BHEL invites offers from reputed Vendors (refer prequalification requirement, if any and other requirements given in enquiry letter uploaded on our websites i.e. www.bhelpem.com & www.bhel.com) for Design, manufacture, inspection and testing at manufacturer's works, proper packing, delivery to site of SCREENED CONTROL CABLES as per technical specification and other details hosted on BHEL & Mjunction website (<https://bheleps.buyjunction.in>).

2. Please note that you have to submit offers in two parts (Techno-Commercial Bid and Price Bid) separately ONLINE via e-Procurement System. Please send us an Acknowledgment for the receipt of Enquiry by mail or Letter. In case you are not making an offer against this enquiry, you are requested to send a regret letter such that the same is received to us on or before the due date.
3. Your best quotation/offer for the above requirement, in line with our terms and conditions, should be submitted online via e-procurement system. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the Tender is submitted on or before the due date by 02:00 PM. Part-I bids shall be opened at 03:00 PM on the due date.

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- 4. Terms and Conditions: - Please refer GCC Rev 06 which is available on www.bhelpem.com. You are requested to kindly download the same.**

4.1 Bidders to note that following form the part of tender documents:

- a. General Conditions of Contract (GCC) Rev 06.
- b. Corrigendum to GCC Rev. 06
- c. Technical Specifications.
- d. Price format & Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) Rev.00.
- e. Technical PQR.
- f. NIT Conditions

4.2 Bidders to note that offers shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of the above tender documents. Deviations (Technical as well as Commercial), if any, shall be listed out clearly with their techno-commercial offer as per annexure-II of GCC Rev-06.

Bidder has to submit "NO DEVIATION CERTIFICATE FOR COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS as per General Conditions of Contracts (GCC, Rev.06), Special Conditions of Contract and Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)" in case of no deviations.

4.3 Any hidden conditions/deviations mentioned elsewhere in offer and standard pre-printed terms & conditions of the tenderers shall not be considered valid.

4.4 Unsolicited Fresh/Revised Price Bids shall not be entertained

4.5 In case of joint bidding, Scope matrix should be clearly defined between foreign bidder and their Indian representative along with the offer.

4.6 If any bidder has mentioned the term Not Applicable / Not Require / Not Quoted in BHEL price format. Hence bidder to need to substantiate the same. If the same item will require in future for the system same will be supplied free of cost.

4.7 Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

4.8 Tenderers must enclose the Quality Plan in the prescribed format, for approval. Equipment will be despatched only after Purchaser's/Owner's inspection at the hold points specified in the approved Quality Plan and issue of Material Despatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC).

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4.9 Integrity Pact (IP)

IP is a tool to ensure that activities and transactions between the Company and its Bidders/ Contractors are handled in a fair, transparent and corruption free manner. A panel of Independent External Monitors (IEMs) have been appointed to oversee implementation of IP in BHEL.

The IP as enclosed with the tender is to be submitted (duly signed by authorized signatory who signs in the offer) along with techno-commercial bid. Only those bidders who have entered into such an IP with BHEL would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this Pact would be a preliminary qualification.

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4.10 Late tenders will be rejected.

4.11 Delivery Schedule: - a) Four (4) months from the date of Approval of drawings/documents in Cat-I by BHEL/customer subject to bidder's first submission within two weeks from the date of PO/LOI & resubmission of the revised drawings/documents within 07 days from the receipt of BHEL-PEM comments. Any deficiency in the document w.r.t. agreed specification/comments from BHEL or submission without compliance sheet shall be treated as non-submission and No. of days delay in submission/resubmission of complete documents during approval process, on account of this, would be reduced from the delivery. b) Subsequent Lot: Three (03) months from BHEL clearance.

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4.12 "BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

As a reminder to the bidders, system will flash following message (in RED Color) during the course of 'online sealed bid':

"Bidders to submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed bid already submitted to BHEL".

4.13 All vendors participating in an open tender shall be required to meet the PQ criteria irrespective of their being registered/ not registered with BHEL, failing which offer of such vendor(s) shall be rejected. Price bid (Part-II) opening/Reverse Auction is subject to the following:-

- a) Techno-commercial qualification / recommendation of bidder by the BHEL-PEM
- b) Approval of bidder by BHEL's Customer (i.e. M/s TANGEDCO). Same shall be taken up by us with customer based on the latest credentials/reference list (Preferably not older than 5 years) furnished by bidder. Accordingly you are requested to submit the following on or before technical bid Part-1 opening:-

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- (i) Company Profile
- (ii) List of projects executed/ on hand for power sectors / Govt. organizations for the subject package.
- (iii) Performance Certificates for satisfactory working of the system /equipment's.
- (iv) Copies of major supply order executed by the vendor.

4.14 Evaluation shall be done excluding GST quoted by bidder.

4.15 CIF is not available for this tender.

4.16 Foreign and indigenous bidders participating through open tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India for bid submission. Basic procedure /checklist has been upload on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquires through e procurement.

4.17 MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted Officer. Bidder to also note that MSEs who submit registration certificate or register themselves after placement of PO shall also be given payment preference as per MSMED-Act 2006.

4.18 Indigenous bidders need to indicate the freight charges in percentage of total Ex-works in unpriced format.

4.19 All the tender documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalization.

4.20 The bidder along with its associate/collaborators/sub vendor/subcontractors/sub vendors/consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice. BHEL Fraud prevention policy is also uploaded in vendor's section on www.bhelpem.com.

4.21 All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications etc. to the tender will be hosted on BHEL & MJunction websites only. Bidders are requested to visit our websites from time to time to keep themselves updated.

4.22 Insurance (Ocean and Inland) is in BHEL's scope.

4.23 Commercial terms of NIT only to be considered and mentioned anywhere in technical specification in case contradicting to be ignored.

4.24 The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offers of the bidders , who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected .The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site **www.bhel.com**

4.25 For guidelines of Foreign Suppliers & Indian agents of foreign suppliers: Please refer our website <https://www.bhelpem.com/gcc.aspx>;

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- 4.26 As per Incoterms (CFR), risk transfers to buyer when the goods have been loaded on board the ship in the country of Export. Hence, shipped on board date mentioned on the clean Bill of Lading or Air way Bill, shall be treated as the date of Shipment/ Dispatch for all contractual purposes including calculation of LD.
- 4.27 Usance period (90 days) of the L/C shall start from the date of Bill of lading/Air Way Bill.
- 4.28 Bill of Lading shall be considered as equivalent document (refer clause 9.7.1 b) for recognition of despatch.
- 4.29 For claiming payment under clause 9.1.1, 9.2.1 and 9.3.1 Bill of lading shall be considered instead of receipted LR (refer clause 9.7.2 b).
- 4.30 Insurance for evaluation purposes shall be @ 0.1 % of quoted C&F price.
- 4.31 Online Registration Portal is operational in BHEL. Non-registered Vendors, who wish to apply for registration with BHEL-PEM, have to apply through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com ' vendor section ' Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted.
- 4.32 Consignee name will be PEM, Noida with full address. However, the destination in LR shall be of Customer Site. Delivery order shall be issued by BHEL-PEM in such cases in favour of customer.
