5. **Clause No. 3 of GTC - Payment Terms:**
100% of payment within 60 days from the date of receipt of complete invoice along with documents in 3 sets (Original + 2 copies) as follows:
 - LR / GR duly endorsed by BHEL Site Official.
 - Material Receipt Certificate issued by BHEL Site Official.
 - GST Compliant Tax Invoice.
 - Packing List (Case-wise)
 - Copy of Transit Insurance Certificate from underwriters.
 - Material Inspection Clearance Certificate (MICC) issued by BHEL Quality Management
 - Guarantee Certificate.
 - Copy of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)
 - Certificate of acceptance of Type Test Reports issued by BHEL Engineering Management wherever specifically mentioned in the Purchase Order.
 - Certificate of successful completion of demonstration/training at Site issued by BHEL Site Official / Construction Management.
 - Certificate of completion of final documentation as per Purchase Order / Technical Specification issued by BHEL Engineering Management.
6. **Destination-** PGCIL Raigarh HVDC Terminal and PGCIL Pugalur HVDC Terminal
7. **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT-** Technical Pre-Qualifying Criteria is specified in NIT. Bidder to comply the pre-qualifying criteria as per **Annexure-6**.
8. Acceptance of Offer and offered Make/Model is subjected to PGCIL approval. PGCIL approval shall be considered as final.
9. **Project Status:** ADB Funded. GST shall be payable as applicable.
10. **Clause-5 (Guarantee clause) of GTC:** The equipment / material supplied and services rendered (if applicable) shall be guaranteed to be free from all defects and faults in design & engineering, material, workmanship & manufacture and in full conformity with the Purchase Order / Contract, Technical Specifications & approved drawings / data sheets, if any, for 18 months from the date of last delivery or up to 27.06.2022, whichever is later. Other terms as per General Terms and Condition (GTC - BHEL/TBG/GTC/ 2016 Rev-1).

- 11. Clause-7 (PBG validity) of GTC:** Vendor shall arrange to submit Performance BG for 10% of the total Ex-works PO value on a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value. PBG should valid till guarantee period with claim period of 3 months extra over and above guarantee period in line with one of the applicable options given in enclosed General Terms and Condition (GTC - BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev-1)
- 12. Clause-12 (Delivery Period) of GTC-** Delivery required in by **Dec'2020**. Bidder to quote their best possible delivery plan in activity schedule to meet immediate delivery requirement.
Note: In case, BHEL's delivery requirement is not met by vendor(s), then a chance may be given to all such vendors to review their quoted delivery schedule in line with BHEL's delivery requirement. However, if vendor fails to meet the requisite delivery plan, then BHEL reserves the right not to consider the offer of such vendor(s).
- 13. Liquidated Damage for Supply (Clause no. 13 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev.01):** In case of delay in execution of Purchase Order beyond the contractual delivery time, an amount of 0.5% of the total PO Ex-Works value & F&I Charges for supply per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total PO Ex-Works value & F&I Charges shall be deducted as Liquidated Damages (LD) along with applicable GST (if any) on LD.
- 14. Reverse Auction: (Clause no. 13 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev.01):** Reverse Auction is not applicable. Price Bids shall be opened.
- 15. Technical Specification-** TB_391_316_Crane Rev 01. No permissible Technical Deviation has been envisaged. Bidders to quote as per Technical Specification.
- 16. Variation of Contract Value / Quantity Variation (Clause no. 13 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev.01):**

- 17. Integrity Pact:** (Clause no. 34 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev.01): Integrity pact is applicable for this tender.

18. Evaluation Criteria: Evaluation criteria shall be **Overall L1 basis**. However, Purchase Orders shall be placed Site wise i.e separate Purchase order for Raigarh HVDC Site and Pugalur HVDC Site.

19. Arbitration (Clause No. 19 of BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev.01): This clause shall be read as per **Annexure-8**.

20. Make in India Declaration:

For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as class I local supplier / class II local supplier / Non-Local supplier and purchase preference to class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020, issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before opening of part II bids against this NIT.

"Bidder to specify the percentage of local content as per the format of self-declaration for local content" as per **Annexure-9**.

"This tender is not a global tender and **only class I** and **Class II** suppliers as defined under the DPIIT order no. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 04.06.2020 are eligible to bid in this tender. Bids received from Non-Local supplier shall be rejected."

21. Please refer Clause at **Annexure-1** and Certification at **Annexure-2 / Annexure-3** (whichever is applicable) regarding restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017. Bidder to comply to the clause and submit the certification. Non-compliance/ Non-submission of certification will lead to rejection of Offer.

22. Bidder to comply the MOP circular dated 02-07-2020 (**Annexure-4**) and its subsequent amendment, if any, in prescribed format (**Annexure-5**). Non-compliance/ Non-submission will lead to rejection of Offer.
