2. VENDOR'S SCOPE OF WORK:

5. INSPECTION:

6. DELIVERY:

Local SR is to be completed within 2 days after handing over of job by PV Shop to the vendor.

7. PENALITY:

If delivery exceeds the stipulated delivery schedule, penalty 1/2 % per week subject to a maximum of 10% on the value of delayed supplies will be levied. However, time taken for the following will not be considered as delay on the part of the vendor.

8. PAYMENT TERMS:

100% payment will be made after handing over of the finished items duly inspected & cleared by Inspection Authority along with all inspection documents.

Payment shall be made within 30 days from the date of submission of Bill. Bill to be submitted to engineer-in-charge along with following documents:

No gate pass will be given to take back the above on completion of work if the contractor fails to show the security department's certification that the material has been brought inside.
- 4. The quantities provided in the schedule are only provisional and may vary according to exigencies of work and no claim can be entertained on this score.
- 5. The contractor should follow the rules and regulations annexed with for employment of labour by contractors in BHEL, Visakhapatnam.

6. **SECURITY DEPOSIT**

- A. Security deposit means the security provided by the contractor towards fulfillment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
