INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

1. Sealed Tender for the above noted work is hereby invited from Contractors experienced in works of similar kind and magnitude.
2. Tenders should be addressed to the AGM /HRM (ESTATE OFFICER) Electronics Division, Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Mysore road, Bangalore – 560 026. In two separate sealed cover for “Technical cum Commercial Bid” and Price Bid duly super scribed and put in an outer envelope, super scribing the Name of work and Name and address of the Tenderer.
 - 2.1 The local address of the Contractors, the name of the person to whom all the Correspondence are to be addressed should be indicated, with telephone number (both office and residence), FAX /E-mail address, Mobile phone No. etc.
3. All entries in tender documents should be in same ink (**preferably blue ink**). Erasing and overwriting is not permitted. The tenderer concerned with proper indication of the name, designation and address of the person signing should duly sign all cancellations and insertions.
4. Tenderers shall fill in all the required particular in the blank space provided for this purpose in the tender documents and also sign in each and every page of the tender document including the drawings attached there to before submitting tender.
5. Unit rate should be quoted in figures as well as in words in Indian Currency only i.e. Rupees and Paise with reference to each item and for the items shown in the attached schedule. These rates shall be for the finished work at site. The rate shall include all taxes and duties payable on account of GST etc. Amount of each item and total on each sheet as also the grand total amount of the whole contract shall be filled by the tenderers.
6. **GST** Compliance is mandatory and all the transactions will be as per GST.
7. In quoting their rates, the tenderers are advised to take into account all factors Including any fluctuations in market rates. No claim for enhanced rates will be entertained on this account after acceptance of the tender or during the currency of the contract.
 - a. If, in the price structure quoted for the required goods/services/works, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price corrected accordingly.
 - b. If there is an error in a total corresponding to the additional or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and

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- c. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject of (a) and (b) above.
- d. If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored.

8 (a) The rate quoted in the tender shall remain valid for a period of **'THREE MONTHS'** from the date of opening tender.

(b) Tenderer shall not increase quoted rates, once the tenderer has submitted offers/quotation/price and during execution of contract in case tender is accepted.

(c) Successful bidder should execute the work strictly in accordance with Tender schedule quoted rates as accepted by BHEL.

9. Quantities shown in the schedule are only approximate and are liable to variation to an extent of 20% (Twenty percent). Within this variation, the contractor is not entitled for any compensation.

10. Before tendering, the tenderer is advised to inspect the site of work and its environments and be well acquainted with the actual working and other prevailing conditions, position of material and labor. They should be well versed with BHEL General Conditions of Contract, instruction to the tenderers, drawing and specification and all other documents which form part of the agreement to be entered into subsequent to award of work. The tenderer should specially note that it is tenderers responsibility to provide any items which is not specifically mentioned in the specifications and drawing, but which is necessary to complete the work.

11. Details and quantities of each item of work shown in the bill of quantities attached here to only approximate. They are given as a guide for the purpose of tendering only and are liable for variation and alteration at the discretion of the competent authority. The work under each item as executed shall be measured and price at the corresponding rates to be quoted by the Contractor in the bill of quantities attached hereto.

12. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm the tender must be signed separately and legibly by each partner or member of the firm or in their absence, by the person holding the power of Attorney on behalf of firm concerned. In the later case, a copy of the power of Attorney duly attested by a Gazetted Officer must accompany the tender.

13. If in any case, the date of Tender Opening falls on holiday, the Tender will be opened on the next working day.

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14. Every tender must be accompanied by **Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.1.41 lakh**. This earnest money will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderers after finalization of the award of work. In the case of successful tenderer, the earnest money will be retained as a part of Security Deposit for satisfactory completion of the work in accordance with Clause-16 of BHEL General Conditions of the Contract. Tenders without Earnest Money Deposit receipt are liable to reject. No interest will be paid on the earnest money deposit.

16. For reimbursement of Earnest Money Deposit, the tenderer should fill the enclosed EFT form, obtain the Banker's signature and also enclose a photocopy of cancelled cheque leaf.

17. Unless the bidder whose tender is accepted signs contract agreement within fifteen days (15 days) of the date of the order directing to do so, the amount of Earnest Money already deposited by bidder will be forfeited and acceptance of the tender withdrawn.

18. If after opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes the tender or makes any modification in their tender or the tenderer fails to deposit the required Security deposit or commence the work in accordance within the period as per LOI/Contract, the Earnest Money Deposited by bidder will be forfeited and acceptance of bidder's tender withdrawn. If only a part of work included in the tender had been awarded to the tenderer, the amount of Earnest Money to be retained will be based on value of the contract so awarded.

19. EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within fifteen days of award of work.

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20. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

20.1 Upon acceptance of the tender, the successful tenderer shall remit the security deposit with Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd within the time as specified in the Letter of Intent.

The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the contract value. EMD of the successful Tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the require amount of Security Deposit.

20.2. The Security Deposit should be furnished before start of the work by the contractor in the form of:

(i) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)

(ii) Bank cheques of scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/Pay Order/Demand Draft/Electronic fund transfer in favour of BHEL.

(iii) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/Public Financial Institutions as defined in the companies act. The bank guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL (Annex-III)

(iv) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of Contractor, a/c BHEL).

(v) Securities available from Indian Post Offices such as National Saving Certificate, Kisan Vikas Patra etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/hypothecated/pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL.

(Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the document or in any other matter connected herewith)

20.3. Security Deposit recovering at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However, in such cases at least 50% of the security Deposit should be collected before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.

20.4. The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

20.5. Security Deposit will be refunded to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the contract on submitting all the required documents / Returns / Proof of compliance to all applicable statutes.

20.6. Failure to pay the security deposit shall be treated as failure to discharge the duties under the contract and shall result in cancellation of the offer of the contract including forfeiting the EMD and the tenderer shall be liable to compensate BHEL for any loss incurred to BHEL.

20.7. The security deposit shall be returned within a reasonable time after the date of expiry of the contract subject to the contractor carrying out all obligations / operations as required under the contract.

20.8. BHEL reserves the right to recover any part or the whole of the amount of the security deposit for losses suffered by BHEL due to failures on the part of the contractor or due to termination of contract or contractor becoming disqualified because of liquidation / insolvency or change of

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composition or loss/damage caused to BHEL's property. The decision of BHEL in respect of such losses, damages, charges, expenses or costs, shall be final and binding on the contractor and the decision shall not be questionable.

21. Unless the bidder whose tender is accepted, signs contract agreement within fifteen days (15 days) of the date of the order directing to do so, the amount of Earnest money already deposited by the bidder will be forfeited and acceptance of the tender withdrawn.

22. If after opening of tenders, a tenderer revokes the tender or increase of earlier quoted rates or after acceptance of his tender does not commence the work in accordance with the instruction of Engineer-in-charge, the Earnest Money Deposited by bidder will be forfeited and acceptance of bidder's tender withdrawn. If only a part of work included in the tender had been awarded to the tenderer, the amount of Earnest Money to be retained will be based on value of the contract so awarded.

23. The BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED reserve the right to reject any or all the tenders received or accept any tender or part thereof without assigning reason thereof. In the case of acceptance of a part of tender, the time for completion may also be reduced to the extent considered necessary by the accepting authority.

24. Conditional and unsigned tenders, tenders which are incomplete or otherwise considered defective, tenders which are not in accordance with the tender conditions laid down by the accepting officer and tenders not submitted in the prescribed forms are liable to be rejected.

25. The tenderers should enclose relevant documents regarding constitution of firm i.e. Individual / Sole Proprietorship Concern / Partnership Firm / Public Limited Company / Private Limited Company to satisfy Clause C (2) , Part -I of NIT.

26. The tenders should be enclosed with a list of contracts already held by the tenderer at the time of submitting the tender and giving the following particulars:

(a). Name of the work, value and address.

(b) The balance work remaining to be done on the same.

27(a). The filled in tender sealed cover should be dropped in the Tender box **Marked HRM-12** kept in the reception of **BHEL-EDN**, in case the sealed tender document is large and not possible to drop the same in the Tender box, it should be handed over at office of **AGM/HR(ESTATE OFFICER)** before the time fixed for submission of tender.

(b) Tenders received after the due date & time of opening of tenders will be rejected.

28. The Contractor's responsibility under this contract shall commence from date of receipt of the order or acceptance of tender.

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- 29.** If proprietor or partner of a firm expires after the submission of tender or after the acceptance of tender, BHEL reserves the right to cancel the contract if the character of the firm undergoes a substantial change.
- 30.** THE BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED will not be bound by any Power of Attorney granted by the tenderer or changes in the composition of firm made subsequent to signing of the contract. They may however recognize such power of Attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice.
- 31.** If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information on tender regarding past unsatisfactory performance with BHEL sister units, BHEL reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage including contract execution period.
- 32.** Words imparting the singular number shall also be deemed to include the plural number and vice-versa where the context so require.
- 33.** The General and Special Conditions are complementary to each other and where they are in conflict, the special condition shall prevail.
- 34.** The expenses for completing the stamping agreement shall be paid by the contractor.
- 35.** Unless or otherwise stated above tendered work includes supply, erection, testing and commissioning of equipment as agreed to in the contract.
- 36.** Any covering letter and comments of the tenderer should be submitted along with the offer.
- 37.** Should a tenderer or a contractor has a relative or in the case of firm or company, any of its share holders' relative is employed in Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, the authority inviting tenders shall be informed of this fact at the time of submission of the tender, failing which tender may be disqualified if such fact subsequently comes to light.
- 38.** The 'INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER' & GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT OF BHEL' shall be deemed to form an integral part of the Contract agreement for the work to be entered into. The Contractor has to scrutinize the same, and when submitting his tender, indicate his acceptance of both. In cases of variation between the two in any matter, the conditions in the 'THE INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS' shall prevail.
- 39.** The Contractor shall apply and obtain license under Contract labour (R&A) Act 1970 and comply with the relevant provisions of this Act in respect of the labour employed by him for executing this contract. The contractor shall furnish necessary returns to the authority through the Principal Employer.

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40. The Contractor shall comply with the provision of Employees Provident Fund and miscellaneous Provisions of Act 1952 and rules, regulations and other orders issued there under. He as an employer shall be liable to pay employer's contribution/deductions towards PF under the PF Act in respect of all the labors employed by him for the execution of the contract in accordance with the provisions of the Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 as amended from time to time. For this purpose he shall indicate the code number obtained from the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner or he should obtain a code number if he has not and produce the Photostat copy of the challans receipt of monthly remittance of the contribution made by him to the Commissioner. He shall also furnish such returns as are due, under the Act, to be sent to the appropriate authorities through the Principal Employer".

41. The Contractor should get himself registered with the E.S.I Authorities as an independent employer, obtain a separate code number and remit the dues in respect of the Labour employed by him for the work and produce the challans/Receipts of remittance of the ESI contributions due under the E.S.I Act to the Company authorities. He shall also furnish such returns, as are due, under the Act, to be sent to the appropriate authorities' through the Principal Employer.

42. If any action is brought in by P.F. Commissioner/ESI authorities on BHEL for the work done by the Contractor for his laborers regarding PF/ESI amount due, short remittances, non-remittances etc., the Contractor shall defend the case on behalf of BHEL and / or reimburse BHEL the expenses so incurred.

43. The contractor should indemnify BHEL against all losses / penal actions due to non-compliance of extant statutes in execution of this Contractor from any previous or running contracts undertaken by them.

44. The contractor should be solely responsible for any accidents and / or compensation payable to the personnel engaged by him under this Contract. He shall provide relief as per the requirement and shall keep BHEL fully indemnified against any claims in this regard.

45. The successful contractor has to execute an indemnity bond with regard to clause. 42 to 44 mentioned above.

46. The bidder along with its associate/collabrators/sub-contractors/Sub-Vendors/Consultants/service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice. Fraud prevention policy and list of Nodal officers shall be hosted on BHEL website, vendor portals of Units/Regions Internet.

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47. Goods & Service Tax (GST):

- 47.1 The tenderer shall have a valid GST Registration. GST Registration No. of the tendered shall be mentioned in the designated field of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 47.2 Provisional GST ID No. of BHEL is **29AAACB4146P1ZB**
- 47.3 On award of the contract, the successful tenderer (vendor) shall mention GSTIN number in all quotations & invoices submitted to BHEL.
- 47.4 SAC (Services Accounting Code) to be mandatorily mentioned in all quotations & invoices submitted.
- 47.5 Invoice submitted should be in the format as specified under GST Laws viz. all details as mentioned in Invoice Rules like GSTN registration number, invoice number, quantity, rate, value, taxes with nomenclature – CGST, SGST, IGST mentioned separately, SAC Code etc.
- 47.6 Payment of GST to vendors as applicable will be made only if it is matching with data uploaded by Vendors.
- 47.7 Vendors shall give undertaking that GST as mentioned in the Invoice has been paid either through cash or admissible input credit and also filed the returns.
- 47.8 For invoices paid on Reverse charge basis – “Tax amount” & that it is “payable on reverse charge basis to be mentioned on the invoice.

48. Payment will be made to the Contractor on monthly basis against the submission of the following documents:

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT/TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

It is hereby agreed by me/us that the BHEL General Conditions of Contract including subsequent amendments/ additions/deletions to clauses if any, and conditions pertaining the settlement of disputes by Arbitration form an integral part of the tender documents and that the tender submitted by me/ us is subject to the aforesaid BHEL General Conditions of Contract/ Technical Specification For Works which has been read and accepted by me/us.

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CLAUSE 20 OF GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

LABOUR

The Contractor shall employ labour in sufficient numbers either directly or through sub-contractors to maintain the required date of progress and of quality to ensure workmanship of the degree specified in the contract and to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge. The contractor shall not employ in connection with the works any person who has not completed his eighteen years of age.

The contractor shall furnish to the Engineer-in-charge at the intervals specified by him. A distribution return of the number and description by trades of the work people employed on the works. The Contractor shall also submit on the 4th and 19th or every month to the Engineer-in-charge a true statement showing in respect of the second half of the preceding month and the first half of the current month (i) the accidents that occurred during the said fortnight showing the circumstances under which they happened and the extent of damage and injury caused by them and (ii) the number of female workers who have been allowed maternity benefits as provided in the maternity benefit Act, 1961 or Rules made there under and the amount paid to them.

The contractor shall pay to labour employed by him either directly or through sub-contractors wages not less than fair wages as defined in the contractors Labour Regulations.

The Contractor shall in respect of labour employed by him either directly or through sub-contractors complies with or causes to be complied with contractors labour Regulations in regard to all matters provided therein.

The Contractors shall comply with the provisions of the payment of wages Act, 1936, Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Workmen's Compensation Act 1923, Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, Maternity Benefit Act 1961 or any modifications there of or any other law relating thereto and rules made there under from time to time.

The Contractors shall be liable to pay his contribution and the employees' contribution of the State Insurance Scheme in respect of all labours employed by him for the execution of the contract, in accordance with the provision of "The Employees State Insurance Act, 1948", as amended from time to time.

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The contractors shall apply to the ESI authorities, get himself registered with them and obtain a code number. He shall pay the remittances under his code number only.

The Contractor shall be liable to pay his contribution and the Employees' contribution towards PF as per Provident Fund Rules and Regulations in respect of all labours employed by him for the execution of the contract. The contractor shall apply to the PF Authorities, get himself registered and obtain a code number from them. He shall pay the remittances towards PF under his code number only.

The Engineer-in-charge shall on a report having been made by an Inspecting Officer as defined in the Contractors Labour Regulations have the power to deduct from the money due to the Contractor any sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss suffered by a worker or workers by reason of non-fulfillment of the conditions of the contract for the benefit of workers, non - payment of wages or of deductions made from him or their wages which are not justified by the terms of the contract of non-observance of the said contractor's Labour Regulations.

The Contractors shall indemnify the BHEL against any payment to be made under and for observance of the Regulation aforesaid without prejudice to his right to claim indemnity from these sub-contractors.

MODEL RULES FOR LABOUR WELFARE

The Contractor shall at his own expense comply with or cause to be complied with model Rules for Labour Welfare as appended to these conditions or rules framed by Government from time to time for the protection of health and for making sanitary arrangements for workers employed directly or indirectly on the works, In case the Contractors fails to make arrangements as aforesaid the engineer-in-charge shall be entitled to do so and recover the cost thereof from the contractor.

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SAFETY CODE
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR IN RESPECT OF
SAFETY OF MEN, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL AND ENVIRONMENT

1. Before commencing the work, contractor submits a "SAFETY PLAN" to the authorized BHEL Official. The 'SAFETY PLAN' shall indicate in detail the measure that would be taken by the contractor to ensure safety of men, equipment, material and environment during execution of the work. The plan shall take care to satisfy all requirements specified hereunder. The contractor shall submit Safety Plan along with his offer. During negotiations before placing of work order and during execution of the contract BHEL shall have right to review and suggest modification in the Safety Plan. Contractor shall abide by BHEL decision in this respect.

2. The contractor shall take all necessary safety precautions and arrange for appropriate appliances as per direction of BHEL or its authorized officials to prevent loss of human lives, injuries to personnel engaged, and damage to property and environment.

3. The contractor shall provide to its work force and ensure the use of the following personal protective equipment as found necessary and as directed by the authorized BHEL officials

4. (i) Safety Helmets conforming to IS-2925: 1984.

(ii) Safety Belts conforming to IS-3521: 1983.

(iii) Safety Shoes conforming to IS-1989: 1978.

(iv) Eye and Face protection devices conforming to IS-8520: 1977 and IS-8940:1978.

(v) Hand and body protection devices conforming to:

IS-2573: 1975

IS-6994: 1973

IS-8807: 1978

IS-8519: 1977

All tools, tackles, lifting appliances, material handling equipment, scaffolds, cradles, safety nets, ladders, equipment's etc. used by the contractor shall be of safe design and construction. These shall be tested and certificate of fitness obtained before putting them to use and from time to time as instructed by authorized BHEL official who shall have the right to ban the use of any item.

All electrical equipment, connections and wiring for constructions, power, its distribution and use shall conform to the requirement of the Indian Electricity Act and Rules. Only electricians licensed by the appropriate statutory authority shall be employed by the contractor to carry out all types of

electrical works. All electrical appliances including portable electric tools used by the contractor shall have safe plugging system to source of power and be appropriately earthed. The contractor shall not use any hand lamp energized by electric power with supply voltage of more than 24 volts. For work in confined space lighting shall be arranged with power sources of not more than 24 volts.

The Contractor shall adopt all fire safety measures as laid down in the "Code for fire Safety at Construction Sites" issued by the Safety Department of the Construction Management (HQ) of BHEL and as per directions of the authorized BHEL official. A copy of the above referred "Code of Fire Safety at the Construction Sites" shall be made available by BHEL to the contractor for reference, on demand by the contractor, during tendering stage itself.

Where it becomes necessary to provide and/or store petroleum Products, explosives, chemicals and liquids or gaseous fuel or any other substance that may cause fire or explosion, the contractor shall be responsible for carrying out such provisions and/or storage in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down in the relevant government acts, such as Petroleum Act, Explosives Act, Petroleum and Carbides of Calcium Manual of the Chief Controller of Explosives, Govt. of India. etc., prior approval to the authorized BHEL official at the site shall also be taken by the contractor in all such matters.

The contractor shall arrange at his cost (wherever not specified) appropriate illumination at all work spots for safe working when natural daylight may not be adequate for clear visibility.

The contractor shall be held responsible for any violation of statutory regulations local, state or central and BHEL instructions that may endanger safety of men, equipment, material and environment in his scope of work or another contractor or agencies. Cost of damages if any, to life and property arising out of such violation of statutory regulations and BHEL instructions shall be borne by the contractor.

In case of a fatal or disabling injury accident to any person at construction sites due to the lapses by the contractor, the victim and/or his/her dependents shall be compensated by the contractor as per statutory requirements. However, if considered necessary, BHEL shall have the right to impose appropriate financial penalty on the contractor and recover the same from payments due to the contractor for suitably compensating the victim and/or his/her dependents. Before imposing any such penalty, appropriate enquiry shall be held by BHEL giving opportunity to the contractor to present his case.

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In case of any damage to property by the contractor, BHEL shall have the right to recover cost of such damages from payments due to the contractor after holding an appropriate enquiry.

In case of any delay in the completion of a job due to mishaps attributable to lapses by the contractor; BHEL shall have to recover cost of such delay from payments due to the contractor, after notifying suitably and giving him opportunity to present his case.

If the contractor fails to improve the standards of safety in its operation to the satisfaction of BHEL after being given a reasonable opportunity to do so; and/or if the contractor fails to take appropriate safety precautions or to provide necessary safety devices and equipment or to carry out instructions regarding safety issued by the authorized BHEL official, BHEL shall have the right to take corrective steps at the risk and cost of the contractor after giving a notice of not less than seven days indicating the steps that would be taken by BHEL.

The contractor shall submit report of all accidents, fires and property damage, dangerous occurrence to the authorized BHEL official immediately after such occurrence, but in any case not later than twelve hours of the occurrence. Such reports shall be furnished in the manner prescribed by BHEL. In addition, the contractor to the authorized BHEL official shall also submit periodic reports on safety from time to time as prescribed.

Before commencing the work, the contractor shall appoint/nominate a responsible officer to supervise implementation of all safety measures and liaison with his counterpart of BHEL.

If safety record of the contractor in execution of the awarded job is to the satisfaction of Safety Department of BHEL, issue of an appropriate certificate to recognize the safety performance of the contractor may be considered by BHEL after completion the job.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

GENERAL

The special condition of contract and other contract documents are complimentary to each other and shall be read in conjunction with each other. In case of any conflict of meanings between the special conditions of contract and the BHEL General conditions of contract the provisions of the special conditions of contract shall override the corresponding provisions for the BHEL General Conditions of contract.

1. SCOPE OF WORK FOR MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS, ROADS, DRAINAGES, SUMPS, SEWER LINES, ED'S BUNGALOW, GUEST HOUSE, PUMPS, ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS, GARDENS & BSCH AT BHEL- EDN TOWNSHIP:

(i) SWEEPING AND SANITARY WORKS

Sweeping of common staircase of all the blocks under occupation, temporary sheds, garages, cycle and scooter sheds, pump houses, ED Bungalow, Guest House, BSCH, internal roads, foot paths, all the rooms, staircase, corridors, kitchen, dining hall, recreation room in E.T. hostel and hall, toilets, corridors of community center and watering and maintaining the existing and new gardens, lawn, trees and plants etc. daily in the township and disposal of garbage in the Township as directed by Engineer-in-charge, washing these areas as and when required should also be taken care of. The toilet and the urinals attached to the temporary sheds should be cleaned daily with phenol, bleaching powder, vim powder and providing naphthalene balls wherever required. Cleaning of storm water drains including corporation drains, nearby open/underground sanitary pipes and other drains, platforms dustbins periodically and also as and when BWSSB sanitary lines and manholes get blocked, they should get it cleaned by coordinating with BWSSB officials and dispose off the debris as directed by the Engineer-in-charge. The contractor shall be fully responsible for keeping the township neat and clean.

No. of workers to be engaged by the contractor for this item of works: **Sweepers – 17 Nos.**

(ii) PUMP OPERATION AND PLUMBING WORKS

Water supply to township by making use of available pump sets and accessories including pumping bore well water to underground sumps & to the overhead tank from where water to be supplied by gravity to all houses and to the tanks of the building including opening and closing of valves and attending to all types of repairs for pipe lines, taps, flushing cisterns, valves, wash basins, sinks and other connected water supply system situated inside the township, water shall be pumped from the sump to the overhead tank and the distribution ensured by gravity.

The tanks of individual houses shall be cleaned by the contractor with bleaching powder, once a month or as directed by the Engineer-in-charge and the main overhead tank and the sump shall be cleaned once in three months or as directed by the engineer-in-charge with bleaching powder. The water at the ground level reservoir (sump) should be chlorinated as directed by the Engineer-in-charge

Spare parts for plumbing works and sanitary works like pipes, specials like bends etc., wash basin, water closets, sinks, cement etc. will be supplied departmentally free of cost at the Township Maintenance Office.

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The minimum number of workers to be engaged shall be **4 Nos. (2 Nos. pump operators (SSW) and 2 Nos. 1 Class Plumbers (SW))** plus reserve for weekly offs and leave Reserve. All the four to be engaged shall be plumbers/operators well experienced in this line and pump operators shall be available in the premises (i.e. in two shifts) throughout year plus replacement such as leave reserve, weekly off & holiday off as per Labour Act.

(iii) CARPENTARY WORKS

This work involves attending rectification to the doors and windows fittings like hinges, tower bolts, stoppers (doors and windows) aldrops, mortise locks, replacement of glass panels, rectification to all shutters of doors and windows. All materials required for the above work will be provided free of cost by Township Maintenance Office.

The contractor has to engage **2 Nos. 1Class Carpenter (HSW)** who has good and wide experience in carpentry works and shall be available in the township premises.

(iv) MASONARY WORKS

This work involves attending rectification to the masonry works like arresting the roof leakages repairing of damaged plastering construction of boiler stands, platforms in the kitchen construction of dustbins. Repairing of leakage sanitary fittings, construction of thrush holds and day to day general maintenance of masonry works.

The contractor has to engage **2 Nos. class- 1 Mason (HSW)**

(v) ELECTRICAL MAINTENANCE IN THE TOWNSHIP

This work involves attending to such work as fuse of cells, rectification work in the appliances like switches, plug points etc. and electrical maintenance work at pumping stations, consumables like fuse wire, insulation tape etc. and necessary tools and plants required for the work shall be provided by BHEL.

The contractor has to engage **4 Nos. Electrician (2 NOS SW + 2 HSW)**

The contractor has to engage **01 Person as Manager (HSW) and 01 person as office clerk (SW) , SUPERVISOR 1 NO.(HSW)**

(Vi) POWER SUPPLY

To restore power supply to individual quarters and other buildings in the event of power failure with necessary liaison with electricity authorities.

(Vii) STREET LIGHTING

To restore street lighting as and when bulbs are fused, if any, problem comes than necessary liaison with electricity authorities.

(Viii) QUARTERS, CAUVERY GUEST HOUSE, ED'S BUNGALOW, E.T's HOSTEL, COMMUNITY CENTER, BHCS etc.

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Necessary trouble shooting in the wiring and fixtures and corrective action in above said buildings, staircases car sheds etc. After trouble shooting for rectification, materials will be supplied by BHEL.

(IX) ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION FOR FACILITIES

(Bore wells, GLR, Car shed and Maintenance office)

Necessary trouble shooting in the distribution system, wiring, cables, starters, switches. After the trouble shooting for rectification/ replacement purposes materials like bulbs/tubes, switches, MCBs, cables, wires, starter parts, sockets, will be supplied by BHEL as and when required.

(X) EARTHING

(a) Periodical watering of earth pits

(b) To check and attend to the conditions of earth connections at the termination points.

The work shall be carried out through 4 Nos. of licensed Electricians two in the first shift and the other two in the II shift and shall be available in the township premises. The quoted rate shall include provision for four electricians (i.e. in two shifts throughout year) plus replacement such as leave reserve, weekly off, holiday off as per Labour Acts.

(xi) MANAGERIAL & ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITY:

Over all operations of Township and BSCH including work allocation, monitoring of all areas of operation covered in the contract.

2. The contractor is to note that the age of the personnel deployed under this contract shall not exceed 60 years as on date of commencement of contract. During execution period of contract suitable replacement for personnel crossing 60 years of age shall be provided in consultation with contract issuing officer /Township in charge.

3. The security deposit deposited by the contractor will be forfeited and credited to BHEL, in event of breach of any of the terms and conditions of this contract by the contractor.

4. The security deposit (50%) shall be released by BHEL on the total completion of the work as per contract terms, remaining 50% of security deposit shall be released subject to the stipulation in our GCC after 06 months from the date of completion of work.

5.. The management of BHEL shall have the right to withhold payment of, or make recoveries from claims due to the contractor in respect of any loss or damage caused or occasioned in respect of the properties of BHEL under the terms and conditions of this arrangement or any payment necessitated due to the infringement of any statutory obligations by the contractor.

6. The contractor shall not transfer or submit the work to anyone without the prior written approval of BHEL. The contractor shall either by himself or through a competent agent approved by BHEL authorities, perform the said work.

7. The contractor or his authorized agent approved by BHEL shall be in attendance in BHEL premises during all working hours for supervising the work. For any negligence of the service employed by the contractor or for any loss or damage caused or occasioned by himself, his agents or workmen in respect of the property of BHEL, the contractor shall be personally responsible and shall make good the loss forthwith.

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8. Increase in costs due new statutory levies under the central or state act or enhancement of such existing levies, wages, Ex-gratia, PF, ESI etc., due to statutory ground time to time subsequent to tendering, shall be met by BHEL.
9. Whether under the contract any sum of money shall be recovered from or payable by the contractor, the same shall be paid by the contractor on demand such amount may also be deducted from any sum the due or from any sum which at any time there after becomes due to the contractor under his contract or under any other contract or from his security deposit, in respect of this work or in respect of any other works.
10. If the management of BHEL engages workers complete any part or whole of the work as per this contract for any period due to failure of the contract or to engage adequate number of workers. He has to reimburse to the management of BHEL, the extra cost involved on this account. The extra cost of engaging such workmen by BHEL will be reckoned at the rate of as per Minimum Wages Act for purpose of recovery from the contractor.
11. All items of work done shall be entered in a register daily so that complete record is obtained of all work performed under this arrangement, and signed and dated by both parties viz., persons authorized for and on behalf of BHEL and the contractor or his agent approved by the company each day on completion of work.
12. Without prejudice of any rights or remedies under this agreement if the contractor dies, the BHEL authorities shall have the right to terminate this agreement without any liability whatsoever as regards enlistment of the work for the balance contract period after the death of the contractor.
13. If any controversy regarding performance of any item of work is there it has to be settled before signing on the register by parties on the same day. No objection will be entertained after the contractor/his supervisor has signed in the register.
14. The contractor shall pay wages to his workmen at the rates as applicable to the Engg. Industry under the minimum wages act for unskilled, semiskilled, skilled and highly skilled categories. The contractor shall disburse the wages on or before 7th of every month, if it falls on Sunday or Holiday payment shall be made on previous day.
15. Exact amount of wages to be remitted to ESI & PF authorities in respect of workmen engaged for the above & the details of amounts remitted towards their PF & ESI for each month to be enclosed.
16. The contractor shall apply & obtain license under the contract labour (R& A) act 1970 and comply with the relevant provision of this act, in respect of the labour employed by him for executing this contract. The contractor shall furnish necessary returns to the authority through the principal employer.
17. (a) The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the payment of wages act 1936, minimum wages act 1948, workmen's compensation act 1923 and other statutory law relating thereto and made there under from time to time.

(b) Any Revision in wages, statutory charges (ESI , PF & Bonus) during execution of contract period, the same shall be reimbursed on submission of Document for disbursement of such payments to contract labours as per eligibility.
18. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the workmen's compensation act 1923, the payment of the wages act 1936, Factory Act, Minimum Wages Act 1948. Employment of Children

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Act 1938, Employer's liability act 1938, industrial disputes act 1947, & other acts central or states that may be applicable to him. He shall be liable to pay all such sum, or sums that may become payable as contribution, compensation, penalty, fine or otherwise, which the provision of the said acts, to or on behalf of any workmen employed by the contractor by an authority empowered under the relevant act. Any cost incurred by the management of BHEL in connection with any claim or proceedings under the said acts or in respect of loss, injury or improper performance of this contract by the contractor, is workmen, servant and any money which may become payable to the management of BHEL as aforesaid shall be deemed to be deducted by the management of BHEL from any money due or accruing to the contractor by the management of BHEL or may be recovered by the management of BHEL from the contractor in the other manner.

19. The contractor should take independent code numbers under EPF act 1952 and ESI Act 1948 and shall cover his workmen under the employees' provident fund schemes and employees' state insurance act 1948 & show proof of payment of subscriptions/contributions to the concerned authorities. Both in respect of ESI/EPF the contractor shall obtain necessary declaration forms from his employees & obtain individual insurance and PF numbers & shall furnish to the company necessary proofs for having made remittance of ESI & PF contributions in respect of all contract laborers engaged by him.

20(a). As regards Employees State Insurance Act, the contractor shall submit Photostat copies of the challans of remittance of the contributions (both the employees contributions and his own contribution there on) to the ESI corporation in respect of the employees engaged in BHEL by him for this work for the relevant period before any payment is released by BHEL.

20(b).The contractor shall mandatorily obtain suitable/ required workmen compensation insurance/policy cover to all his workers who are not covered under ESI act at his cost, to ensure employees compensation and accidental cover as may be applicable. A documentary proof for the same shall be submitted to BHEL within 15 days of commencement of work. The contractor shall also enclose along with his monthly bill, a valid documentary proof for having taken workmen compensation insurance/policy for his workers who are not covered under ESI act. These documents are necessary for processing the bills.

21. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of Employees' Provident Fund and miscellaneous provisions act 1952 and rules, regulations and other orders issued there under. He as an employer shall be liable to pay employer's contribution/ deductions towards PF under the PF act in respect of all labour employed by him for the execution of the contract in accordance with the provision of the Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 as amended from time to time. For this purpose he shall indicate the code number obtained from the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner or he should obtain a code number if he has not and produce the Photostat copy of the challan receipt of monthly remittance of the contribution made by him to the commissioner. Final payment due to him will be released only on production of a "no due certificate" from the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner. He shall also furnish such returns as are due, under the Act, to be sent to the appropriate authorities through the Principal Employer."

22. The BHEL General Conditions of contract shall also apply to this work except to the extent modified in these conditions. The contractor shall scrutinize the GCC available in BHEL- EDN and acquaint himself with provisions thereof to the satisfaction.

23. This arrangement is purely on temporary license basis & it is subject to the extension/renewal slowly at the option & discretion of the management of BHEL.

24. The management of BHEL shall be at liberty to terminate the contract by issuing a month's notice to the contractor without assigning any reason what so ever. As regards unsatisfactory performance or non-compliance with any of the terms & conditions of the contract by the contractor, the management of the BHEL shall have the right to terminate the contract forthwith without notice & rearrange the balance work through other agencies at the risk and cost of the contractor & under such circumstances, the security deposit paid by the contractor shall stand forfeited.

25. Tenderers shall submit an up to date solvency certificates, from their bankers (scheduled Bank) and up to date income tax clearance certificate & work experience certificate.

26. The contractor shall follow such, Act, rules & regulations of the state/central Govt. that are in force and that may be framed from time to time. BHEL shall not be responsible for any infringement of the various statues in force by the contractor.

27. The contractor shall take, at his own cost the necessary license in respect of this work. The expenses in completing the formalities in executing the agreement including execution on stamp paper will also be met by the contractor.

28. Any additional items of work nor covered by the contract or change in the frequency of cleaning work in excess of 110% of the agreed area or frequency has to be carried out by the contractor at a rate agreed by mutual discussion between the contractor and the Engineer-in-charge.

29. Statutory Deduction towards income tax will be made as per rules. Income Tax will be deducted in every monthly bill payable to contractor.

30. Final payment due to the contractor will be released only on production of 'No due certificate' from the regional provident fund commissioner and ESI authorities. The contractors also to furnish such returns as are due under the Act to be sent to the appropriate authorities through BHEL as principal employer.

31. Clearance for statutory requirements like ESI and PF contributions and other relevant documents pertaining to this contract should to be obtained from Welfare (HR) department every month for release of payment.

32. REVERSE AUCTION/PRICE BID OPENING:

- BHEL reserves the right to go for reverse auction at any point of time before opening of Price Bid.
- Bids with non-acceptance of reverse auction will be liable for rejection.
- Opening of Price Bid at discretion of BHEL.
- BHEL shall be at liberty to cancel the tender at any time, before ordering, without assigning any reason.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTRACTORS

There will be no objection if the arbitrator so appointed is an employer of BHEL or an employer of any other unit of BHEL and that he had to deal with the matters to which the contract relates and that in the course of its duties as such he had expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or difference. The Arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason, such Executive Director / General Manager as aforesaid at the time of such transfer vacation of office or inability to act, shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. It is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed by such Executive Director/General Manager or an employee appointed as arbitrator as aforesaid should act as arbitrator and the arbitrator shall give reasons for the award.
