Terms & Conditions	: 1. Delivery within 06 weeks from the date of PO. In case of any deviation to delivery terms loading on quoted price shall be done @ 0.5 % per week or part thereof and max. up to 10% for the period of relaxation sought for comparing L1 standing. 2. 100% PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT AND VERIFICATION OF MATERIAL AT STORE SUBJECT TO SUCCESSFUL INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING AND ITS ACCEPTANCE. ANY DEVIATION IN PAYMENT TERMS WILL BE LOADED (SBI PLR RATE AT THE TIME OF TENDER OPENING + 6 %) ANNUAL INTEREST RATE FOR SOUGHT RELAXATION TIME PERIOD FOR COMPARING STANDING. 3. (a) Rates to be quoted for BHEL-Rudrapur deliver basis. Freight and insurance shall be in the scope of supplier only. (b)-Scope of Supply-Design, Manufacturing, supply and installation with all clamps at BHEL Rudrapur. (c) - Offers from Manufacturers or authorized dealers shall be acceptable only. 4. Test certificate shall be required for chemical and mechanical properties of the material and it must be certified by a LAB which is having the accreditation from NABL (National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories). Inspection shall be done by BHEL/Third party at suppliers works prior to dispatch. If BHEL wants to waive off the inspection at suppliers works then supplier has to submit all the inspection reports and test certificates to BHEL for obtaining dispatch clearance, however final acceptance of the product will be done only after receipt and successful installation and commissioning at BHEL Rudrapur. 5. Calibration certificate required with supply. 6. Bidder has to submit performance/execution certificate from at least two customers. 7. Minimum 01 year warranty required for the date of commissioning. 8. LD/Penalty clause shall be applicable with this enquiry. The delivery of goods shall be made strictly as per time limit specified in delivery schedule. Failure to supply within this period will make the supplier liable to a penalty of $\frac{12}{100}$% (half percent) of the total order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order value for the reasons attributable to the party. 9. Rates are to be quoted including transit insurance and transportation charges. 10. 01 set of operation & maintenance manual required in hard copy and same in soft copy also.		

11. Tender shall be awarded based on quoting lowest price on item wise basis and to techno-commercially qualified bidder(s) only.

12. Risk Purchase clause shall be applicable with this enquiry. RISK PURCHASE CLAUSE: On finding non-supply of the PO as per PO delivery terms, BHEL may source the material from any alternate arrangements/orders. On such occasions, the difference of amount shall be recovered from pending /subsequent bill(s) of original supplier.

GST Clause:

BHEL will evaluate offers of all bidders on "cost to BHEL" basis and the eligible input credit of GST (including IGST, CGST, OR UGST whichever is relevant) likely to be passed on by bidders to BHEL will be reduced from total cost to arrive at "cost of BHEL".

Hence it is responsibility of successful bidders to ensure that bidder to follow all relevant GST Act and rules, provision amended from time to time to enable BHEL to take input credit of GST on the invoice amount submitted to BHEL against supplies made/ services rendered.

Successful bidders will be required to prepare invoice as per relevant provision of GST Act/Rules amended from time to time and should file the returns correctly and in timely manner to enable BHEL to take timely input credit of GST on Vendors invoice

BHEL will make provisional payment of GST charged to successful bidders against invoice submitted to it as advance along with main payment. Any loss of GST input credit to BHEL due to fault of bidders shall be compensated by bidders to BHEL along with interest and penalty.

Decision of BHEL regarding fault/ omissions made by bidders in following GST provision resulting in loss of input credit to BHEL will be final and binding on successful bidder.

Facilitation of MSE bidder:

MSE bidders are encouraged by BHEL and shall be facilitated as per prevailing MSME act. MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of valid MSE certificate like EM-II certificate or NSIC certificate or Udyog Aadhar Memorandum or any other relevant certificate provided by any other body specified by Ministry of MSME, Govt under Public Procurement Policy along with attested copy of a Chartered Accountants certificate not older than one financial year .

Non-submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening/reverse auction. If the tender is to be submitted through e-procurement portal, then the above required documents are to be uploaded on the portal. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer.

Suspension of Business Dealings:

Action shall be taken as per extant BHEL "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/Contractors AA/MM/SB/01 Rev.02 Dated 22.07.2016" against Supplier as well their agents who either fail to perform or are in default without any reasonable cause like force majeure, cause loss of business/money/reputation, indulge in malpractices, cheating, bribery, fraud or any other misconduct or formation of cartels so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price, tempering with tender process etc. Further details in this regard can be accessed through BHEL website www.bhel.com

Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-Submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder (s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com). The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates. If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealing with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).''
