Sub :- “Examination & certification of testing of relief valves of LPG storage vessels by competent person.

Dear Sir,

Sealed tender is invited in two part bid system for carrying out the work as per the details given in scope of work (Annexure-I).

Duration of work	:	3 full day visits (The test due dates of safety relief valves are 18-11-2019, 01-12-2019 & 15-12-2019. The work must be completed on or before due dates)
Period of Contract	:	15.11.19 to 16.12.19
Last date of tender submission	:	01-11-2019 upto 11:00 am (Tender received after due date & time will not be accepted)
Date & time of tender opening	:	01-11-2019 at 2:00 pm
Place of tender submission	:	Tender room, administrative building, ground floor, BHEL Bhopal– 462021

1.0 Techno-commercial Bid (Part-1): The first envelop shall contain the Techno-commercial bid as per the enclosed Annexure – I, II, III, IV, V & VI duly signed by the contractor and with copies of relevant documents. The envelope shall be super scribed “Techno-Commercial bid Enq. No. (name of work)”.

1.1 Price bid (part-2): The second envelope shall contain the price bid only. The price shall be quoted in price bid format only. The envelope shall be sealed and super scribed “Price Bid Enq. No.(name of work)”.

1.2 Both the above two envelopes shall be kept in another sealed cover. The cover shall be super-scribed with “Quotation for Enq. No..... (name of work)”, Due date The tender can be sent through post or dropped to Works Tender Box Tender Room, ADM Building, Ground Floor of BHEL, Bhopal – 462021, before due date & time. (It should also contain Tenderer address).

2.0 Eligibility criteria/ qualifying requirement:-

1. Only those contractors/agencies/competent persons who are recognized by Chief Controller of Explosives, PESO, Govt. of India, Nagpur under Static and Mobile Pressure vessels (Unfired) Rules 2016 [rule 18(2)(xiii)] for testing of relief valves and have valid recognition certificate during the test dates.
2. The copy of valid competent person certificate from PESO is to be submitted along with the offer.
3. The offer of other parties will not be considered and will be rejected.

3.0 Tender terms:-

- a) The tender should be valid for one month.
- b) BHEL, Bhopal reserves right to accept the tender in full or in part and tenderer shall be bound to perform the work as per amount quoted in tender.
- c) The other terms and conditions are as per annexure-I, II, III, IV, V & VI.

4.0 Compensation of Delay/ Penalty Clause:-

In case the contractor does not carry out the contractual/statutory obligations and the general terms and conditions or the services rendered by him are found to be unsatisfactory, it will brought to his notice first to rectify the deficiency/ anomaly within specified time (3 days) failing which BHEL reserves the right to impose penalty (0.5% per week of contract value will be deducted after 3 days time, limited to maximum 10% of contract value) and/or terminate the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever. In such an event, no damages will be payable for short closure of the contract. The remaining work may be awarded to any other suitable agency at risk and cost of contractor.

5.0 Payment terms :-

The payment will be made after satisfactory completion of work through Fin (works) as per BHEL terms. GST shall be paid only when relevant bill/invoice bearing GSTN registration no. of both contractor & BHEL is submitted.

Note:- Any loss or delay in input tax credit (ITC) due to reasons attributable to contractor to be recovered from contractor with interest.
