Please send us an Acknowledgment for the receipt of Enquiry by mail or Letter. In case you are not making an offer against this enquiry, you are requested to send a regret e-mail/letter such that the same is received to us on or before the due date.

Your best quotation/offer for the above requirement, in line with our terms and conditions, should be submitted online via e-procurement system. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the Tender is submitted on or before the due date by 02:00 PM. Part-I bids shall be opened at 03:00 PM on the due date.

Important Note to be considered by all bidders:

The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offers of the bidders who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com

- 2.1 Bidders to note that following form the part of tender documents:

- General Conditions of Contract (GCC) Rev 06 including corrigenda related to GST.
- Technical Specifications.
- Price format & Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) Rev.00.
- Technical PQR
- NIT Conditions
- Any other document enclosed with NIT.

- 2.2 Bidders to note that offers shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of the above tender documents. Deviations (Technical as well as Commercial), if any, shall be listed out clearly with their techno-commercial offer as per annexure-II of GCC Rev-06.

Bidder has to submit "NO DEVIATION CERTIFICATE FOR COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS as per General Conditions of Contracts (GCC, Rev.06) including corrigenda, Special Conditions of Contract and Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)" in case of no deviations.

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- 2.3 Any hidden conditions/deviations mentioned elsewhere in offer and standard pre-printed terms & conditions of the tenderers shall not be considered valid.
- 2.4 Unsolicited Fresh/Revised Price Bids shall not be entertained.
- 2.5 In case of joint bidding, Scope matrix should be clearly defined between foreign bidder and their Indian representative along with the offer.
- 2.6 If any bidder has mentioned the term Not Applicable / Not Require / Not Quoted in BHEL price format. Hence bidder to need to substantiate the same. If the same item will require in future for the system same will be supplied free of cost.
- 2.7 Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 2.8 Tenderers must enclose the Quality Plan in the prescribed format, for approval. Material will be despatched only after Purchaser's/Owner's inspection at the hold points specified in the approved Quality Plan and issue of Material Despatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC).

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- 2.10 Late tenders will be rejected.

2.11 Delivery:

A) Delivery schedule of Main Supply with commissioning spares: Within Six (06) months from drgs/docs approval or from date of manufacturing clearance whichever is earlier. Vendor to submit drgs/docs as per Annexure-VI (Master Drawing List with schedule of submission) of Section-IA of Technical Specification No. PE-TS-435-154-A101, Rev.00 and resubmit drgs/docs within 10 days incorporating all comments. In case there are delays in submission of drgs/docs beyond scheduled submission time or 10 days of comments that much days of delay would be reduced from delivery period.

(B) Delivery Schedule of Mandatory Spares: To be delivered within Six (06) months from date of manufacturing clearance from BHEL.

- 2.12 "BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the

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Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

As a reminder to the bidders, system will flash following message (in RED Color) during the course of 'online sealed bid':

"Bidders to submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed bid already submitted to BHEL".

- 2.13 All vendors participating in an open tender shall be required to meet the PQ criteria irrespective of their being registered/ not registered with BHEL, failing which offer of such vendor(s) shall be rejected. Price bid (Part-II) opening/Reverse Auction is subject to the following: -

- Techno-commercial qualification / recommendation of bidder by the BHEL-PEM
- Approval of bidder by BHEL's Customer (i.e. M/s TANGEDCO). Same shall be taken up by us with customer based on the latest credentials/reference list (Preferably not older than 5 years) furnished by bidder. Accordingly, you are requested to submit the following on or before technical bid Part-1 opening or along with offer: -
 - Company Profile
 - List of projects executed/ on hand for power sectors / Govt. organizations for the subject package.
 - Performance Certificates for satisfactory working of the system /equipment's.
 - Copies of major supply order executed by the vendor.

- 2.14 Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total cost to BHEL excluding GST) basis.

- 2.15 CIF is not available for this tender.

- 2.16 Foreign and indigenous bidders participating through open tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India for future tenders. Basic procedure /checklist has been upload on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquires through e procurement.

- 2.17 MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate applicable for the relevant financial

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year (latest audited). Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted Officer. Bidder to also note that MSEs who submit registration certificate or register themselves after placement of PO shall also be given payment preference as per MSMED-Act 2006.

- 2.18 Indigenous bidders need to indicate the freight charges in percentage of total Ex-works in unpriced format.
- 2.19 All the tender documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalization.
- 2.20 The bidder along with its associate/collaborators/sub vendor/subcontractors/sub vendors/consultants/service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice. BHEL Fraud prevention policy is also uploaded in vendor's section on www.bhelpem.com.
- 2.21 All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications etc. to the tender will be hosted on website only. Bidders are requested to visit our websites from time to time to keep themselves updated.
- 2.22 Insurance (Ocean and Inland) is in BHEL's scope.
- 2.23 Commercial terms of NIT only to be considered and mentioned anywhere in technical specification in case contradicting to be ignored.

- 2.25 Online Registration Portal is operational in BHEL. Non-registered Vendors, who wish to apply for registration with BHEL-PEM, have to apply through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com ' vendor section ' Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted.
- 2.26 All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications etc., to the tender will be hosted on websites only (www.bhelpem.com, www.bhel.com, <https://bhel.abcprocure.com/EPROC/>) under subject tender reference. Bidders are requested to visit our websites regularly to keep themselves updated. Bidders may go through the Sellers' manual & Help documents provided on E-Procurement Portal website & obtain required Digital Signature Certificate for participating in the subject tender. 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- 2.27 Delivery Port shall be Chennai, India.
- 2.28 PVC is not applicable for this package.
- 2.29 If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any consequences thereof. Hence, all bidders are requested to be more careful at the time of uploading the Unpriced and Price Bid for Part-I and Part-II respectively to avoid mismatch.
- 2.30 Overall (%) quantity variation in contract value (due to changes in the scope) for this package shall be 0%. Which will prevail over the quantity variation clause no.6.0 indicated in the GCC rev 06.
- 2.31 The order of precedence shall be NIT/RFQ, Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), and General Conditions of Contract (GCC, Rev.06) in conjunction with GST related corrigendum.
- 2.32 Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid, etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature(s) of person(s) signing the bid else bid shall be liable for rejection.
- 2.33 MSE bidders to give declaration of UAM number on CPPP, failing which such bidders will not be able to enjoy the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order, 2012 for tenders invited electronically through CPPP.
- 2.34 5% Overhead charge will be considered instead of 30% (presently in clause 26.2(b) of GCC Rev.06).
- 2.35 Foreign Bidders will have to quote C&F (Cost & Ocean Freight) basis instead of FOB as per following terms & conditions:
- As per Incoterms (CFR), risk transfers to buyer when the goods have been loaded on board the ship in the country of Export. Hence, shipped on board date mentioned on the clean Bill of Lading or Air way Bill, shall be treated as the date of Shipment/ Dispatch for all contractual purposes including calculation of LD.
 - Usance period (90 days) of the L/C shall start from the date of Bill of lading/Air Way Bill.
 - Bill of Lading shall be considered as equivalent document (refer clause 9.7.1 b OF GCC rev-06) for recognition of dispatch.
 - For claiming payment under clause 9.1.1 and 9.2.1 Bill of lading shall be considered instead of receipted LR (refer clause 9.7.2 b of GCC rev-06)
 - Freight is to be quoted as inclusive in basic price by vendor and is not to be quoted separately.
 - Insurance for evaluation purposes shall be @ 0.1 % of quoted C&F price.
 - There will be no change in MRC payment
- 2.36 Detailed offers are to be submitted including the following along with the Price schedule as per BHEL format enclosed with NIT: -
- Acceptance of GCC Rev-06 including GST related corrigenda
 - Acceptance of Special Conditions of Contract (SCC Rev 00) for the project.
 - Supporting Documents for Technical Pre-Qualifying Requirement

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- d) Technical & Commercial Deviations, if any in Annexure-II (**Mandatory to be filled & submitted along with techno-commercial offer**).
- e) Along with your offer, please submit a copy of this letter duly signed & stamped on each page as token of acceptance of terms & instructions conveyed.
- f) Un-Priced price format duly filled in 'Quoted' or 'Q' in each column/row.
