3.1 Enquiry No., due date etc. must be legibly superscribed on the sealed envelopes as per clause no. 2.0 of "Procedure for submission and opening of tenders".

3.2 Bidders shall submit their offers meeting the requirements of the following tender documents (enclosed) and other Terms and Conditions included in this Enquiry Letter:

- **Part-I: Techno-Commercial Bid:** Comprising of technical offer, Annexure-I, Commercial terms and conditions, unpriced copy of price bid and Annexure-II, PQR documents and credentials.

- **Part-II: Price Bid:** Containing prices, **cost of withdrawal of deviation (As per Annexure-II of GCC Rev 06)**, to be submitted in original, strictly, as per price schedule of BHEL for complete scope of Tender enquiry.

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All the above Tender Documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalisation.

3.3 Tenders shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of the above tender documents. Deviations (Technical as well as Commercial as per attached sheet), if any, shall be listed out separately. Technical deviations and Commercial deviations shall be furnished in separate sheets under the headings "**TECHNICAL DEVIATIONS**" and "**COMMERCIAL DEVIATIONS**" respectively, along with reasons for taking such deviations.

3.4 Standard pre-printed terms & conditions of the tenderers shall not be considered valid.

3.5 In case there is no change in the technical scope and / or specification and / or commercial terms and conditions, the bidder/s shall not be allowed to change his / their price bids after the due date within the validity period.

3.6 In case of joint bidding, Scope matrix should be clearly defined between foreign bidder and their Indian representative along with the offer.

3.7 If any bidder has mentioned the term Not Applicable / Not Require / Not Quoted in BHEL price format. Hence bidder to need to substantiate the same. If the same item will require in future for the system same will be supplied free of cost.

3.8 Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

3.9 Tenderers must enclose the Quality Plan in the prescribed format, for approval. Equipment will be despatched only after Purchaser's/Owner's inspection at the hold points specified in the approved Quality Plan and issue of Material Despatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC).

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3.11 Late tenders will be rejected.

3.12 **Delivery Schedule:-** Delivery shall be six (06) months from the date of drawings/documents approval. Vendor to submit drawings/documents for approval within two (02) weeks from the date of P.O. and resubmit drawing/document within 10 days incorporating all comments. In case there are delays in submission of documents beyond 02 weeks of order or 10 days of comments that much days of delay would be reduced from delivery period.

3.17 During price evaluation in case of foreign currency bids, exchange rate (TT selling rate of State Bank of India) as on schedule date of tender opening (part I bid in case of two part bids) will be considered for conversion in Indian Rupees. No correspondence will be entertained on this account.

3.18 Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total cost to BHEL) basis

3.19 CIF is not available for this package.

3.20 Foreign and indigenous bidders participating through open tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India for future tenders. Basic procedure /checklist has been upload on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquires through e procurement.

3.21 MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate (Format enclosed at Annexure-1 where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted Officer.

3.22 Indigenous bidders needs to indicate the freight charges in percentage of total Ex-works in unpriced format.

3.23 All the tender documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalization.

3.14 "BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder.

This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance

With the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)."

As a reminder to the bidders, system will flash following message (in RED Color) during the course of 'online sealed bid': "Bidders to submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed bid already submitted to BHEL".

3.15 All vendors participating in an open tender shall be required to meet the PQ criteria irrespective of their being registered/ not registered with BHEL, failing which offer of such vendor(s) shall be rejected and the price bid (Part-II) opening/Reverse Auction is subject to the following:-
