Indigenous suppliers:

1. Response to Tenders for Indigenous supplier will be entertained only if the vendor has a valid GST registration no which should clearly have mentioned in the offer. If any specific exemption is available, a declaration with due supporting documents need to be furnished for considering the offer. 6. In case of discrepancy in the data uploaded by supplier in the GSTN portal or in case of any shortages or rejection in the supply, then BHEL will not be able to avail the tax credit and will notify the supplier of the same. Supplier has to rectify the data discrepancy in the GSTN portal or issue credit note (details to be uploaded in GSTN portal) for the shortages or rejections in the supplies, within the calendar month notified by BHEL.
7. 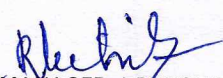
