In Case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items

3. The bidder has to note that this is a conditional tender enquiry. Price bid (Part-II) opening of the bidder is subjected to following:
- A. Techno-Commercial recommendation by BHEL.
4. This item/package /system falls under the list of items defined in para 3 of ministry of finance guideline dtd. 20.09.16 (Procurement of items related to Public safety, Health, Critical Security operations & Equipments etc.) & hence criteria of prior experience/Turnover shall be same for all the bidders including startup/MSME.
5. Bidders have to note that Department of Expenditure's (DOE) Order (Public Procurement No. 1 and No. 2) vide ref. F. No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23/07/2020 is applicable to subject tender. Bidders have to go through Annexure-B (of this NIT letter) and to note that same forms the part of NIT. Accordingly, a bidder has to bid as per the provisions of above referred DOE's order/s & Annexure-B.
6. Bidder has to comply Govt. of India, Ministry of Power, Order no.-25-111612018-PG dated 02/07/2020 regarding testing of imported equipment, components and parts. For details, please refer the order.
7. In case of joint bidding, Bidders shall be required to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between them along with the offer for the complete scope as per NIT

Supplier has to made first submission of BoM within 30 days of CAT-I or CAT-II approval of primary documents, whichever is earlier and subsequent revision within 10 days of BHEL comments. BoM shall be considered as Secondary Document.

10. Evaluation will be done on total cost to BHEL, excluding GST with necessary loading/s (as applicable).

11. Bidder has to note that The Evaluation Currency for this tender shall be INR.

12. Overall (%) quantity variation: Variation on overall package value due to changes in the scope shall be -30% to +30%.

13. CIF is not applicable for this package.

14. BHEL shall be resorting to Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) for this tender. RA shall be conducted among all the techno-commercially qualified bidders. Price bids of all techno-commercially qualified bidders shall be opened and same shall be considered as initial bids of bidders in RA. In case any bidder(s) do(es) not participate in online Reverse Auction, their sealed envelope price bid along with applicable loading, if any, shall be considered for ranking.

Vendors to note that above RA clause will supersede clause no 13 of "Instruction to Bidders" of GCC Rev 07

The Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. Total Cost to BHEL) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, Freight as applicable, including loading (if any). De-loading (if any) shall be done in line with NIT terms.

All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.

18. If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any consequences thereof. Hence all bidders are requested to be more careful at the time of uploading the Unpriced and Price Bid for Part-I and Part-II respectively to avoid mismatch.

19. Bidders have to note that Deviations from NIT are generally not acceptable. Deviations, if any, are to be listed out clearly, as per Annexure-II (Deviation Sheet – Cost of Withdrawal), of GCC Rev 07, in techno-commercial offer. Any deviation mentioned or shown separately or found hidden in offer, will not be taken cognizance of.

In case of deviations from NIT, the bidder shall give the cost of withdrawal of such deviation in Price Bid, as per Annexure-II, Deviation Sheet (Cost of Withdrawal) of GCC Rev-07. For multiple deviations, all deviations are to be mentioned in “Deviation Sheet” and “cost of withdrawal” must be mentioned separately against each deviation.

20. MSE Bidder has to declare UAM number on CPPP, failing which such bidder will not be able to enjoy the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order 2012.

21. Bidders have to note that Due to COVID-19 pandemic condition prevailing in the country, BHEL/PEM may go for Remote Inspection of Offered items, if required. Vendors are requested to be equipped with the facilities/gadgets as indicated in the guidelines attached to take up the inspection REMOTELY.

22. Bidders to ensure that Third party / customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have verifiable details of document / certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of Issuing Authority and its organization contact number and e-mail Id etc. In case the same found not available, Purchaser has right to reject such document from evaluation.

23. Bidder has to note that following forms the part of terms & conditions of the tender:

“The bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other bidder(s).
