2. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offer without assigning any reasons thereof. BHEL also reserve the right to cancel the offer wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof. BHEL also reserve the right to split/part award the job. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter (except for the refund of EMD)
3. No deviation with respect to tender clauses and no additional clauses/ suggestions/clarification in Techno-commercial bid/Price bid shall normally be considered by BHEL. Bidders are requested to positively comply with the same. Offers with deviation are liable for rejection.
4. You are free to visit the site and study the prevailing site condition including law & order etc. before quoting (if applicable).
5. For any clarification on the tender document, you may seek the same in writing or through e-procurement portal/platform as per specified format within the last date of seeking clarification as per tender. BHEL shall not be responsible for receipt of queries after due date of seeking clarification due to postal delay, and receipt of any query after due date shall not be entertained.
6. BHEL may decide holding Pre-bid Discussion [PBD] with all intending bidders. On such communication from BHEL, the bidder shall ensure participation for the same at the appointed time, date and place as may be decided by BHEL. Outcome of PBD (if any) shall also form part of tender.
7. In case of absence of any queries from bidder(s), their quoted price will be PRESUMED to be final and complete with reference to the tender documents (including Tender change notes (TCNs), clarifications, corrigendum issued by BHEL, if any). Bidders are requested to study the tender documents in detail and prepare their queries /clarifications accordingly. All such queries / clarifications shall be cleared/replied by BHEL. Such clarification letters, corrigendum and/or Tender change notes (TCNs), if issued by BHEL, shall form part of tender document.
8. In the event of any conflict between requirement of any clause of this specification/ documents /drawings /data sheets etc or requirements of different codes/ standards specified/ contradictions between any two clauses of tender document, the same to be brought to the knowledge of BHEL by bidders for clarification before due date of seeking clarification, otherwise, more stringent requirement as may be interpreted by BHEL shall prevail and shall be binding on you. Any typing error/missing pages/ other clerical errors in the tender documents, noticed by you must be pointed out before submission of offer, or else, BHEL's interpretation shall prevail & binding on you.
9. Unless specifically mentioned otherwise, bidder's quoted price shall deemed to be in compliance with tender including PBD.
10. Tender document containing above mentioned volumes shall be signed & stamped in all pages including this covering letter. Price bid shall be furnished in the specified format enclosed with the tender.
11. Price bids of those bidders will be opened who will be qualified for the subject job on the basis of evaluation of Techno-commercial bids / pre-qualifying criteria and as considered suitable by BHEL.
12. While BHEL reserves the right to open the price bid of the offers in camera. The date & time to open the tender opening shall be intimated to the bidders in case BHEL decides it to be 'Public opening' and in such a case, one authorized representative of the bidder shall be allowed to attend.

13. Taxes and duties shall be as per tender.

14. Statutory variation of taxes and duties (plus or minus) in accordance with Govt. Notifications to the account of BHEL. Any imposition of new / additional Duty / Tax at the time of supply shall be borne by BHEL.

15. **Bidders are required to submit price as per tender Price Schedule format in e-procurement portal/platform in the form & manner as mentioned in tender.**

16. **Overwriting or erasures should be avoided. If however, they exist they must be invariably attested.**

17. BHEL reserves the right to go for REVERSE AUCTIONING (RA) instead of opening the price in e-procurement portal/platform, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

In such case all qualified bidders will be intimated regarding procedure/ modality of process prior to RA and price will be decided through RA process only. In such case the price in e-procurement portal/platform, submitted by the bidder will not be opened.

18. In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'online sealed bid' by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue. Information and General Terms and conditions of Reverse Auction is attached in Part-F.

19. Reverse Auction is the type of auction typically conducted to buy goods / items over Internet in which the lowest price bidder wins. In case, the bidders are willing to know the details about the methodology, they may please contact HEAD/PURCHASE OR DGM/PURCHASE, BHEL, KOLKATA.

20. However, if Reverse Auction process is not adopted or Reverse Auction is unsuccessful as defined in the RA rules/procedures, or for whatsoever reason, then the 'PRICE BID' in e-procurement portal/platform, submitted by the bidder will be opened for deciding the successful bidder. BHEL's decision in this regard will be final and binding on bidder.

21. In case BHEL decides not to go Reverse Auction procedure for this tender enquiry, the price bid and price impacts, if any, already submitted in e-procurement portal/platform, submitted by the bidder shall be opened as per BHEL's standard practice.

22. Bidders are requested to note that the accepted / agreed tender terms (technical, commercial or on Reverse Auction) in their original offer can not be altered / withdrawn by their own during the processing of tender.

23. Unsolicited discounts received after opening of techno commercial bid shall not be considered for evaluation. However, if the party who has submitted the unsolicited discount/rebate becomes the L-I party, then the awarded price shall be after considering the discount.

1. **100% payment within 30 days of submission on invoices accompanied with receipted challan after receipt of materials at destination.**
2. All taxes and duties e.g. ED, VAT/CST, and any other levies shall be quoted separately, as per percentage of Basic Price.
3. Where there is provision for payment of VAT/CST extra it will be paid only if registration number under State VAT /Central Sales Tax is mentioned on the bill/invoice.
4. The supplier will insure at his cost the goods for all transit risk.
5. Our Bankers are STATE BANK OF INDIA, COMMERCIAL BRANCH, SALT LAKE, KOLKATA / IDBI BANK, PARK STREET BRANCH, KOLKATA. Bank Charges, if any, will have to be borne by the supplier.
6. Correct date of effecting supplies in the event of an order should also be recorded in the quotation.
7. Failure to despatch in time as per terms of delivery quoted in the order would make the supplier liable to an unconditional penalty of ½% of the value of goods ordered in arrears per week, at the discretion of the purchaser subject to maximum of 10% of order value. Non acceptance of penalty clause will attract maximum 10% loading on the offer and accordingly proportionate percentage will be loaded for accepting less percentage of penalty clause. Ex: If the supplier has accepted for maximum 5% penalty clause, then balance 5% will be loaded.
8. The equipment supplied shall be guaranteed for satisfactory performance for a period of eighteen months from the date of despatch or 12 months from the date of commissioning which ever is earlier, as per applicability.
9. The order may be spilt among the suppliers as per BHEL discretion.
10. Acceptance of all goods will be subject to our inspection either at the suppliers' works or on receipt at destination.
11. Material should be of standard quality and conforming to our specification / relevant I.S. or B.S.
Materials not conforming to those shall be rejected and returned to the suppliers at suppliers risk and cost.
12. Manufacturer's name, their trade mark and brand, if any should be mentioned illustrative leaflets giving technical particulars etc. should be attached.
13. Sample must be submitted where specified so as to reach us on or before the due date of enquiry.
14. No enhancement of rate for whatever cause will be allowed once the quotation is accepted and the order is placed. Withdrawal the quotation after it is accepted or failure to make the supply within the schedule period will entail cancellation of the order and forfeiture of earnest money if any and/or risk purchase and such defaulter is to be blacklisted.
15. The successful party should, if required by us in case the party is not included in the DGS & D list of rate contract holder furnish a security deposit or bank guarantee from the approved bank for an amount of 10% of the total value of the order for satisfactory execution of the same in accordance with the terms and conditions and delivery specified in the order.
16. The quantity of each item to be purchased may vary according to actual requirement at the time of placing order.
17. Any dispute arising out of this shall be referred to the sole arbitration of BHEL/PSER or any other officer nominated by the office and is award shall be final & binding on the parties. The venue of the arbitration in all cases shall be in Calcutta.

19. All suits in respect of this shall lie in the courts in Kolkata only.

21. Valid authorised dealership certificate shall be furnished with offer.
22. Supplier shall maintain and ensure necessary safety measures as required for inspection & test H.V. Tests, Pneumatic Test, Hydraulic test, Spring Test, Bend Test etc. to enable inspection Agency for performing inspection. If any test equipment found not complying with proper safety requirements then the inspection Agency may withheld inspection till time desired safety requirements are met.

2. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit ‘online sealed bid’ in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of ‘online sealed bid’ by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno-commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
3. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.

2.5	Supplier fails to respond against three consecutive tenders. ('Regret letter' from the Supplier is to be considered as response)
2.6	Supplier fails to settle any outstanding on account of material (including short return)/ scrap or on any other account.
2.7	Supplier works are under strike/ lockout for a period of more than six months.
3.0	De-listing A Supplier may be de-listed i.e. removed from the list of registered Suppliers of a Unit for all categories of material on the basis of one or more of the following reasons:
3.1	Supplier in any way tampers with tendering procedure affecting ordering process.
3.2	Supplier has misused BHEL documents/ drawings or has breached the confidentiality agreement with BHEL.
3.3	After placement of order, Supplier fails to execute the contract.
4.0	Banning A Supplier can be banned from doing any business with all Units of BHEL on the basis of receipt of evidence of one or more of the following reasons:
4.1	Supplier is found to be responsible for submitting fake/ false/ forged documents, certificates, or information or has resorted to unethical, illegal means in getting the contract.
4.2	In spite of warnings, the Supplier persistently violates or circumvents the provisions of labour laws/ regulations/ rules and other statutory requirements.
4.3	Supplier is found to be involved in cartel formation or in any act so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price.
4.4	The Supplier has indulged in malpractices or misconduct such as bribery, corruption and fraud, pilferage etc.
4.5	The Supplier is found guilty by any court of law for criminal activity/ offences involving moral turpitude in relation to business dealings.
4.6	The Supplier is declared bankrupt, insolvent, has wound up or been dissolved; i.e. ceases to exist for all practical purposes.
4.7	Supplier is found to have obtained any internal information/ documentation of BHEL by unauthorized means.
4.8	A decision has been taken by the administrative ministry of the Government to ban business dealings with a Supplier and such decision has been communicated to BHEL.
4.9	The foreign Principals along with the representing Agent shall be banned together if information submitted by them about their precise relationship, commission/ remuneration etc. payable/ receivable and other particulars as asked by BHEL, as per the extant guidelines regarding dealing with Agents of Foreign Suppliers is found false/ incorrect.
4.10	Supplier has substituted, damaged, failed to return, or unauthorizedly disposed off free issue materials/ tools etc. of BHEL.
5.0	Contracts already entered with a contractor before the date of issue of order of 'HOLD' or 'DE-LISTING' shall not be affected.
6.0	All existing contracts with a 'BANNED' contractor shall normally be short closed
7.0	Once the order for banning is passed, existing offers/ new offers of the Supplier shall not be entertained.
8.0	The above guidelines are not exhaustive but enunciate broad principles governing action against contractors
