### 1.0 **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

The Contractor shall have experience in maintenance of online UPS systems during last 7 years ending 30th Nov 2017. Work Order & Work Completion Certificates from the customer shall be enclosed in support of successful and satisfactory completion of the orders.

### 2.0 SCOPE OF THE WORK:

Work is to be carried out as per Scope of Supply (Annexure-I),

### 3.0 LOCATION OF WORK:

- 3.1 The subject job is to be carried out at inside ADM Building of BHEL, Heavy Plates & Vessels Plant (HPVP), Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
- 3.2 The intending tenderers are advised to visit the above place, note down the entry procedures, safety requirements, work permit system etc. and satisfy themselves of all conditions prevailing there before submission of their tenders.

### 4.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

- I. The tenderer shall submit EMD for ₹ 740/- (Rupees Seven Hundred Forty only) in the following forms only:
- II. EMD by the tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:
  - a) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.

### 5.0 WORK COMPLETION PERIOD:

Contract shall be valid for a period of One Year from the date of work order or intimation from CS & IS. Dept., whichever is later.

### 6.0 **SECURITY DEPOSIT**:

- A. Security deposit means the security provided by the contractor towards fulfillment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
- B. The total amount of the security deposit will be **5%** of the contract value. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security deposit.

### C. Modes of Deposit:

The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of **5%** of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms:

- a) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
- b) Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.

### D. Collection of Security deposit:

At least 50% of the required security deposit, including the EMD, should be submitted before start of the work. Balance security deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required security deposit is collected.

### G. Refund of Security Deposit:

- b) Security deposit shall not be refunded to the Contractor except in accordance with the terms of the Contract.

### 7.0 INCOME TAX:

Income tax as per statutory requirement will be deducted on each payment made to the contractor and TDS certificate will be issued to this effect.

### **8.0 PAYMENT TERMS:**

Payment will be made on monthly basis within 30 days from submission bill along with following documents to CS & IS department.

- a) Invoice/Bill
- b) Work Completion certificate issued by CS&IS department.
- c) RTGS
- d) GST payment proof is to be submitted along with the bill.

**Note:** All payments will be released only through RTGS / NEFT through BHEL proforma. Electronic Funds Transfer form (enclosed in Annexure-B) duly filled and certified through bank may be enclosed.

### 9.0 PRICE SCHEDULE, TAXES & DUTIES:

- a. Prices shall be quoted in the price schedule attached to the tender for the complete scope of work.
- b. The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes & duties as applicable as on due date of tender submission except GST. However, GST as applicable shall be payable by contractor and same shall be reimbursed by BHEL on submission of proof of payment along with the bill.
- c. In addition to existing taxes, any new taxes imposed by Central/ State Govt. shall be payable by the contractor and same shall be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents/proof of payment.
- d. In case, any new tax is imposed instead of existing tax, difference of the amount shall be reimbursed/ recovered on submission of documentary evidence.
- e. Any new tax is imposed by Central/ State Govt. or there is any variation in taxes after expiry of delivery / contract period, the same shall be borne by contractor only.
- f. All terms & conditions of the contract in respect of taxes & duties are subject to new taxation laws introduced time to time by Govt. and terms & conditions will deemed to be modified in accordance with the provisions of New Laws like GST.
- g. The quoted prices shall be fixed & firm without any escalation during the entire period of contract and till completion of the work.

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h. Tenderer should quote the rates & amount in figures. In case of any mismatch between the quoted rates and amounts, the quoted rates shall be considered as final. It may be noted that corrections, overwriting etc. are not allowed. If there is a discrepancy between amount in figures & words, the amount in words shall prevail unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail. ### **SCOPE OF WORK**

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### 2.0 Scope of work:

- 2.1 The contractor shall provide maintenance service to keep the UPS and battery banks in good and efficient working condition. The contractor should provide preventive and corrective maintenance of UPS and battery bank and should get verified from authorized persons of CS & IS Department. He should also carry out necessary repairs and provide SUITABLE replacement (equivalent or higher configuration) of defective part(s) / equipment's as required.
- 2.2 The AMC is comprehensive i.e. no cost of parts replaced by contractor will be borne by BHEL HPVP, Visakhapatnam except batteries, transformer, DC capacitor.

### 3.0 Preventive maintenance:

The preventive maintenance (PM) is to be carried out once in 3 months. The preventive maintenance includes the following:

- I. Checking the general performance of UPS and battery banks.
- Cleaning of UPS and batteries.
- III. Checking fitment of internal and external hardware and heating of the system.
- IV. Cleaning of PCBs if any.
- V. Checking of operating parameters.
- VI. Checking of input /output voltages of batteries.

### 4.0 Breakdown maintenance:

The break down calls registered by CS & IS Department must be attended promptly and if they are not rectified within 24 hours (excluding Sundays and holidays), the contractor shall provide a suitable replacement for the defective UPS. Maintenance of all the UPS pertaining to these would be the responsibility of the vendor.

- 4.1. The contractor has to provide a new equivalent parts / items with same or higher specifications available in the market of the faulty items. No UPS will be allowed to go outside of BHEL HPVP Visakhapatnam for repair.
- 4.2 Contractor should have enough spare parts of UPS at their service centre so that UPS could be repaired timely.
- 4.3. If the UPS is not repaired within 24 hours (Excluding Sundays & holidays) after reporting the complaint, penalty shall be imposed @Rs.500/ per day. If UPS is not repaired beyond three days, UPS can be repaired from outside at the risk and expense of the contractor.
- 4.4 Installation of batteries, thimble and connectors provided by BHEL HPVP Visakhapatnam, as and when required should be replaced by service provider.

### **5.0 General Conditions:**

**5.1** Agreement between contractor and BHEL-HPVP Visakhapatnam will remain in force for period of one year from the issue date of work order.

- **5.9** Payments will be made on quarterly basis only after satisfactory completion of work in each Quarter, after submitting preventive maintenance report, breakdown maintenance report & required statutory documents.
- **5.10** No component (s) / Spare(s) shall be removed without informing to CS & IS department.
- **5.11** Contractor has to display their phone numbers on the UPS.
- **5.12** No transport will be provided to the contractor/ service engineer for maintaining the UPS or for attending the breakdown call. No transportation allowances will be allowed. No TA will also be paid to the staff of the contractor.

### 1. Availing Input Tax Credit (ITC) by BHEL:

- 1.1 GST portion of invoice shall be released only upon: -
  - 1.1.1 Contractor declaring such invoice in his GSTR-1.
  - 1.1.2 Receipt of goods and tax invoice by BHEL.
  - 1.1.3 Confirmation of payment of GST thereon by contractor on GSTN portal.
- 1.2 Further, incase GST credit is delayed/ denied to BHEL due to non / delayed receipt of goods and/or tax invoice or expiry of timeline prescribed in GST law for availing such ITC, or any other reasons not attributable to BHEL, GST amount shall be recoverable from contractor along with interest levied/ leviable on BHEL.
