14. **Delivery Schedule: -**

SUPPLY: - Within six (06) months from the date of all documents approval in Cat-I subject to documents submission by vendor within weeks as indicated in attached annexure-VII of Tech.Spec.-PE-TS-412-154-A001, R01 and every re-submission within Ten (10) days after incorporating all BHEL/Customer comments.

In case there are delays of submission/resubmission from given schedule, that much days of delay would be reduced from delivery period.

Mandatory Spares are to be delivered along with the last consignment of main supply within the contractual delivery period..

15. Pre-Qualifying Requirements: Bidders have to provide the required details as per PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT CRITERIA (enclosed as NIT Tender Documents) in their Techno-Commercial offer. Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Pre-Qualifying requirements.
16. Bidders are requested to refer Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) format & rules and adhere to it while furnishing PBG.
17. BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS IN CASE OF REVERSE AUCTION

The Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. Total Cost to BHEL availing input tax credit) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, Freight charges, Insurance charges (if applicable)etc, including loading (if any) as applicable.

19. CIF is not available for this package
20. If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any consequences thereof. Any incomplete drawing submitted shall be treated as non-submission with delays attributable to bidder's account. Engineering meeting shall be held fort nightly, for which the bidder shall depute his concerned engineer along with project manager to BHEL PEM office or at customer office. The meeting can also be held at site.
