- 2. The tender shall address to OFFICER INVITING TENDER AS INDICATED IN THE TENDER NOTICE.
- 3. Tenders submitted by post shall be sent as "REGISTERED POST ACKNOWLEDGEMENT DUE" and shall be posted with due allowance for any postal delay. The tenders received after the due date and time of opening is liable to be rejected. Telegraphic offers and offers received by telex may not be considered.
- 4. Tenders shall be opened at the time and date as specified in the tender notice in the presence of such of those tenderers or other authorized representatives who may be present.

- 8. Tenderers must submit both Technical and Price-Bid clearly.
- 9. All enteries in the tender shall either be typed or be written in ink. All cancellations and insertions shall be duly attested by the tenderer.

THE OFFER SHALL BE KEPT OPEN FOR ACCEPTANCE FOR A MINUMUM PERIOD OF TWO MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF OPENING OF TENDERS.

11. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:

The successful tenderer's responsibility under this contract commences from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent by Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited. The successful tenderer shall be required to complete the job within 20 days of placement of order.

12. To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges and overheads. In case of termination of contract and to levy liquidated damages for delay in completion of work, at the rate of ½% of the contract value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a ceiling of 10% of the contract value.

#### 12. REJECTION OF TENDER AND OTHER CONDITIONS:

The acceptance of Tender will rest with B HEL which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves to itself full rights for the following without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

- a) To reject any or all of the tenders.
- If a tenderer expires after the submission of his tender or after the acceptance of his tender, BHEL may at its discretion, cancel such tender. If a partner of a firm expires after the submission of the tender or after the acceptance of the tender, BHEL may cancel such tender at its discretion unless the firm retains its character.
- b) BHEL will not be bound by any power of Attorney granted by the tenderer or by chances in the composition of the firm made subsequent to the execution of the contract. BHEL may,however, recognize such power of Attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice, the cost of which will be chargeable to the contractor concerned.
- c) If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender, BHEL reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage or to cancel the contract, if awarded,and forefeit the moneys due.
- d) Canvassing in any form in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractor who resorts to canvassing are liable to be rejected.
- e) The successful tenderer should not sub-contract the part or complete work detailed in the tender specification without written permission of BHEL. The tenderer is solely responsible to BHEL for the work awarded to him.
- f) No deviations to the tender condition will normally be accepted. However,if the tenderer insists for certain deviations to the conditions, financial implication thereof shall be loaded to the quoted price for evaluating the tender's offer.
