is later. Withdrawal from contract during contract period in BHEL will entitle forfeiture of security deposit.

All payments will be released only through RTGS / NEFT.

10. PRICE SCHEDULE, TAXES & DUTIES:

- a. Prices shall be quoted in the price schedule attached to the tender for the complete scope of work.
- b. The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes & duties as applicable as on due date of tender submission except service tax. However, Service Tax as applicable shall be payable by contractor and same shall be reimbursed by BHEL on submission of proof of payment along with the bill.
- c. In addition to existing taxes, any new taxes imposed by Central/ State Govt. shall be payable by the contractor and same shall be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents/proof of payment.
- d. In case, any new tax is imposed instead of existing tax, difference of the amount shall be reimbursed/ recovered on submission of documentary evidence.
- e. Any new tax is imposed by Central/ State Govt. or there is any variation in taxes after expiry of delivery / contract period, the same shall be borne by contractor only.
- f. All terms & conditions of the contract in respect of taxes & duties are subject to new taxation laws introduced time to time by Govt. and terms & conditions will deemed to be modified in accordance with the provisions of New Laws (i.e., GST)
- g. The quoted prices shall be fixed & firm without any escalation during the entire period of contract and till completion of the work.
- h. Tenderer should quote the **rates in figures as well as in words**. In case of any mismatch between the quoted rates and amounts, the quoted rates shall be considered as final. It may be noted that corrections, overwriting etc. are not allowed
- i. All rates shall be quoted in the tender format only.

11. RISK PURCHASE:

In case the contractor fails to execute the work due to any reason, BHEL reserves the right to get the same completed through some other party at the risk & cost of the contractor and any additional expenditure incurred due to the same shall be charged to the contractor.

12. VALIDITY OF OFFER:

The offer shall be valid for a period of **3 months** from the last date for tender submission.

13. GENERAL:**13.1 Bidders shall confirm their acceptance to all the terms & conditions of the tender enquiry.**

Deviations to the tender conditions are not acceptable and BHEL-HPVP reserves the right to reject such offers which do not meet Technical / Commercial requirements without any / further correspondence.

Bids not accompanied with requisite EMD/NSIC/MSME registration certificate, late / delayed bids, incomplete / conditional offers, bids not conforming to the terms & conditions specified in the tender documents are liable for rejection.

13.2 BHEL reserves the right to modify or cancel or short close the tender at any stage at its discretion without assigning any reason thereof.

13.3 The bidders shall study the Tender documents and all other relevant documents in detail for understanding the scope of work involved in various items before submission of offers.

For any clarifications required on this tender document, scope of work etc., the bidders shall depute their authorized representatives to HPVP, Visakhapatnam with prior intimation to get clarifications from concerned authorities.

13.4 Dy. Manager (Electrical Maint.) shall be the Engineer-in-charge for herein after referred to as such in the tender.

13.5 Lowest offer need not be the rate acceptable to BHEL-HPVP. BHEL-HPVP reserves the right for negotiation with the L1 bidders as per applicable guidelines.

14. TENDER SUBMISSION:

14.1 The Bid shall be submitted in two parts.

Part-I: Techno-Commercial Bid shall be placed in one cover along with the following documents:

- All pages of tender document after duly signed & stamped
- Proof of document for payment of Earnest Money Deposit of ₹ 1,650/-
- Turnover for last 3 years certified by the Practicing Chartered Accountant
- Copy of P.F. Registration Certificate.
- Copy of E.S.I Registration Certificate.

- f. Experience Certificates in line with eligibility criteria
- g. Copy of Service Tax Registration Certificate.
- h. Copy of PAN
- i. All other applicable documents as detailed in the tender

Part-II : Price Bid in the prescribed format shall be placed in another separate cover.

The tender documents including the various supporting documents enclosed by the bidder should be signed on all pages with seal.

Both covers containing Part – I & Part – II bids shall be placed in another bigger size envelope duly super scribing the Tender No. & Subject on the envelope.

14.2 The tender completed in all respects shall be dropped in the Outsourcing tender box kept at reception counter, ADM building latest by 14.00 Hrs. on 06.01.2017.

Offers received in any other form will not be accepted.

Last date for receipt of tenders is 06.01.2017 up to 14.00 hrs. BHEL-HPVP is not responsible for any postal or other delays in submission of offers.

14.3 Submission of an offer by a tenderer implies that all the tender documents were read by the tenderer and the tenderer is aware of the scope and specifications of the work, site condition, local conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, free / chargeable materials etc., will be issued to him by BHEL - HPVP and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.

15.0 OPENING OF TENDERS:

Techno-commercial Bids will be opened on 06.01.2017 at 14.00 Hrs. at Customer Cell, Admn. Building, BHEL- HPVP. The bidders may depute their representatives at the time of opening. The price bid of the technically qualified bidders will also be opened in the presence of representatives of the bidders and the date & time of opening of price bids will be intimated later. In case of reverse auction, the date of conducting reverse auction will be intimated in advance at appropriate time.

If bids are not accompanied by requisite Earnest Money Deposit / NSIC / MSME registration certificate along with Part – I (Techno Commercial Bid), then Part-II (Price Bid) will not be considered for opening.

SCOPE OF WORK

The vendor's scope of work broadly consists of

TECHNICAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Supply of MCB with sheet metal enclosure and fixing of MCB in sheet metal enclosure and fixing of the sheet metal enclosure on K320 welding generator firmly with required nut, bolts etc. is in the scope of vendor. Vendor has to do internal wiring from connector block to MCB. Approx. 0.5 meter cable is required for each welding generator, which is to be supplied by the vendor.

Wire specification: 3 core X 4 sq. mm. copper flexible unarmoured cable of reputed make.

2. The contractors quoting the tender shall get themselves well versed with the site condition. The contractor should be well versed with all the activity.
3. Submission of tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specification of the work to be done.

SIGNATURE OF TENDERER WITH SEAL

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS1. **PERFORMANCE & QUALITY:**

The performance and quality of work will be closely observed and in case, the same is not satisfactory, this contract will be terminated without any notice.

2. **TIME SCHEDULE:**

All the works mentioned in the contract should be completed in all respects within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of work order / date of intimation by engineer-in-charge. The total contract will be operated in a staggered manner as per the availability of site.

3. **RISK PURCHASE:**

In case the contractor fails to execute the work within the scheduled time due to any reasons, BHEL reserves the right to get the same completed through some other party at the risk & cost of the contractor and any additional expenditure incurred due to the same shall be charged to the contractor.

4. Bidders shall confirm their acceptance to all the terms & conditions of the tender enquiry. Any deviations to the tender terms & conditions are not acceptable.

5. **PAYMENT TERMS:**

- a. 90% payment will be released within 30 days from the submission of bill to Electrical maintenance department along with completion certificate issued by Engineer-in-charge.
- b. 10% of the total amount will be released after the completion of guarantee period i.e., 2 months from date of completion or on closure of contract whichever is later. Withdrawal from contract during contract period in BHEL will entitle forfeiture of security deposit.
- c. All payments will be released only through RTGS / NEFT.

6. **SUB - LETTING:** Subletting of the assigned work will not be permitted. But in special circumstances, this may be allowed. In such case, the party should obtain the written approval from BHEL before Subletting.

7. The rates quoted by the contractor should be firm for the contract period. There shall be no revision in contract rates during the contract period.

8. BHEL reserves the right to negotiate for price reduction with L1 party and negotiated price will be considered as contract amount for all practical purposes.

9. **Earnest Money Deposit:**

A. EMD is to be paid by the tenderers for securing fulfillment of any obligations in terms of the NIT.

B. **Modes of Deposit:** The EMD may be accepted only in the following forms:

- a) Cash Deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening).
- b) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening).
- c) Banker's Cheque / Pay Order/ Demand Draft, in favour of BHEL, Visakhapatnam along with offer.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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Forfeiture of EMD: EMD by the tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:

- a) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
- b) The contractor fails to deposit the required security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract.
- c) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- C. EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within 15 days of award of work.
- D. EMD shall not carry any interest.
- E. EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit.

10. **Security deposit:**

- A. Security deposit means the security provided by the contractor towards fulfillment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
- B. The total amount of the security deposit will be **5% of the contract value**. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security deposit.

C. **Modes of Deposit:**

The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of 5% of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms:

- a) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
- b) Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.
- c) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the companies act. The bank guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
- d) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the companies act (FDR should be in the name of the contractor, a/c BHEL.
- e) Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)

Note: Acceptance of Security Deposit against Sl. No. (d) and (e) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith).

D. **Collection of Security deposit:**

At least 50% of the required security deposit, including the EMD, should be submitted before start of the work. Balance security deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required security deposit is collected

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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11. Security Deposit / Bank Guarantee will be released after the maintenance period of 2 months or on closure of contract whichever is later.
12. The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
13. **Towards Statutory Liability (if applicable)**
 - a) All statutory requirements under Minimum Wages Act-1948, Payment of Wages Act-1936, Workmen Compensation Act-1923, EPF, payment of Gratuity Act- 1972,. ESI Act-1948, The Contract Labour (R&A) Act-1970, Payment of Bonus Act-1965, Income Tax Act, Service Tax Act and all other applicable Acts shall be complied with latest version by the contractor.
 - b) Contractor shall comply with all statutory requirements, rules, regulations, notifications in relation to employment of his employees issued from time by the concerned authorities.
 - c) Contractor shall ensure payment of statutory prescribed minimum wages as applicable from time to time in the presence of authorized representative of BHEL and maintain proper records of their timely disbursement. These records need to be preserved for a period of at least 3 years and should be made available even after the contract is over for any verification by the statutory authorities / BHEL authorities.
 - d) Contractor shall ensure payment of ESI contribution under ESI Act, 1948 and provide ESI membership No. / card of each employee.
 - e) Contractor shall produce proof of deductions as well as remittances of PF, Pension, ESI contribution, administrative charges etc. wherever applicable and shall maintain proper records. Contractor to issue wage slips to his employees.
 - f) Contractor shall be solely responsible for non-payment/ delayed payment of wages /DA, contributions under EPF, ESI Act etc.
 - g) In case the contractor fails to make payment of wages to his employees or remittance of contribution to the concerned authorities, the security deposit / other dues / running bills under the contract can be utilized by BHEL to discharge the liability of the contractor.
 - h) Contractor shall indemnify BHEL against all claims and losses under various Labour Laws, statutes or any civil or criminal law in connection with employees deployed by him.
 - i) The liability for any compensation on account of injury sustained by an employee of the contractor will be exclusively that of the contractor.
 - j) Contractor to obtain insurance cover for his employees / equipment / tools etc. and take third party risk insurance coverage at his own cost BHEL shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, and pilferage of property and / or his employees.
 - k) Contractor should have independent code numbers / exemptions under EPF and ESI Act, 1948 and shall cover his employees under the said codes.
 - l) Payment of bonus under the payment of Bonus Act, Payment of gratuity under the Gratuity Act, and retrenchment compensation under Act will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
 - m) Over and above the daily wage rate, payment shall be made for leave with wages.
 - n) Contractor shall observe Provisions of the Factories Act in respect of working hours, holidays, rest intervals, leave and overtime to his employee.
 - o) Contractor shall be responsible for making payment of wages before expiry of 7 days from the last day of wage period and to ensure disbursement of wages in the presence of the authority's representative of contract operating division who shall record under his signature at the end of entries in the Register of wages.
 - p) Once the contract is awarded, it is the responsibility of contractor to pay wages due to intermediate minimum wages revision by Govt. and BHEL is not responsible to pay any additional amount due to such minimum wage revision by Govt.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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14. ARBITRATION:

Except as otherwise provided elsewhere in the contract, if any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arises between the parties hereto or their respective representatives, at any time, in connection with construction, meaning, operation, effect, interpretation or out of the NIT, contract or breach thereof, the same shall be referred to Arbitration of a Sole Arbitrator appointed by Unit Head.

Subject to as aforesaid, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any statutory modifications or re-enactment in lieu thereof and the rules made there under shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The award shall be a speaking and reasoned one and shall be final and binding on the parties. The venue of arbitration in all cases shall be at Visakhapatnam.

In case, there are different wordings/expressions of a same/identical clause at different places of this Tender Document, a stricter meaning of such clause which is in favour of BHEL will apply and binding on the bidder/Contractor.

15. **“MSE suppliers** can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) **or** valid NSIC certificate **or** EM II certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (Format enclosed at **Annexure-B** where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer”.
