SECTION – I

SCOPE OF WORK

BHEL desires to appoint reputed Fumigation Agency for its Export cargo at either its nominated godown or at port of loading or on the Container or JNPT or MBPT or Truck at various ports both Air & sea.

Detailed Terms & Conditions for such appointment are as follows:-

- i) The Fumigation Agent will depute his representative for carrying out necessary Fumigation.
- ii) The Fumigation Agent will make his own arrangements for entry into ports, various places for official and equipments for carrying out the job inside ports or other area as and when required.
- iii) The Fumigation Agent to ensure retrieval of equipments and man power without involvement of BHEL and their CHA. The Fumigation Agent to ensure their equipments are safe inside the port and BHEL will in no manner be liable for any loss / damage.
- iv) The Fumigation Agent to ensure adoption of practices of fumigation without harming surroundings including port labour by the way of fumigation or any other. The Fumigation Agent will be fully responsible for any or all claims if any arise out of the process being followed during fumigation.
- v) The Fumigation Agent should submit certificates of Phytosanitary Compliance (Standard ISPM-15) or any other acceptable Compliance acceptable in the international Trade.
- vi) The Fumigation Agent to ensure Stamping of all the wooden packages for compliance required as per relevant standards.
- vii) The Fumigation Agent to be present during customs examination for explanation of the Phytosanitary compliance carried out, if desired
- viii) The Fumigation Agent to co ordinate with the CHA for carrying out timely activities to ensure that there is no delay in going ahead with further processing of the cargo.
- ix) The fumigation work has to be certified by CHA representative at site that the fumigation has been done to the satisfaction of customs.

Description of work mentioned above is illustrative and not exhaustive and they will have to consider all incidental works if involved while conducting the job in giving their rates. No incidental/additional charges will be payable for any other miscellaneous works connected with the handling of above jobs.

If felt necessary the contractor may also be called upon to fumigate import Cargo of BHEL.

3. The price offer must be made only in the formats enclosed with this tender.
4. The offers shall be kept valid for a period of **1 month** from the date of opening of the tender.
5. BHEL reserves the right to accept any tender or part of tender or to reject all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- (1) The Special Conditions mentioned herein will supersede the General Terms and Conditions mentioned in SECTION ñ IV.
- (2) **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** If the contractor fully performs and completes the works in all respects to the entire satisfaction of BHEL and presents an absolute "No Claim Certificate" in the prescribed form and returns properties belonging to BHEL taken, borrowed or hired by him for carrying out the said works, the amount of Security Deposit will be released to the contractor after deducting all costs , expenses and other amounts that are to be paid to BHEL under this or other contracts entered into with the Contractor. It may be noted that in no case the Security Deposit shall be refunded / released prior to passing of final bill.
- (3) **EVALUATION CRITERIA:**
Price Bids would be evaluated on the basis of total cost by applying the rates given in price bid to quantum of work load specified in the price bid.
- (4) **Following documents shall be required for payment :-**
- (a) Fumigation Tax invoice in original.
 - (b) Copy of Fumigation certificate.
 - (c) Original job slip of fumigation of commodity with CHA stamp and sign.

- (5) **PAYMENT TERMS**

 - c) If the GST payment portion not reflected on GST portal at the time of payment than the payment will be made after deduction GST.

- (6) **Taxes & Duties on payments :**
- (a) GST will be paid extra as applicable
 - (b) TDS will be recovered from bills as per the rules prevalent.

 - (d) Invoice having incorrect GSTIN no will have to be rectified by contractor. Financial liability if any for incorrect GSTIN no will be borne by contractor.

SECTION IV GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.0** The following terms shall have the meaning hereby assigned to them except where the context requires otherwise:-
- 1.1** "COMPANY" OR "BHEL" (or B.H.E. Ltd.) shall mean Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, a Company registered under Indian Companies Act 1956, with its Registered Office at BHEL House, Siri Fort, New Delhi-110 049, India or its Authorised Officers or its Engineer or other Employees authorised to deal with this contract.
- 1.2** "BIDDER" shall mean the Party bidding for the Tender.
- 1.3** "OPERATOR" shall mean the individual, Partnership firms or Private / Public Limited Co. or any legal entity who enters into Contract with BHEL and shall include their executors, administrators, successors and assigns. "OPERATOR" shall also mean "OPERATOR" "CONTRACTOR" "CARRIER" "TRANSPORTER" or "MTO" where the context so requires.
- 1.4** "CONTRACT" or "CONTRACT DOCUMENT" shall mean and include the agreement, the work order, the accepted appendices of rates, Schedules of Quantities (if any), General Terms and Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract, Instructions to Bidder, the drawings, the Technical Specifications and the Special Specifications (if any).
- 1.5** Any conditions or terms stipulated by the bidder in the tender documents or subsequent letters shall not form part of the Contract unless specifically accepted in writing by BHEL and incorporated in the Agreement.
- 1.6** "TENDER SPECIFICATIONS" shall mean the Scope of Work, Special Instructions / Conditions, Technical specifications/requirement , Appendices, Site Information and drawings pertaining to the work and any other relevant reference in the Tender Document for which the Bidder are required to submit their offer.
- 1.7** "APPROVED" "DIRECTED" or "INSTRUCTED" shall mean approved, directed or instructed by BHEL.
- 1.8** "SINGULAR AND PLURAL" etc. words carrying singular number shall also include plural and vice versa, where the context so requires. Words imparting masculine gender shall be taken to include the feminine gender and words imparting persons shall include any Company or Association or Body or Individuals, whether incorporated or not.
- 1.9** "VALIDITY OF THE CONTRACT" The contract will remain valid till all the activities specified therein are completed in all respects to the satisfaction of BHEL.
- 1.10** "COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT" The contract will be treated as complete on full and final settlement of all Bills / invoices raised under the contract with no claim on either side.
- 1.11** Contractor shall ensure that their staff maintains maximum efficiency and decorum and discharge their duties in a manner commensurate with our culture. Under no circumstances indiscipline and inefficiency will be tolerated. In case it is found that their staff are indulging in misbehavior or indiscipline or theft or sleeping on duty or forgery or involving in any act; which in BHEL opinion, will cause disturbance, industrial relations problems, reduction of production/plant efficiency, indiscipline, immorality, loss or damage to the personnel/property/equipments etc. belonging to BHEL business associates, then BHEL reserve the right to expel such person(s) of their staff without reference to Service Provider. Contractor shall be advised of such an action and then

Contractor shall promptly replace such person(s) and ensure the work is not affected in any way. Under no circumstances their staff will be construed to be our employees directly or indirectly to which Contractor agree.

- 1.12 Contractor shall provide competent supervisor to supervise the total job and ensure that all the jobs are completed in time without any delays.
- 1.13 Contractor are required to provide supervisors cum coordinators who shall be responsible for execution of assignment allotted, taking care of statutory concessions, organizing uninterrupted jobs, handle labour relation & discipline at site, take care of accident cases. These supervisors cum coordinators shall be technically qualified & competent to effectively & efficiently carry out the aforesaid duties.
- 1.14 Contractor shall ensure that the personnel deputed at our site are duly trained and proficient in their job. Also, they must be properly screened and cleared by taking recourse to verification of their antecedents and meeting of stipulated requirements.
- 1.15 Contractor shall issue uniforms, safety shoes and other safety appliances and identity cards to their personnel and shall provide them with all statutory benefits and welfare measures that are required under law. Contractor shall produce us on demand evidence of such measures of benefits/measures which are supposed to give to their personnel. Service Provider shall maintain all records pertaining to their personnel. BHEL shall not be liable or responsible under any circumstances for injury or death of their personnel at site. Contractor shall take suitable insurance cover for this and make us co-beneficiary of the policies. Contractor undertake to pay all their personnel by 7th of every month. To ensure adequate performance as required for this agreement, Contractor shall exercise adequate supervision and control. The supervisor to be deputed by Contractor shall be authorised by Contractor to take all decisions that are required to be taken at site arising out of the scope of work in the plant including industrial relations.
- 1.16 Contractor shall be responsible to maintain all the property, equipments given to Contractor for rendering the services in good order. Reasonable wear and tear shall be accepted. However any loss or damage made to these due to reasons attributable to Contractor shall be made good by Contractor at their risk and cost or the cost for the same shall be recovered from their bills.
- 1.17 Either party will claim on the other at any point of time any consequential damages including but not limited to loss of profit, loss of goodwill, etc.

2.0 Issue of Notice: The Operator shall furnish the name, designation and addresses of his Operators/associates at Mumbai, All complaints, notices, communications and references shall be deemed to have been duly given to the Operator, if delivered to the Operator or his Operator/representative.

3.0 Commencement of Work: The Operator shall commence the work on specific intimation from BHEL in writing or the time indicated in the LOI and shall proceed with the same with due expedition without delay. If the Operator fails to commence the work as per the terms of Order/Contract, BHEL, at its sole discretion will have the right to cancel the Order/Contract. His Earnest Money and/or Security Deposit will stand forfeited without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regard.

4.0 Invoices And Payment Terms:

The Operator will be required to raise the Invoice for the services rendered. The Invoices will have to be raised according to the explicitly agreed rates and payment terms of the contract.

The payments shall be made through RTGS/NEFT. The contractor would be required to submit bank details for receiving the payments.

In case the, TDS is not applicable, the contractor will have to produce the exemption letter from the relevant authorities to this effect.

In case of any revision in the Service Tax rates the same shall be considered.

5.0 Risk Purchase: BHEL reserves to itself the following rights in respect of this Contract without entitling the Operator for any compensation.

5.1 If at any time during the currency of the contract, the Operator fails to render all or any of the services required under the scope of work of the contract satisfactorily in the opinion of BHEL, whose decision shall be final and binding on the Operator, BHEL reserves the right to get the work done by other parties or departmentally at the cost and risk of the Operator and also forfeit the Security deposit.

5.2 To recover any moneys due from the Operator, from any moneys due to the Operator under this or any other contract or from the Security Deposit.

5.3 To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges & overheads in case of termination of Contract.

6.0 Observance Of Local Laws :

6.1 The Operator shall comply with all Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations etc. The Operator shall obtain all necessary permits/approval from the local Governing Body, Police and other concerned Authorities as may be required under law.

6.2 The Operator shall pay all taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tolls, royalty, commissions or other charges that may be Leviable on account of any of the operations connected with the execution of this contract.

6.3 The Operator shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed.

7.0 Safety of Men, Equipment, and Material & Environment:

All safety rules, codes applied by BHEL/its customer at site shall be observed by the Operator and his workmen without exception. The Operator shall be responsible for the safety of the equipment/materials and work to be performed by him.

8.0 Laws Governing the Contract: The contract shall be governed by the Indian Laws for the time being in force and only courts in Mumbai, India shall have jurisdiction over this contract.

9.0 Indemnity: The Operator shall indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL all losses, claims etc. arising out of any of his acts or out of the acts of his Operators or associates or servants during the currency of the contract.

10.0 The agent shall ensure that the Fumigation inline with the latest requirement placed by relevant authorities.

11.0 Security Deposit:

11.1 Successful bidder shall submit 5% of the total contract value as security deposit within Five days of issue of LOI for the contract. EMD of the successful Bidder shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit

11.2 Security deposit may be made in any of the following ways:

11.2.1 Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.

- 11.2.2 Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. Bidder to obtain the proforma for Bank Guarantee format from BHEL on issue of LOI.
- 11.2.3 Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Bidder, a/c BHEL).
- 11.2.4 Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Bidder furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL).
- Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith
- 11.3** If the value of work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Bidder or recovered from payment/s due to the Bidder.
- 11.4** The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
- (Note: Acceptance of Security Deposit against Sl. No. 11.2.3 and 11.2.4 above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith). Securities / BGs shall be released after one **(1) month** of successful execution, completion of the contract and upon fulfillment of contractual obligations as per terms of the contract.

12.0 Requirements Of Performance

- 12.1 All permissions / Clearances or any other relevant authorization from competent authority shall be obtained by the Operator at his own cost. Any contingency arising in this respect shall be the responsibility of the Operator. Also the Operator shall be responsible for any mishap, accident en route and consequences therefore including legal complications, if any.
- 12.2 The contract as entered into between BHEL and the Operator shall in no way, nullify, reduce, mitigate or absolve the parties of any responsibility, obligation or liability that may devolve upon them under the acts or laws governing such activity.
- 12.3 Fumigation Services Agent(s) shall be responsible and accountable to BHEL for proper safety, care, handling and storage of cargo while it is in their custody or control and or that of their agents.

13.0 Force Majeure: Both OPERATOR and BHEL shall be governed by Force Majeure condition. If at any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, blockades, insurrections, riots, terrorist acts, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, landslides, lighting, earthquakes, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes or other industrial disturbances, lockouts, act of God , storms floods, washouts, arrest and restraints of the government, necessity for compliance with any court order, law ordinance or regulations promulgated by any governmental authority having jurisdiction, either federal or state, civil or military, civil disturbances and any other events (hereinafter referred to as events) provided, notice of the happening of any such event is given by either party to the other within 14 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of BHEL as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive.

14.0 TIME LIMIT FOR SUBMISSION OF BILLS:

The Bidder shall make a claim for the services rendered under this contract to BHEL within **(3)Three months** of such service. If he does not prefer claim within the said

period, he shall be deemed to have waived his right in the respect thereof and shall not be entitled to any payment on account thereof. Nevertheless, the accepting authority on written request can waive off this limitation and allow late submission of bills if the reasons for delay are found convincing and reasonable.

No claim in respect of under payment to the Bidder shall be considered valid or entertained unless a claim in writing is made thereof within **(3) Three months** from the date on which payment of the original claim thereto was made. Any claim for such under payment, not received within the stipulated four months period, shall be liable to be summarily rejected by BHEL. Nevertheless, the accepting authority on written request can waive off this limitation and allow late submission of bills if the reasons for delay are found convincing and reasonable.

However, in case of any specific issue over which the Bidder had not billed for any particular activity the same can be allowed for payment, subject to with the prior approval of the General Manager, notwithstanding what has been laid down in the Clause on Payment. The decision of the General Manager shall be final and binding on the Bidder.

15.0 Prevention of Corruption: Canvassing in any form or any attempt to influence directly or indirectly any official of the company will lead to rejection of the bid & forfeiture of the EMD.

The company shall be entitled to cancel the contract and to recover from the Operator the amount of any loss resulting from such cancellation, if the Operator has offered or given any person any gift or consideration of any kind as an inducement or reward for doing or intending to do any action in relation to the obtaining or the execution of the contract or any other contract with the company or for showing or indenting to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the contract with the company, if the like acts shall have been done by any persons employed by him or acting on his behalf whether with or without the knowledge of the Operator in relation to this or any other contract with the company.

16.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

EMD of the Bidder will be forfeited if:

After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the Bidder revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.

The Bidder fails to deposit the required Security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOA/ Contract

If the bidder declines to accept the LOA or is unable to accept the work which has been awarded on the basis of the offer received from the bidder or revokes the offer within the validity period of the offer, the earnest money shall stand forfeited

EMD by the Bidder shall be withheld in case any action on the Bidder is envisaged under the provisions of extant 'Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ Bidders' and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.

EMD of successful bidder will be adjusted towards part of the security deposit.

EMD of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned normally within fifteen days of placement of LOA/Work Order on successful bidder.

EMD shall not carry any interest.

In case total EMD amount is more than Rs.2 Lakh, the amount in excess of Rs.2 lakh maybe accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee from scheduled bank. The Bank Guarantee in such cases shall be valid for at least six months

17.0 Discrepancy In Words & Figures: Quoted In Offer :

If, in the price structure quoted for the required goods/ services/ works, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless in the opinion of the purchaser there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price corrected accordingly.

If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and

If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject of 20.1 and 20.2 above.

If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored.

The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com.

18.0 MSME suppliers: The bidder may also be a Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) vendor registered as per MSE act. As per the public procurement policy notified by the Central government.

25% of the tendered quantity is earmarked for MSE suppliers in this tender. Out of the 25% tendered quantity reserved for MSE suppliers, 6.25% shall be earmarked for procurement from MSE owned by SC / ST entrepreneurs. Also 3% shall be earmarked for procurement from MSE owned by women.

In case MSE vendor participating in the tender quotes within the price band of L1 + 15%, they will be allowed to supply the portion of the requirement subject to acceptance of L1 price by MSE vendor. In case of more than one such MSE, the supply shall be shared proportionately.

"MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM, II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate with due validity or Udyog Aadhar No along with attested copy of a CA certificate (where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders.

In case any improper / lack of documents is there vendor on their own interest may submit all the relevant documents as stated above, before tender opening.

No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiencies in the above required documents are not submitted before tender opening. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer for consideration of MSE certificate. "

Such Micro/Small Enterprises registered vendors must state the sub-category to which they belong and submit documentary proof for the same. The sub-categories:

(a) Enterprises owned by Scheduled Castes.

(b) Enterprises owned by Scheduled Tribes.

(c) Enterprises owned by other than above two categories

The enterprises under (a) & (b) means the proprietor in case of single owned firm and all partners in case of partnership firm and all directors in case of private/public limited must belong to SC/ST category (Such enterprise will have to submit relevant document for proof of SC/ST category during offer submission) (Note: vendor need to go through General note Of tender condition also for any special instruction & deviation from above.)

If more than one valid MSE supplier stands with in range of L1+15% range, 25% of quantity will be shared till quantity split is feasible & rest of 25% will be awarded to lowest quote of valid MSE supplier.

Note: Wherever for splitting of order, if splitted quantity comes out <1, the splitting of order will not be feasible. (for MSE vendors).

Further updates or any changes, will according to MSE procurement policy. Traders will be excluded from the above MSE benefit as per MSE public procurement policy.

For MSE vendors getting award-

In order to get benefit to MSE suppliers in Bill timely payment MSE supplier will have to send the original hard copy of Udyog Aadhar No (UAN) supported by CA certificate of last fin yr. Scanned copy is not acceptable for MSE consideration.

Payment for MSE Indigenous eligible vendors will be as per MSMED Act 2006 subject to fulfilment of above procedure.

21.2.3. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.
